Revelation 10:1-4

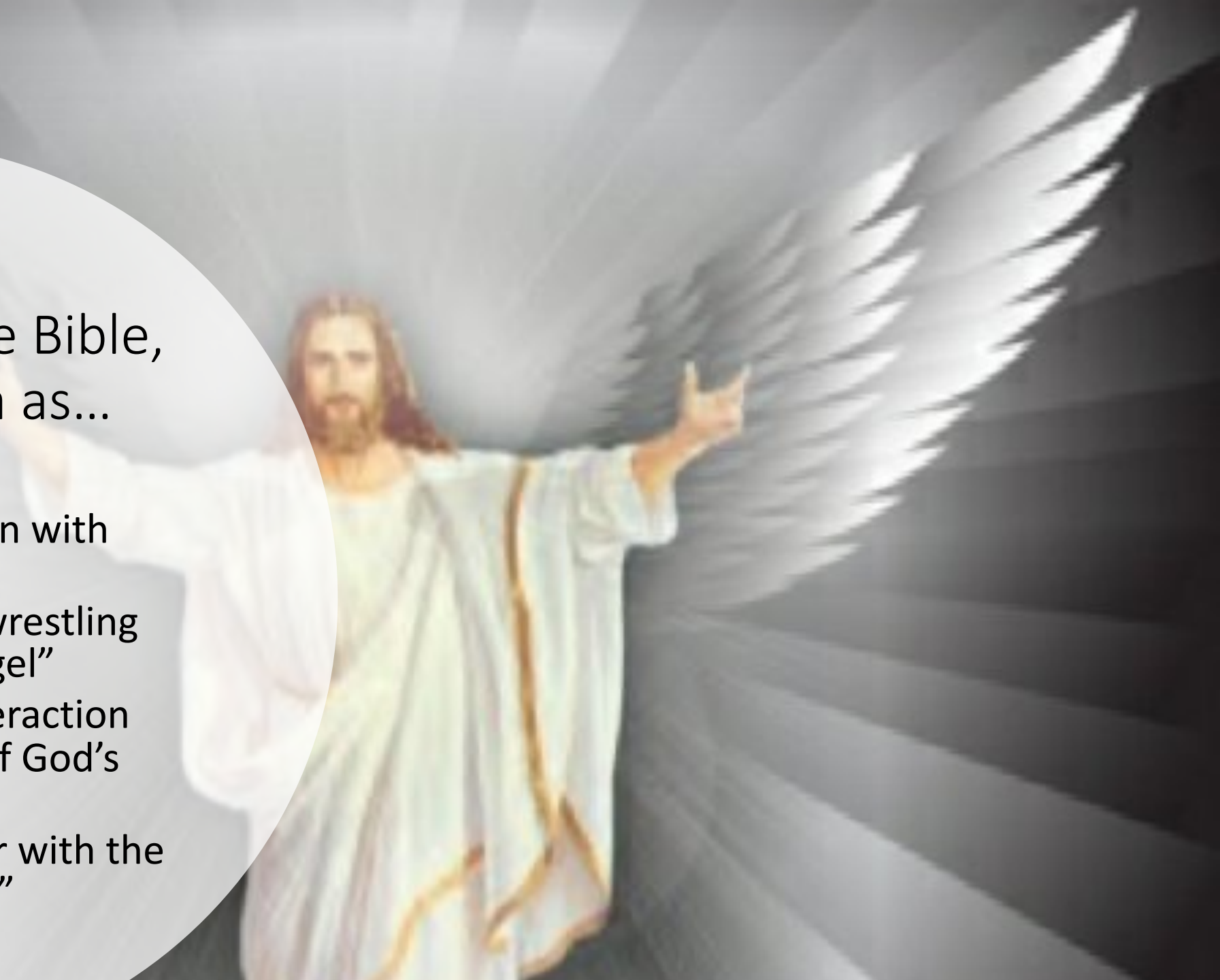
- **10** I saw still another ***mighty angel*** coming down from heaven, clothed with a ***cloud***. And a ***rainbow*** was on his head, his ***face was like the sun***, and his ***feet like pillars of fire***. ² He had a little book open in his hand. And he set his right foot on the sea and *his left foot* on the land, ³ and cried with ***a loud voice***, as *when a lion roars*. When he cried out, seven thunders uttered their voices. ⁴ Now when the ***seven thunders uttered their voices***, I was about to write; but I heard a voice from heaven saying to me, “***Seal up the things which the seven thunders uttered***, and do not write them.”

Who is this Mighty Angel?

- ²⁶ And ***above the firmament*** over their heads was the ***likeness of a throne***, in appearance like a sapphire stone; ***on the likeness of the throne was a likeness with the appearance of a man*** high above it. ²⁷ Also from the appearance of His waist and upward I saw, as ***it were, the color of amber*** with the appearance of fire all around within it; and from the appearance of His waist and ***downward I saw, as it were, the appearance of fire*** with brightness all around. ²⁸ Like the ***appearance of a rainbow in a cloud*** on a rainy day, so was the appearance of the brightness all around it. This was the ***appearance of the likeness of the glory of the LORD.***” - Ezekiel 1:28
- Compare this with the angel in Rev 8:3 (He was given much incense, that he should offer it with the prayers of all the saints upon the golden altar which was before the throne.) – Therefore, this angel has the ownership of the prayers of the saints.

- The “7 seals” on the Ketubah
- His right foot on the sea (Mediterranean Sea) and his left foot on the land

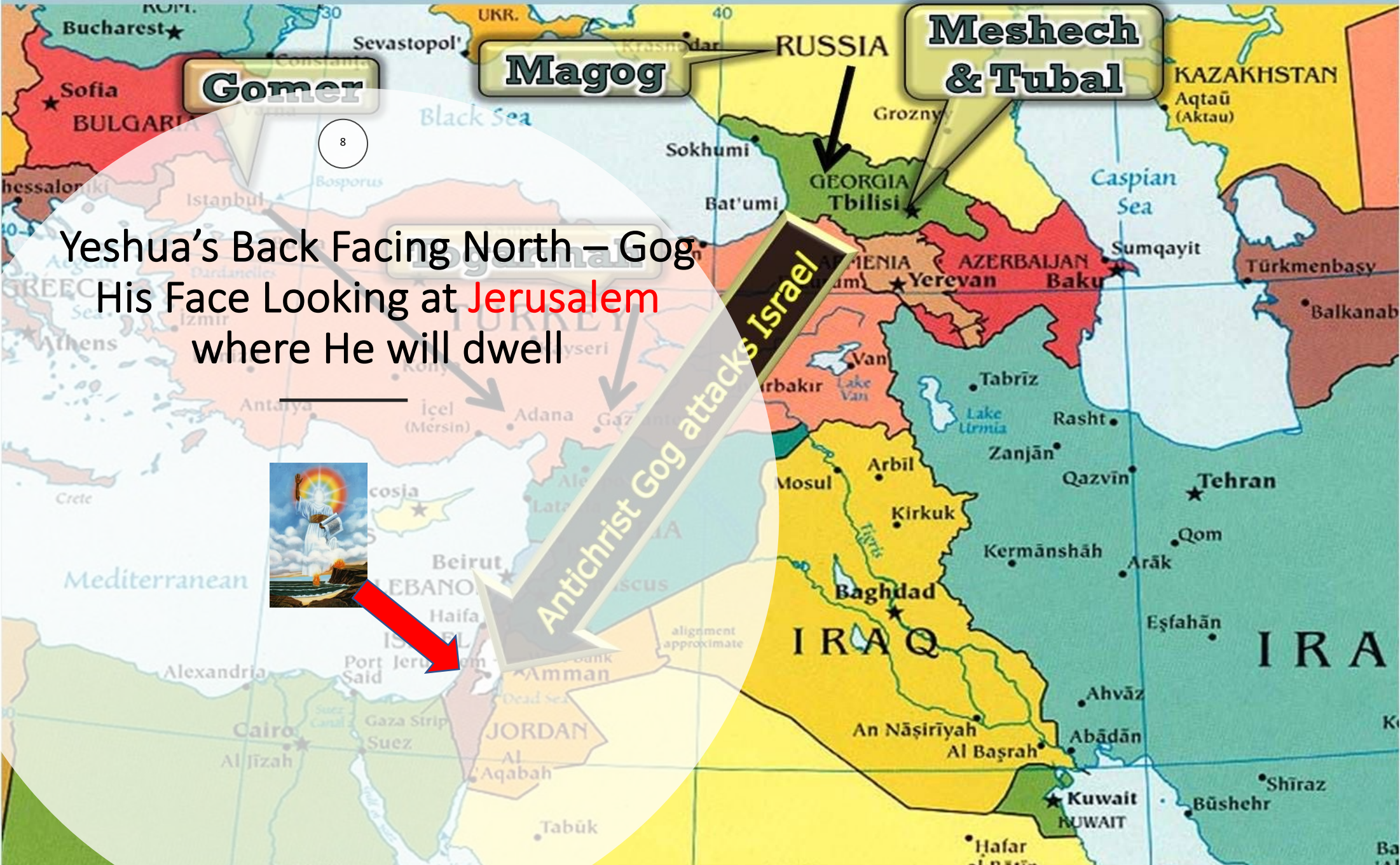

Revelation 10:3-4 Where is this place?

- ³ and cried with ***a loud voice***, as *when a lion roars*. When he cried out, ***seven thunders uttered their voices***. ⁴ Now when the seven thunders uttered their voices, I was about to write; but I heard a voice from heaven saying to me, “***Seal up the things which the seven thunders uttered, and do not write them.***”
- “Then it came to pass on the third day, in the morning, that there were **thunderings** and lightnings, and a thick cloud on the mountain; and the sound of the trumpet was very loud, so that all the people who were in the camp trembled.” – Exodus 19:16
- Thundering, voices-thunders - 3X- OT(Exodus); 7X-NT(Rev)

What & Why was John not permitted to write?

- ***He saw the Marriage Supper of the Lamb in heaven!***
- ⁹ Then he said to me, “Write: ‘Blessed *are* those who are called to the marriage supper of the Lamb!’ ” And he said to me, “These are the true sayings of God.” – Rev 19:9

Revelation 10:5-6

- “⁵ The angel whom I saw standing on the sea and on the land raised up his hand to heaven ⁶ and ***swore by Him*** who lives forever and ever, who ***created heaven*** and the things that are in it, the earth and the things that are in it, and the sea and the things that are in it, that there ***should be delay no longer,***”

¹² But above all, my brethren, ***do not swear***, either by heaven or by earth or with any other oath. But let your “Yes” be “Yes,” and your “No,” “No,” lest you fall into judgment. - James 5:12

Revelation 10:7

- ⁷ but in the days of the ***sounding of the seventh angel***, when he is about to sound, the ***mystery of God*** would be finished, as He declared to His servants the prophets.”
- ⁵⁰ Now this I say, brethren, that flesh and blood cannot inherit the kingdom of God; nor does corruption inherit incorruption. ⁵¹ Behold, I ***tell you a mystery***: We shall not all sleep, but we shall all be changed— ⁵² in a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at ***the last trumpet***. For the trumpet will sound, and the dead will be raised incorruptible, and we shall be changed.” – 1 Cor 15:50-52

Revelation 10:8-9

- ⁸ Then the voice which I heard from heaven spoke to me again and said, “Go, take the little book which is open in the hand of the angel who stands on the sea and on the earth.”
- ⁹ So I went to the angel and said to him, “Give me the little book.”
- And he said to me, “Take and eat it; and it will make your stomach bitter, but it will be as sweet as honey in your mouth.”

Revelation 10:10-11

- ¹⁰ Then I took the little book out of the angel's hand and ate it, and it was as sweet as ***honey in my mouth***. But when I had eaten it, my ***stomach became bitter***. ¹¹ And he said to me, "You must prophesy again about many peoples, nations, tongues, and kings."
- Ancient Hebrew custom: The rabbi in charge would ask his new Torah students to spread honey on a small corner of their Torah.
- The children were asked to eat the portion of the Torah
- Denotes the Torah must be consumed to make it a part of the body and soul
- "Bitter" because our flesh is at war with God's holy and righteous commands

The Two Witnesses

- **11** Then I was given a reed like a measuring rod. And the angel stood, saying, “Rise and ***measure the temple of God, the altar, and those who worship there.*** ² But ***leave out the court*** which is outside the temple, and do not measure it, for it has been ***given to the Gentiles.*** And they will ***tread the holy city underfoot for forty-two months.***

- Temple includes both the Holy Place and the Holy of Holies
- Those who worship there = the priests = brides
- Forty-two months is 1260 days or 3 ½ Year

Revelation 11:3-4

- ³ And I will give *power* to ***my two witnesses***, and they will prophesy ***one thousand two hundred and sixty days***, clothed in sackcloth.” ⁴ These are the ***two olive trees*** and the ***two lampstands*** standing before the God of the earth.
- The dedication of the Temple cannot be done without a prophet
- The highest level of the office of the Prophets are those who minister to nations and kings

Who Are the Two Witnesses?

- ²⁷ And as it is appointed for men to die once, but after this the judgment,” - Hebrew 9:27
- Except for those who are living at the time of the Second Coming (1 Thess 4:16-17)
- Two prophets (navi'im)
 - Enoch – Genesis 5:24 – Enoch chosen by God to judge the fallen teraphim
 - Elijah – 2 Kings 2:11-12 – Malachi 4:5 sent before the coming of the terrible day of the LORD
 - Elijah opposed (Babylon) Jezebel and the Beast (Ba'al)

Revelation 11:5-6

- ⁵ And if anyone wants to harm them, fire proceeds from their mouth and devours their enemies. And if anyone wants to harm them, he must be killed in this manner. ⁶ These have ***power to shut heaven***, so that no rain falls in the days of their prophecy; and they have power over waters to turn them to blood, and to strike the earth with all plagues, as often as they desire.

Revelation 11:7-8

- ⁷ When they finish their testimony, the ***beast that ascends out of the bottomless pit (Abaddon)*** will make war against them, overcome them, and kill them. ⁸ And ***their dead bodies will lie*** in the street of the ***great city*** which ***spiritually is called Sodom and Egypt***, where also our ***Lord was crucified***.
- Begins from the Feast of Trumpet
- Killed after 3 ½ years or 42 months on or near Passover
- Resurrected 3 ½ days - Feast of First Fruit
- The Daniel entire 7 years starts on the Feast of Trumpets and ends 7 years later on the Feast of Trumpets

Revelation 11:9-12

- ⁹ Then *those* from the ***peoples, tribes, tongues, and nations*** will see their ***dead bodies three-and-a-half days***, and not allow their dead bodies to be put into graves. ¹⁰ And those who dwell on the earth will rejoice over them, make merry, and send gifts to one another, because these two prophets tormented those who dwell on the earth.
- ¹¹ Now ***after the three-and-a-half days*** the breath of life from God entered them, and they stood on their feet, and great fear fell on those who saw them. ¹² And they heard a loud voice from heaven saying to them, “Come up here.” And they ascended to heaven in a cloud, and their enemies saw them.

Revelation 11:13-14

- ¹³ In the same hour there was a ***great earthquake***, and ***a tenth of the city fell (Jerusalem)***. In the earthquake ***seven thousand people were killed***, and the rest were afraid and ***gave glory to the God*** of heaven.
- ¹⁴ The ***second woe*** is past. Behold, the third woe is coming quickly.
- “give glory to God” - confirms there will be Believers during this season
- Third woe is the Seventh Trumpet also the Seven Bowls
