

Yeshua is now seated at the right hand of GOD and opening the Seals, one at a time. Only when the Seventh Seal is opened, will the Bride join HIM in the marriage chamber

- Israel is Jehovah Wife Tablet of Stone, Ketubah opened, no seals
- 2. Bride is Yeshua future Wife Scroll with Seven Seals
- 3. Church is Yeshua's Body

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Revelation 6:1

6 Now I saw when the Lamb opened **one of the seals**; and I heard one of the **four living creatures** saying with a voice like thunder, "**Come and see**."



The Four Living Creatures

Rev 4:8a – "The four living creatures, each having six wings, were full of eyes around and within…"

Ezekiel 10:9 vs Ezekiel 1:5vs Rev 4:8 (Four Living Creatures)

- And when I looked, there were four wheels by the cherubim, one wheel by one cherub and another wheel by each other cherub; the wheels appeared to have the color of a beryl stone.
 - Beryl stone is one of the stones in the throne, like emerald -Rev 4:3





Hierarchy of Angels

Three separate "orders" - hierarchy

- Cherubim Genesis 3:24, Ps 91:1, Eze 10:5 – Archangels - Four Living Creatures – Rev 5:6-8
- Seraphim Isaiah 6:2 with six wings – Burning Ones or Healing Angels (Messengers)
- Teraphim Lowest form Heb 13:2 (Watchers) Fallen Teraphim are known as idols (objects of worship). Genesis 6 – Fallen angels have sex with daughters of man – Offsprings are the Nephilim

Cherubim -Archangels

Archangels (Cherubim)

- Michael Warrior (Prince) of God – Prince of Israel
- Gabriel Redeemer of God
- Raphael Healer of God
- Uriel Light of God
- Lucifer Cherub of Light
- Abaddon Cherub of Life (Death)



Lucifer – Cherub who fell – Ezekiel 28:13-19

¹³ You were in Eden, the garden of God;
Every precious stone was your covering:
The sardius, topaz, and diamond, beryl, onyx, and jasper, sapphire, turquoise, and emerald with gold.
The workmanship of your timbrels and pipes
Was prepared for you on the day you were created.

¹⁴ "You were the **anointed cherub** who covers; I established you; You were on the holy mountain of God; You walked back and forth in the midst of fiery stones.

¹⁵ You were **perfect in your wa**ys from the day you were created, till iniquity was found in you.

¹⁶ "By the abundance of your trading You became filled with violence within, And you sinned; Therefore, I cast you as a profane thing, out of the mountain of God; And I destroyed you, O covering cherub, From the midst of the fiery stones.

17 "Your heart was lifted up because of your beauty; You corrupted your wisdom for the sake of your splendour;
I cast you to the ground, I laid you before kings, that they might gaze at you.

¹⁸ "You defiled your sanctuaries By the multitude of your iniquities, By the iniquity of your trading; Therefore, I brought fire from your midst; It devoured you, and I turned you to ashes upon the earth In the sight of all who saw you.
¹⁹ All who knew you among the peoples are astonished at you; You have become a horror, And *shall be* no more forever."

Teraphim – Genesis 6

- Book of Enoch
 - 200 of Satan's fallen angels (teraphim) lead by one named Samyaza
 - Seduced daughters of man
 - Offspring Hybrid of devils and humans called Nephilim (plural of nephal)
- Where did demon come from?
 - Demon is the disembodied soul of a dead nephal or unclean spirits
 - Demons always see to reside inside something living story of Mark 5 "Demonpossessed man healed"
- "⁷ And as you go, preach, saying, 'The kingdom of heaven is at hand.' ⁸ Heal the sick, cleanse the lepers, raise the dead, *cast out demons*. Freely you have received, freely give." Matt 10:7-8; Mark 3:14-15; Luke 9:1

Revelation 6:2

² And I looked, and behold, *a white horse*. He who sat on it had a *bow*; and *a crown was given to him*, and he *went out conquering and to conquer*.

Mainstream Interpretation of the White Horse

- The Rider on the White Horse is a deceiver.
- The Rider has a Bow but no Arrows
- Deception comes after Yeshua's cruxification
 - Birth of Islam
- What does Scripture say?
- We need to return to Scripture
 - Principle of First Mentioned
 - Scripture interprets Scripture
 - Precept upon precept

What Does Scripture Say?

- White (leukos Strong's G3022) which means
 - Light, bright, brilliant
 - Of garments of angels and of those exalted to the splendor of the heavenly state
 - As a sign of innocence and purity of the soul
 - Whitening colour of ripening grain
- Crown (stephanos Strong's G4735) which means
 - A mark of royal or exalted rank
 - Wreath or garland which was given as a prize to victors in public games
 - A reward given to genuine servants of God
 - A reward of righteousness

What Does Scripture Say?

- Bow the ancient Greek archer's tool of war is **G5115 τόξον** (toxon)
- A word represents both bow and arrow.
- Bow root word is **G5088 τίκτω** (tik'-to) which means
 - To bring forth 9X,
 - Of a woman giving birth 3X
 - Be delivered 5X
 - *Be in travail* 1X
 - *Bear fruit* 1X

What Does Scripture Say?

- "and he went out conquering and to conquer" Rev 6:2b
- The word for "conquering and to conquer" has the same Concordance number as Overcome G3528 νικάω (nik-ah'-o)
- "To him who overcomes..." the ending phrase before the Reward in each Letter to the Seven Churches
 - to carry off the victory, come off victorious
 - of Christ, victorious over all His foes
 - of Christians, that hold fast their faith even unto death against the power of their foes, and temptations and persecutions

Now To Put These Understanding together

- The Rider On the White Horse takes on a very different meaning
 - White Horse Righteousness
 - Rider with Bow (with Arrows) Bring forth new birth, or to bear fruit
 - Crown Victor's crown, crown of reward for work done
 - Conquering and to conquer Are Overcomers
 - The concluding verse in all the Seven Letters
 - "To him who overcomes, I will grant ..."



Compare These Two Persons

Revelation 19:11-16

• ¹¹ Now I saw heaven opened, and behold, a white horse. And He who sat on him was called Faithful and True, and in *righteousness* He *judges* and makes war. ¹² His eyes were like a flame of fire, and on *His head were many crowns*. He had a name written that no one knew except Himself. ¹³ He was clothed with a robe dipped in blood, and His name is called *The Word of God*. ¹⁴ And *the armies in heaven*, clothed in fine linen, white and clean, followed Him on white horses. ¹⁵ Now out of *His mouth goes a sharp sword*, that with it He should strike the nations. And He Himself will rule them with a rod of iron. He *Himself* treads the winepress of the fierceness and wrath of Almighty **God.** ¹⁶ And He has on *His* robe and on His thigh a name written: **KING OF KINGS AND** LORD OF LORDS.

Revelation 6:3-4

³ When He opened the second seal, I heard the second living creature saying, "Come and see." ⁴ Another horse, *fiery red*, went out. And it was granted to the one who sat on it **to take** peace from the earth, and that people should kill one another; and there was given to him a **great sword**.



Sword – Strong's G3162

- G3162 derived from **G3163 μάχη (**makh'-ay)
- a fight or combat
 - of those in arms, a battle
 - of persons at variance, disputants etc., strife, contention
 - a quarrel

Same "sword" referred to in Matt 10:34 & Luke 12:49

Notice that the riders on the *Red and the Pale Horses* are *"Granted" power*. They could only do when God permits. Unlike the riders of *White and Black Horses* only describe what the *riders are carrying out* or the items they are given

Bringing the Gospel...Matt 24:14

- There is a PRICE to pay
 - Persecution, to the point of being martyred
 - Wars in diverse places
- The Red Horse also presents the spirit of the Antichrist
- Notice it is always God who gives the power for the enemies to act
 - ⁵ And he was given a mouth speaking great things and blasphemies, and he was given authority to continue for forty-two months." Rev 13:5
 - ⁷ It was granted to him to make war with the saints and to overcome them.
 And authority was given him over every tribe, tongue, and nation." Rev 13:7

Revelation 6:5-6

⁵ When He opened the third seal, I heard the third living creature say, "Come and see." So, I looked, and behold, a **black** *horse*, and he who sat on it had a pair of scales in his hand. ⁶ And I heard a voice in the midst of the four living creatures saying, "A quart (measure) of wheat for *a denarius*, and *three* quarts(three measure) of barley for a denarius; and do not harm the *oil and the wine.*"



Pair of Scale

- Measurement of Justice
- The Scales are balances by one common denominator – One Day's wage – One denarius



What Does Barley Represents in the OT

- Barley in the OT represents God's *deliverance, protection and abundance* provision
- "then the man shall bring his wife to the priest. He shall bring the offering required for her, one-tenth of an ephah of **barley** meal; he shall pour no oil on it and put no frankincense on it, because it *is* a *grain offering of jealousy*, an offering for remembering, for bringing iniquity to remembrance." Numbers 5:15 – *Deliverance from Jealousy*
- The Exodus story Exo 9:25-26 9:31 Goshen was spared during the Barley harvest
- Story of Ruth 1 They returned at the beginning of the Barley harvest which gave them abundant provision

Temple Worship & First Fruits

- Used as part of Temple worship during Biblical times
- When the barley had ripened, a single sheaf of barley was waved before the Lord at the first glimpse of dawn
 - Signifies the beginning of harvest
- The barley sheaf was offered up with a sacrificial lamb and presented to the LORD as the *"first fruits"*
- Barley represents the First Fruits and those who believe in Yeshua and receive the gift of Salvation

One Quart & Three Quarts

- First mention of "one measure (quart)
 - Exodus 16:4 one measure (quota) of manna
- First mention of "three measures (quarts)" appears in Genesis 18:6
 - "⁶ So Abraham hurried into the tent to Sarah and said, "Quickly, make ready three measures of fine meal; knead *it* and make cakes."
 - One of the three men told Sarah that she will have a son
- One quart (measure)
 - Manna Bread deliverance from hunger/Bread from Heaven Exodus 16:4
 - The window's son resurrected 1 Kgs 17:7-24
 - Lepers and Israel deliverance rom hunger and death/Food from Heaven 2 Kgs 7:16
- Three quarts (three measures):
 - Abraham promise of a son, the first of many sons Genesis 18:6
 - Hannah Prayer for a son deliverance from barrenness 1 Sam 1:20

One quart and Three quarts

- The One quart, Three quarts, represent
 - Message of deliverance,
 - Resurrection,
 - Abundant new life through Yeshua,
 - Provisions Bread of Life,
 - Many sons both Jews and Gentiles

Wheat and Barley

- Wheat represents those chosen to rule
 - Qualifies in one measure
 - The chief grain, appointed to rule and of excellent quality
 - Delivered, resurrected and given the Bread of Life
- Barley represents Overcomers through Yeshua
 - Qualifies in three measures
 - Marked, sealed and of especially excellent quality
 - Yeshua the First of Many Sons

Third Horse (Black)

- Oil represents the Holy Spirit
- Wine represents blood of Yeshua and the new covenant
- "do not harm the oil and the wine" Rev 6:6b
 - The wheat and the barley are kept safe by the oil and the wine
- The grains, oil and wine are weighed before they are brought into the Temple as an offering
- We are also weighed by the scale symbolized by the rider of the black horse – 1 Peter 4:17 (Judgement begins with the house of the Lord)
- "Behold, the days are coming," says the Lord GOD,
 "That I will send a famine on the land, Not a famine of bread,
 Nor a thirst for water, But of hearing the words of the LORD." Amos 8:11 A famine of understanding is here

What Does the Rider of the Black Horse Do?

• Represents

- God's Justice represented by the Scale of Justice through Yeshua, the judgment of God's people
- Barley represents God's deliverance, Protection, Resurrection and Provisions
- Wheat represents Yeshua together with those who receive Him as their Savior

The Four Horses of Zechariah – Chapter 6

- Helps me to reconcile the verse from Zechariah 6:1-6
- 6 Then I turned and raised my eyes and looked, and behold, four chariots were coming from between two mountains, and the mountains were mountains of bronze. ² With the first chariot were red horses, with the second chariot black horses, ³ with the third chariot white horses, and with the fourth chariot dappled horses—strong steeds. ⁴ Then I answered and said to the angel who talked with me, "What are these, my lord?"⁵ And the angel answered and said to me, "These are four spirits of heaven, who go out from their station before the Lord of all the earth. ⁶ The one with the black horses is going to the north country (Babylon), the white are going after them, and the dappled are going toward the south country." Zech 6:1-6
- ⁴ And I heard another voice from heaven saying, "Come out of her, my people, lest you share in her sins, and lest you receive of her plagues." – Rev 18:4



Revelation 6:7-8

⁷ When He opened the fourth seal, I heard the voice of the fourth living creature saying, "Come and see." ⁸ So I looked, and behold, *a pale horse*. And the name of him *who sat on it was Death*, and *Hades followed with him*.

And power was given to them over *a fourth of the earth*, to kill *with sword*, with *hunger*, with *death*, and by the *beasts of the earth*.

The Pale Horse

- The Rider on the Pale Horse represents the beginning of judgment on those who are with the Mystery Babylon
- This rider comes in its intensity at the Great Tribulation of the Dragon
- Again, you notice "power" is given to the rider
- One fourth of the world would suffer and die
- The "beasts" could be viruses
- ⁶ The one with the black horses is going to the north country (Babylon), the white are going after them, and the *dappled (pale)* are going toward the *south country*." – Zech 6:6



Revelation 6:9-10

⁹ When He opened *the fifth* seal, I saw under the altar the souls of those who had been slain for the word of God and for the testimony which they held. ¹⁰ And they cried with a loud voice, saying, "How long, **O Lord,** holy and true, until You judge and *avenge our blood* on those who dwell on the earth?"

Revelation 6:11

¹¹ Then a *white robe* was given to each of them; and it was said to them that they should *rest a little while longer*, until *both the number of* their *fellow servants* and *their brethren*, who would be killed as they *were*, *was completed*.



Revelation 6:12 ¹²I looked when He opened *the sixth seal*, and behold, there was a *great earthquake*; and the *sun became black* as sackcloth of hair, and the *moon became like blood*.

Revelation 6:13

¹³ And the *stars* of heaven fell to the earth, as *a fig tree drops* its late figs when it is *shaken by a mighty wind*.

"And He said to them, "I saw **Satan** fall like **lightning** from heaven." – Luke 10:18



Revelation 6:14

¹⁴ Then the *sky receded as a scroll* when it is rolled up, and every *mountain and island* was moved out of its place.



Isaiah 2:2-4

Now it shall come to pass in the latter days *That* the mountain of the LORD's house Shall be *established on the top of the mountains*,

And shall be exalted above the hills; And all nations shall flow to it. ³ Many people shall come and say,

"Come, and let us go up to the mountain of the LORD,

To the house of the God of Jacob; He will teach us His ways, And we shall walk in His paths."

For out of Zion shall go forth the law, And

the word of the LORD from Jerusalem. ⁴ He shall judge between the nations, And rebuke many people; They shall **beat their swords into plowshares**,

And their *spears into pruning hooks; Nation shall not lift up sword against nation,* Neither shall they learn war anymore. Come, let us go up to the mountain of the Lord, to the house of the God of Jacob, that He may teach us His ways and that we may walk in His paths.

Isaiah 2:3

Revelation 6:15-17

¹⁵ And the kings of the earth, the great men, the rich men, the commanders, the mighty men, every slave and every free man, hid themselves in the caves and in the rocks of the mountains, ¹⁶ and said to the mountains and rocks, "Fall on us and hide us from the face of Him who sits on the throne and from the wrath of the Lamb! ¹⁷ For the great day of His wrath has come, and who is able to stand?"
