








Revelation 4:1


4 After these things I looked, and behold, a door standing open in heaven.

- The Awesome privilege
 - Jehovah GOD is Sovereign (Daniel 4:34-35)
 - Holy (Isaiah 6:1-3)
 - Eternal, Omnipotent, Omniscient
 - Glorious, Resplendent
 - Just, Righteous, Loving, Wrathful, Patient... and more!

OUR INTIMATE PRIVILEGE

- Jesus taught us in the Sermon of the Mount
 - the expression "your Father" 15 times!
 - how to pray "'OUR FATHER in Heaven...'" - Matthew 6:9
 - "see" the Father by looking at HIM (Jesus) John 14:7-11
 - He had revealed the Father to His disciples John 17:6, 26
 - He spoke to Mary, "I am returning to my Father and your Father, to my God and your God." – John 20:17





Principle of First Mentioned

- "So, Joseph went up to bury his father; and with him went up all the servants of Pharaoh, the **elders** of his house, and all the **elders** of the land of Egypt," Genesis 50:7
- "So, when they had appointed elders in every church, and prayed with fasting, they commended them to the Lord in whom they had believed." – Acts 14:23
- "And as they went through the cities, they delivered to them the decrees to keep, which were determined by the apostles and **elders** at Jerusalem." Acts 16:4

No Bible Reference that there are 12 elders from the Tribe of Israel and 12 disciples of Yeshua

Revelation 4:6-8

⁶ Before the throne there was a sea of glass, like crystal. And in the midst of the throne, and around the throne, were four living creatures full of eyes in front and in back. ⁷ The first living creature was like a lion, the second living creature like a calf, the third living creature had a face like a man, and the fourth living creature was like a flying eagle.

⁸ The four living creatures, each having six wings, were full of eyes around and within. And they do not rest day or night, saying:

"Holy, holy, Lord God Almighty, Who was and is and is to come!"



Number FOUR – Four Living Creatures

- Represents Yeshua in the Menorah, the fourth light, the shamesh light
- Represents complete four corners of the earth, four points in the compass, four gospels, Matthew, Mark, Luke and John

Ezekiel 1:5-9


⁵ Also from within it *came* the likeness of four living creatures. And this was their appearance: they had the likeness of *a man*. ⁶ Each one had *four faces*, and each *one had four wings*. ⁷ Their legs *were* straight, and the soles of their feet were like the **soles of calves' feet**. They sparkled like the *color of burnished* bronze. 8 The hands of a man were under their wings on their four sides; and each of the four had faces and wings. 9 Their wings touched one another. The creatures did not turn when they went, but each one went straight forward.





Ezekiel 1:10-11

¹⁰ As for the likeness of their faces, each had the face of a man; each of the four had the face of a lion on the right side, each of the four had the face of an ox on the left side, and each of the four had the *face of an* eagle. 11 Thus were their faces. Their wings stretched upward; two wings of each one touched one another, and two covered their bodies.




Ezekiel 1:12-14

¹² And each one went straight forward; they went wherever the spirit wanted to go, and they did not turn when they went. 13 As for the likeness of the living creatures, their appearance was like burning coals of fire, like the appearance of torches going back and forth among the living creatures. The fire was bright, and out of the fire went *lightning.* ¹⁴ And the living creatures ran back and forth, in appearance like a flash of lightning.



Ezekiel 1:15-18


15 Now as I looked at the living creatures, behold, a wheel was on the earth beside each living creature with its four faces. 16 The appearance of the wheels and their workings was like the color of beryl, and all four had the same likeness. The appearance of their workings was, as it were, a wheel in the middle of a wheel. 17 When they moved, they went toward any one of four directions; they did not turn aside when they went. ¹⁸ As for their rims, they were so high they were awesome: and their rims were full of eyes, all around the four of them.





Revelation 4:9-11

⁹ Whenever the living creatures *give glory and honor* and *thanks* to Him who sits on the throne, who lives forever and ever, ¹⁰ the *twenty-four elders fall down* before Him who sits on the throne and worship Him who lives forever and ever, and cast their crowns before the throne, saying: ¹¹ "You are worthy, O Lord, To receive glory and honor and power; For *You created all things*, And by *Your will* they exist and were created."

- Glory and honor and power.

Revelation 5:1-4

5 And I saw in the right hand of Him who sat on the throne a scroll written inside and on the back, sealed with seven seals. 2 Then I saw a strong angel proclaiming with a loud voice, "Who is worthy to open the scroll and to loose its seals?" 3 And no one in heaven or on the earth or under the earth was able to open the scroll, or to look at it. 4 So I wept much, because no one was found worthy to open and read the scroll, or to look at it.



Jewish Betrothal Procedure

- 1. Jewish father goes to the potential home of the bride with his son
- 2. They bring gifts for the potential bride. There are gifts
 - 1. from the Father (John 14:16, Heb 2:4 Holy Spirit)
 - 2. (1 Cor 12:28 gift of healings, helps, administration, and varieties of tongues)
 - 3. The best gift is Love (1 Cor 13:13)
 - 4. from Yeshua (Eph 4:11 apostles, prophets, evangelists, pastors and teachers)
- 3. They are invited into the home of the bride
- 4. Fellowship with the bride extended family First cup (Sanctification)
- 5. Sit down with the bride father to negotiate terms Second cup (Betrothal)

Jewish Betrothal Procedure

- Document the agreements in the Scroll (Ketubah) sealed with seven seals – Third Cup (Cup of Inheritance) reference to The Ten Commandments
- 7. Bridegroom and father gives gifts (Ephesians 4:8) to the bride and depart to their home
- 8. The father keeps the Ketubah and the son prepares a home-room for the bride John 14:2
- 9. Seals are opened only by the Bridegroom on the night of consummation of the marriage. Fourth Cup (Cup of Praise) Matthew 26:29




Revelation 5:5-7






Revelation 5:8-10
