
When the Bridegroom comes,

Rev 21:9-13

- ⁹ Then ***one of the seven angels*** who had the seven bowls filled with the seven last plagues came to me and talked with me, saying, “Come, I will show you the bride, the Lamb’s wife.” ¹⁰ And he carried me away in the Spirit to a great and high mountain, and showed me the ***great city***, the ***holy Jerusalem***, descending out of heaven from God, ¹¹ having the glory of God. Her light *was* like a most precious stone, like a jasper stone, clear as crystal. ¹² Also she had a great and high wall with **twelve gates**, and twelve angels at the gates, and names written on them, which are *the names* of **the twelve tribes** of the children of Israel: ¹³ three gates on the east, three gates on the north, three gates on the south, and three gates on the west.

THE DAY OF THE LORD



Rev 21:22-27

- ²² But I saw no temple in it, for the Lord God Almighty and the Lamb are its temple. ²³ The city had ***no need of the sun or of the moon*** to shine in it, for ***the glory of God illuminated it***. The Lamb *is* its light. ²⁴ And the nations of those who are saved shall walk in its light, and the ***kings of the earth bring their glory and honor into it***. ²⁵ Its gates shall not be shut at all by day (there shall be no night there). ²⁶ And they shall bring the glory and the honor of the nations into it. ²⁷ But there shall by ***no means enter it anything that defiles, or causes an abomination or a lie***, but ***only those who are written in the Lamb's Book of Life***.

The Nations Worship the King

- "16 And it shall come to pass *that* everyone who is left of all the nations which came against Jerusalem shall go up from year to year to **worship the King**, the LORD of hosts, and to **keep the Feast of Tabernacles**. 17 And it shall be *that* whichever of the families of the earth do not come up to Jerusalem to worship the King, the LORD of hosts, on them there will be no rain."-Zech 14:16-17

Rewards from the LORD

- Matthew 25:21 “²¹ His lord said to him, ‘Well *done*, good and faithful servant; you were faithful over a few things, I will make you ruler over many things. Enter into the joy of your lord.’
- Philippians 3:13-14 – “¹³ Brethren, I do not count myself to have apprehended; but one thing *I do*, forgetting those things which are behind and reaching forward to those things which are ahead, ¹⁴ I press toward the ***goal for the prize*** of the upward call of God in Christ Jesus.

John 10:27-30

- ²⁷ My sheep hear My voice, and I know them, and they follow Me. ²⁸ And I give them eternal life, and they shall never perish; neither shall anyone snatch them out of My hand. ²⁹ My Father, who has given *them* to Me, is greater than all; and no one is able to snatch *them* out of My Father's hand. ³⁰ I and *My* Father are one."



Matthew 6:19-20

- ¹⁹ “Do not lay up for yourselves treasures on earth, where moth and rust destroy and where thieves break in and steal; ²⁰ but lay up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where neither moth nor rust destroys and where thieves do not break in and steal.
- The ***Crown*** we receive will depend on the quality of service or work we do for the Kingdom of God

Five Type of Crowns

1. The **Incorruptible Crown**

- 1 Cor 9:24-25 “²⁴ Do you not know that those who run in a race all run, but one receives the prize? Run in such a way that you may obtain *it*. ²⁵ And everyone who competes *for the prize* is temperate (***Self control***) in all things. Now they *do it* to obtain a perishable crown, but we *for* an ***imperishable crown***.”

Five Type of Crowns

2. Crown of Righteousness

- ❖⁸ Finally, there is laid up for me the ***crown of righteousness***, which the Lord, the righteous Judge, will give to me on that Day, and not to me only but also to all who have loved His appearing.
- ❖ This Crown is obtained through FAITH in HIM for is righteous
- ❖ For Righteousness is Imputed to us who believe

Five Type of Crowns

3. The Crown of LIFE

- ❖ Rev 2:10 “¹⁰ Do not fear any of those things which you are about to suffer. Indeed, the devil is about to throw *some* of you into prison, that you may be tested, and you will have tribulation ten days. Be faithful until death, and I will give you the ***crown of life***.”
- ❖ Give to those who endure sufferings and prevailed
- ❖ To the Martyrs
- ❖ James 1:12 “¹² Blessed *is* the man who endures temptation; for when he has been approved, he will receive the ***crown of life*** which the Lord has promised to those who love Him.”

The Baptism of Suffering

- ²⁵ Three times I was beaten with rods; once I was stoned; three times I was shipwrecked; a night and a day I have been in the deep; ²⁶ *in* journeys often, *in* perils of waters, *in* perils of robbers, *in* perils of *my own* countrymen, *in* perils of the Gentiles, *in* perils in the city, *in* perils in the wilderness, *in* perils in the sea, *in* perils among false brethren; ²⁷ in weariness and toil, in sleeplessness often, in hunger and thirst, in fastings often, in cold and nakedness—2 Cor 11:25-27

Five Type of Crowns

4. The Crown of Glory

- ❖ 1 Peter 5:1-4 “The ***elders*** who are among you I exhort, I who am a fellow elder and a witness of the sufferings of Christ, and also a partaker of the ***glory*** that will be revealed: Shepherd the flock of God which is among you, serving as **overseers**, not by compulsion but willingly, **not for dishonest gain** but eagerly; ³ nor as being lords over those entrusted to you, but being **examples to the flock**; ⁴ and when the Chief Shepherd appears, you will receive the ***crown of glory*** that does not fade away.”
- ❖ For those who shepherd the flock, the Five-fold Ministry
- ❖ Those who preaches the Gospel of the Kingdom of God

Five Type of Crowns

- Crown of Rejoicing

- ❖ 1 Thess 2:15 “¹⁹ For what *is* our **hope**, or **joy**, or *crown of rejoicing*? *Is it* not even you in the presence of our Lord Jesus Christ at His coming?

- ❖ Phil 4:1 “Therefore, my beloved and longed-for brethren, my joy and crown, so stand fast in the Lord, beloved.”

- ❖ For every believer who believes in the death, resurrection and ascension of Yeshua.

What Do We Become...in Heaven

- We were not be transformed into angels
- ³⁹ All flesh *is* not the same flesh, but *there is one kind of* flesh of men, another flesh of animals, another of fish, *and* another of birds. ⁴⁰ *There are* also celestial bodies and terrestrial bodies; but the glory of the celestial *is* one, and the *glory* of the terrestrial *is* another. ⁴¹ *There is* one glory of the sun, another glory of the moon, and another glory of the stars; for *one* star differs from *another* star in glory. ⁴² So also *is* the resurrection of the dead. *The body* is sown in corruption, it is raised in incorruption. ⁴³ It is sown in dishonor, it is raised in glory. It is sown in weakness, it is raised in power. ⁴⁴ It is sown a natural body, it is raised a spiritual body. There is a natural body, and there is a spiritual body.” 1 Cor 15:39-44
