








#### The Feasts of the Lord

- Tabernacles






#### Three Harvests in Israel

- Rev 7 the **Harvest** of the 144,000 groomsmen
  - Firstfruits
- 5<sup>th</sup> proclamation **Harvest** of the Bride
  - Pentecost (Shavuot)
- 6<sup>th</sup> proclamation **Harvest** of the Martyrs

### Harvest of the Holy Spirit & the Bride

- Shavout Pentecost Wheat harvest in late Spring (Holy Spirit)
  - 50 days is the Feats of Shavout
  - 2 Thess 2:7 "For the mystery of lawlessness is already at work; only He who now restrains will do so until He is taken out of the way."
  - 4<sup>th</sup> & 5<sup>th</sup> proclamations
  - The harvest of the Bride, the Seventh Trumpet (5<sup>th</sup> Angel proclamation) 1
     Cor 15:51-52, 1Thess 4:13-18
- Feasts of Trumpet Wet harvest, early autumn, harvest of grapes, citrus, and pomegranates (Jesus returns)




### Cont'd

- We also know that these two witnesses are given authority to govern and to bring judgments to mankind for 3 1/2 years, the first half of the last seven years prophesized in Daniel 9:27.
- These two witnesses are described in Rev 11 and ministered during the first half of the seven years tribulation period.
- All the bowl judgments fulfill the last half of Daniel's seven year prophecy and God's work will then be finished and the 1,000 years reign will begin.
- This strongly supports the idea that God will meet His groomsmen on Mt Zion somewhere very close to the beginning of the seventh trumpet, just before the snatching of the Bride.

### The Seven Angelic Proclamations

- These angels appeared one after another, giving last warning and directions to those who dwell on the earth.
- God sends His angels to do the final evangelistic call.
- The second proclamation informs us that Babylon the Great harlot has fallen.
- The third proclamation warns "If anyone worships the beats and his image and receives his mark on the forehead or upon the hand, he will also drink the wine of the wrath of God".
- The Shamash Angel, is the fourth and is not an actual angel but the Lord Yeshua.
- The fifth proclamation is the harvest of the Bride.
- The sixth proclamation is the harvest of the Martyrs.
- The seventh proclamation is the release of the seven bowls

Thunders




#### Cont'd

- As we begin Rev 15 (Bowl), only 3 groups will be left on earth: the guests (martyrs), the unbelievers and the fallen angels with their offspring, the nephilim.
- The fallen angels and nephilim have never had their names written in the book of life nor were they ever invited.
- At the sounding of the *sixth* angelic proclamation, the seven bowls are about to be poured out upon the earth. During this time which last 3 ½ years, (42 months) the martyrs will suffer at the hand of the ruler of the earth, the False Messiah.

#### Cont'd

- The sixth angelic proclamation happens sometime after the seventh trumpet and before pouring of the seven bowls of God's judgment.
- We know that the beast or the false messiah presents himself to the world by sitting on God's throne in His temple in Jerusalem after the two witnesses are killed and harvested, the harvest of the Bride, the sounding of the seventh trumpet and the opening of the seventh Seal.
- The temple would have been completed by then.



- Yeshua in Rev 14:14 bearing His sickle is coming to earth to harvest and is arriving in the clouds Acts 1:9-11.
- This harvest occurred at the seventh trumpet and is also a reference to the parables in the book of Matthew that refer to the best harvest (the wheat harvest) which is celebrated on Shavout (Pentecost)
- Rev 14, we saw the first harvest and referred to it as Firstfuits, representing the Barley harvest which we identify as the 144,000 groomsmen.
- The seventh trumpet is the snatching of the Bride and the Hebrew wedding is to follow Rev 11:15-19. God is proclaiming the coming marriage between Himself and His Bride (The second harvest).
- The seventh trumpet is the announcement of the marriage just before the first bowl of judgment is poured out on the remaining earthly inhabitants.
- Rev 11:19 the doors of the Temple are thrown opened, at the same time of the corrupting of the temple through the Abomination of Desolation set up by the false messiah as mentioned in Daniel's prophesy.

- Recorded in Mishnah, the Temple veil was rent and its doors were thrown open in AD30, just after the death of Yeshua.
- The incidence in AD30 signifies that the Temple had become an abomination through the corrupt leadership of the Sadducees.
- Shavuot is the feats where God gave the Torah on Mount Sinai and made Israel His bride.
- It is also during this feast that HE will come back for HIS Bride
  1 Thess 4:13-18; 1 Cor 15:51-52.
- The fifth angelic proclamation is describing the Messiah, riding on the clouds as described in Acts 1. He again has a sickle for harvest. Rev 14:16 represents the wheat harvest. The sixth and seventh proclamations are associated with the harvest of believers (rapture).

### Yeshua 2<sup>nd</sup> Return


- Yeshua second coming occurs in three phases.
  - Feast of Firstfruits for His groomsmen
  - Feasts of Shavuot for His Bride Acts 1 and 1 Cor. 15:51-
  - Feast of Trumpets Rev 14:19-20 HE returns on a white horse to defeat the armies of Satan – Rev 19

### Song of Moses and Song of the Lamb

- In heaven, we see a group of people before the throne of God worshipping and singing two songs.
- These songs in OT the Israelites sang to God praising Him for delivering and redeeming (Exodus 15:1-3 vs Rev 15) & (Deut 31:30, 32:1-4)
- Sea represents nations, mankind and or different people groups.

  These are people harvested at the seventh trumpet 1 Cor 15:51-52
- Both of these 2 songs were sung only on Shabbat, the day of rest, which heralds the thousand-year reign





#### Rev 22:1-4

And he showed me a pure river of water of life, clear as crystal, proceeding from the throne of God and of the Lamb. In the middle of its street, and on either side of the river, was the tree of life, which bore twelve fruits, each tree yielding its fruit every month. The leaves of the tree were for the healing of the nations. And there shall be no more curse, but the throne of God and of the Lamb shall be in it, and His servants shall serve Him. They shall see His face, and His name shall be on their foreheads. There shall be no night there: They need no lamp nor light of the sun, for the Lord God gives them light. And they shall reign forever and ever.

### Rev 22:7,12,14-15,17,20


- "Behold, I am **coming quickly**! Blessed *is* he who keeps the words of the prophecy of this book."
