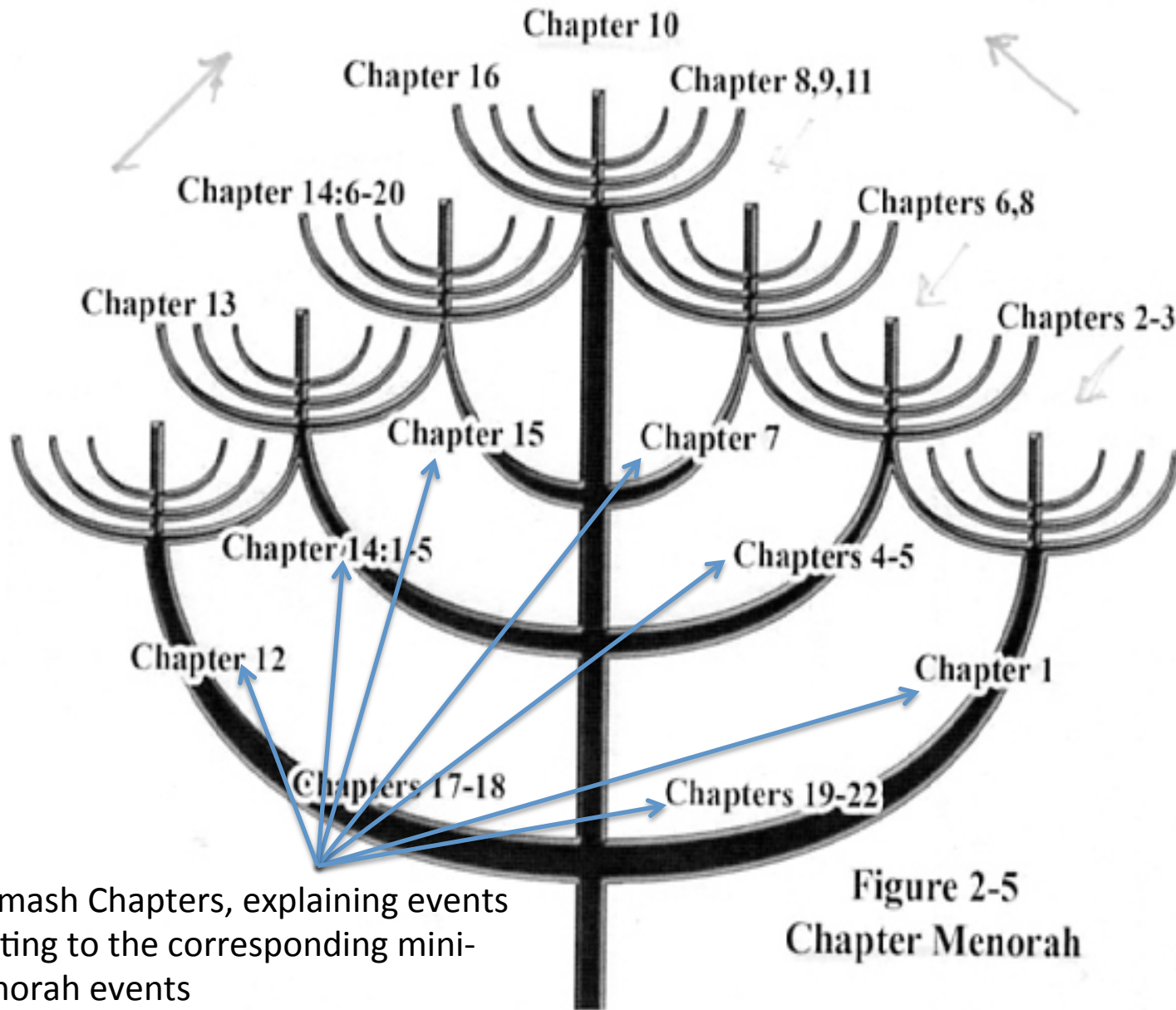

# The Seventh Seal & Seven Trumpets

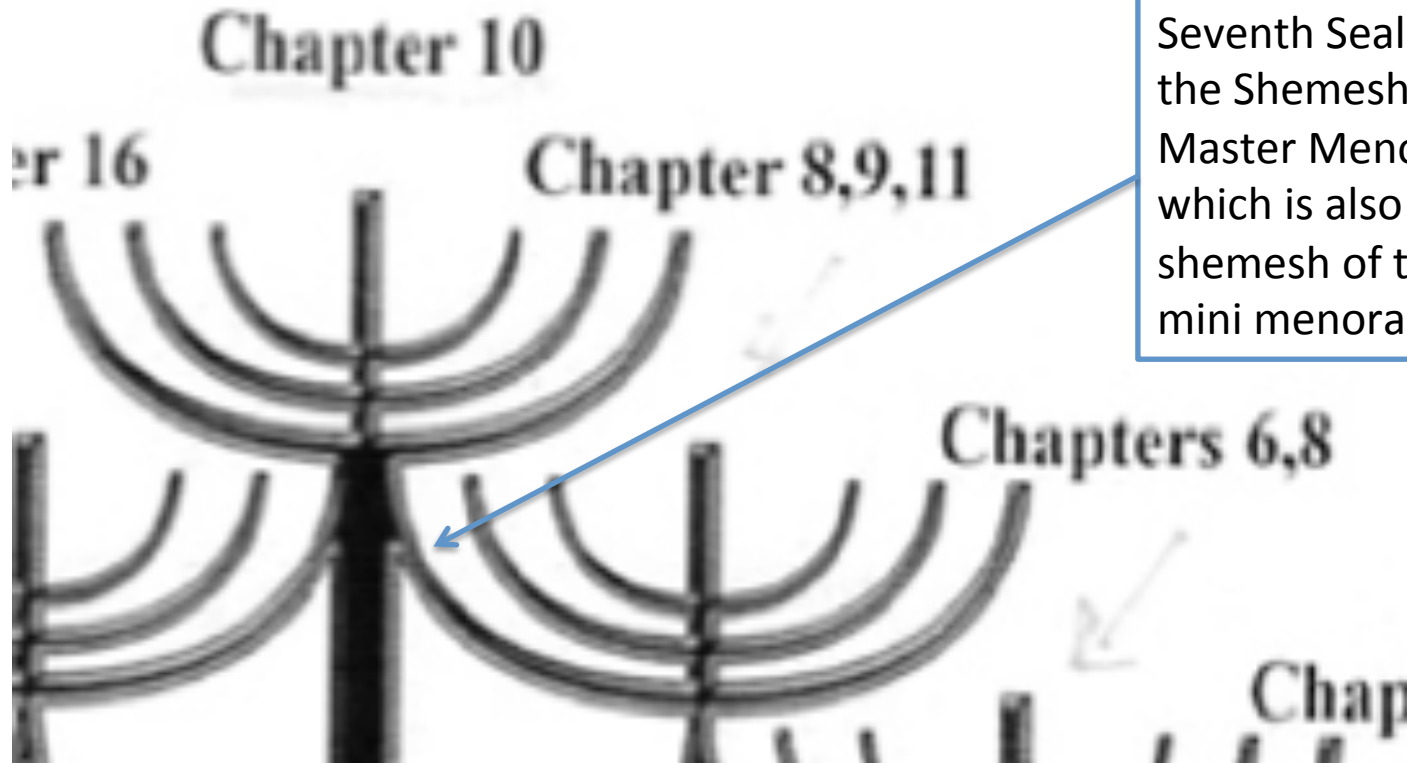

# Seventh Seal



Seventh Seal leads to the Shemesh of the Master Menorah which is also the shemesh of the Forth mini menorah

Notice that the Seventh Seal leads to the 4<sup>th</sup> mini menorah

# Significance of the Seventh Seal

- The entire Ketubah is unveiled
- The Bridegroom is with the Bride in the marriage chamber
- The fourth cup is about to be drunk
- The Marriage supper of the Lamb is on hand –  
Rev 19:9

# Chapter 8

- Significance of the half an hour silence
- There are two worship services
- One in the morning and the second one is in the evening
- After the second service the last trumpet (7<sup>th</sup> Trumpet) will be blown and then the doors of the temple will shut
- This signifies the commencement of the Great Tribulation

# Sixth and the Seventh Seal

- Nested within the Sixth and the Seventh Seal
  - Are the Seven Trumpets
- The Sixth Trumpet is the Ezekiel 38-39 war
- Sixth Trumpet has two events
  - Ezekiel 38-39 war
  - The Two witnesses
- The two Witness is the 1<sup>st</sup> period of the seven years tribulation

# Chapter 10

- In this chapter we have the 7 Thunders.
- This chapter is unique because it is the mini menorah chapter as well.
- It describes Yeshua in the first 7 verses and it is the shamash of the entire master menorah.
- The message of the entire Bible is wrapped up in this chapter – the Messiah.
- The thunders identify the groom Himself, in all His glory.
- Yeshua is coming down from heaven to explain the terms of the wedding covenant and define who will be His Bride.
- The thunders represent the Torah or the principle of righteous living, by which Yeshua can identify the Bride.
- Now the little book (scroll) is opened (Ketubah) and the principle by which the Bride shall live by is to be clearly seen by all.



# Coming on the Clouds

- Matt 24:30 – “...son of man coming on the clouds of the sky...”
- Genesis 9:16-17 – God speaks of the rainbow as the sign of His everlasting covenant.
- Rev 4:3 – apostle John sees a rainbow surrounding the throne of God..
- Rev 1:13-16 – describes Yeshua the Messiah in detail...
- Rev 10:2 – Yeshua lands his right foot on the sea and His left foot on the land. “Sea” denotes mankind and “land” denotes death or the grave.
- HE has authority over the living and the dead.
- The above reveals that Yeshua back (against) is facing north, which is the Gog country (Russia).
- This N-S orientation is exactly the orientation of the mountains on which blessings and curses were read (Mt Ebal and Mt Gerazim). Blessings and curses - Deut 28.

# The Thunders

- What is a thunder? – “ra’am” “to rage, to roar, to be angry, to tremble”
- Blowing the shofar is itself a type of thunder.
  - God blows His Spirit into us and we respond by breathing back His Spirit through the shofar.
  - The shofar is used to celebrate, to announce the sacrifices and a call to war.
- The implication in Rev 10 is Yeshua the Groom is coming forth to defend His Bride against Gog, the ones who are cursed.
- John is commanded to “seal up the words” in contrast to Rev 1:19
- However in Rev 1:19 is “to write up what you have seen” not “what you have heard”
- There are both written Torah and oral Torah
- To seal up the oral Torah is to live out the principles of the Torah, by carefully and consistently observing God’s teachings and instructions. Integrating His divine wisdom into our very souls. By doing this we place a guard around our hearts even as we guard His Word – Phil 4:7

# Revelation 10:5

- No angel ever swear – Matt 5:34-36, James 5:12 we are instructed not to swear either by heaven or by earth.
- However, the one that spoke is Yeshua.
- Rev 10:6 & 1 Cor 15:50-52; 1 Th 4:16-17
- The mystery of God that will be revealed is none other than the harvesting of the Bride.
- In Rev 11:15 – after the death and resurrection of the two witnesses, the seventh trumpet sounds.
- Yeshua then comes as a Groom to snatch away His Bride.
- There are three separate Harvests (Raptures).
- The seventh Trumpet and the last tract of the Mishnah deals with customs of ritual purities and impurities.
- The Bride's promise is to keep herself pure. – Rev 19:7

# Rev 10:8-11

- Ancient Hebrew custom – when Jewish children first entered the classroom to learn Torah, the rabbi would ask them to spread honey on a small corner of a page in their Torah. They would then tear the corner off and eat it.
- The Torah tastes sweet when it enters the mouth. But, when it reaches our inner parts where our flesh resides, it turns sour because our flesh is at war with God’s holy and righteous commands.
- You must make God’s word a part of your soul to properly prophesy.
- Deut 11:26-28 Obeying God’s command results in blessings, disobedience bring curses.
- The seven Thunders are the Mishnah and the B’rit Hadashah. They are thundered forth by Yeshua Himself, identifying His Bride and also calling to war against those who oppose her.
