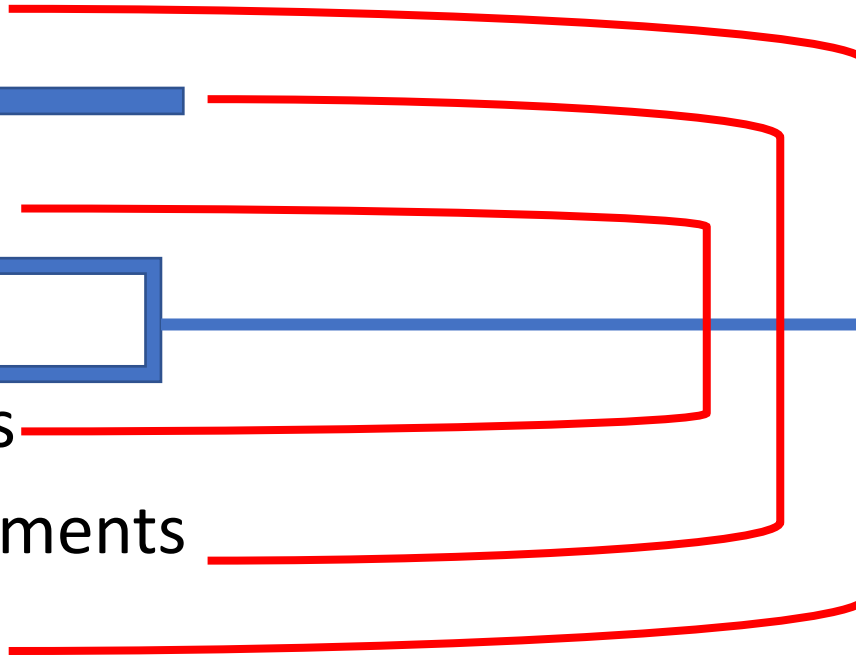

Scene on Earth

Revelation 14:1

14 Then I looked, and behold, a Lamb standing on Mount Zion, and with Him **one hundred and forty-four thousand**, having His Father's name written on their foreheads.



Who are these 144,000 - Rev 14:2

- ² *And I heard a **voice** from heaven, like the **voice** of many waters, and like the **voice** of loud thunder. And I heard the sound of harpists playing their harps. ³ They sang as it were a new song before the **throne**, before the four living creatures, and the elders; and no one could learn that song **except the hundred and forty-four thousand** who were **redeemed from the earth**. ⁴ These are the ones who were **not defiled with women**, for they are **virgins**. These are the ones who *follow the Lamb* wherever He goes. These were **redeemed from among men**, being **firstfruits to God** and **to the Lamb**. ⁵ And in their *mouth was found no deceit*, for they are *without fault* before the throne of God.*

7 Proclamations By 7 Angels (In Future)

- 1st Voice: Rev 14:6 - **Everlasting Gospel** Preached by Angel
- 2nd Voice: Rev 14:8 – Fall of the Mystery Babylon
- 3rd Voice: Rev 14: 9 - Wrath of God, Eternal Torment
- 4th Voice: Rev 14:13 – Blessings on the Martyrs
- 5th Voice: Rev 14:15 – Good Harvest (the Bride and the Martyrs)
- 6th Voice: Rev 14: 18 – Bad Harvest (Wrath of God)
- 7th Voice: Rev 16:1 – Pour Out the 7 Bowls (Battle of Armageddon/Ezekiel 38-39 War)

What is this Everlasting Gospel?

- Good News
- Yeshua First Coming as a Sacrificial Lamb
- HE shed His precious blood to redeem us
- But without Repentance and by Faith, there is no Redemption
- It is also known as the Gospel of the Kingdom

What is the Gospel of the Kingdom?

- ²⁵ Now it was the ***third hour***, and they crucified Him. ²⁶ And the inscription of His accusation was written above: THE KING OF THE JEWS” – Mark 15:25-26
 - Yeshua is the King and HE will return to rule and reign from Jerusalem
- ³ to whom He also ***presented Himself alive*** after His suffering by many ***infallible proofs***, being seen by them during ***forty days*** and speaking of the things ***pertaining to the kingdom of God***. – Acts 1:3
- ¹⁴ And this ***gospel of the kingdom*** will be preached in ***all the world*** as ***a witness to all the nations***, and then ***the end will come***.” – Matt 24:14
- ²³ When they persecute you in this city, flee to another. For assuredly, I say to you, you ***will not have gone through the cities*** of Israel before the Son of Man comes. – Matt 10:23

The First Angel Proclamation - Revelation 14:6-7

⁶Then I saw another angel flying in the midst of heaven, having the everlasting gospel to preach to those who dwell on the earth—to every nation, tribe, tongue, and people— ⁷saying with a **loud voice** “***Fear God and give glory to Him,*** for the hour of His judgment has come; and **worship Him who *made heaven and earth, the sea and springs of water.***”

God of Creation- Genesis 1-3

- Fear God and give Him the glory
- Worship Him
- HE is the GOD of Creation
- ***Genesis 1-3***
 - Creation and Fall of Man
 - Gospel (Good News) is to redeem the fallen man back to GOD

The Second Angel Proclamation – Rev 14:8

- ⁸ And another angel followed, **saying**, “**Babylon** is ***fallen***, is ***fallen***, that great city, because she has made all nations drink of the wine of the wrath of her fornication.

Who is this Mystery Babylon? – Rev 17&18

- “fallen, is fallen” Mentioned twice – Important
- The First Babylon
 - The Past foretells the Future
 - Form and Pattern of Prophecy
- Genesis 6:4
 - ⁴ There were giants on the earth in those days, and also afterward, when the sons of God came into the daughters of men and they bore *children* to them. Those *were* the mighty men who *were* of old, ***men of renown (Nephilm)***.
- Genesis 11 – Tower of Babel (One World Order)
 - Son of Ham
 - Son of Cush
 - Nimrod

What is Babylon

- Genesis 11:8 – God came and destroyed the Tower of Babel, the symbol of disobedience, manipulation and control
- ³⁰ That very night Belshazzar, king of the Chaldeans, was slain. – Daniel 5:30 (538 BC)
- Today Babylon is Secularism, Man's achievement without God
- Unity without God, perfect, utopian society
- Political, Totalism
- Babylon is Satan system, a counterfeit to God's Kingdom

The Third Angel Proclamation – Rev 14:9

- ⁹ Then a third angel followed them, saying with a **loud voice**, “If anyone ***worships the beast and his image***, and ***receives his mark*** on his ***forehead*** or on ***his hand***, ¹⁰ he himself ***shall also drink*** of the wine of the ***wrath of God***, which is poured out full strength into the cup of His indignation. He shall ***be tormented*** with ***fire and brimstone*** in the ***presence of*** the ***holy angels*** and in the presence of the ***Lamb***. ¹¹ And the smoke of their torment ascends ***forever and ever***; and they have no rest day or night, who worship the beast and his image, and whoever receives the mark of his name.”



The Mark of the Beast

- The Third Angel made it very clear, there is no compromise- no Plan B
- The Choice is an Eternal Choice
 - ¹¹ And the smoke of their torment ascends ***forever and ever***; and they have no rest day or night, who worship the beast and his image, and whoever receives the mark of his name.”

— rev 14:12-13
Blessed Are
Those ...

¹² Here is the patience of the saints; here *are* those who keep the commandments of God and the faith of Jesus. ¹³ Then I heard a **voice from heaven** saying to me, “Write: ‘***Blessed are the dead*** who ***die in the Lord from now on.***’ (*Martyrs*)” “Yes,” says the Spirit, “that they may ***rest from their labors***, and their ***works follow them.***”

Who Are These People? – Rev 7:13-15

- ¹³ Then one of the elders answered, saying to me, “Who are these arrayed in white robes, and where did they come from?”
- ¹⁴ And I said to him, “Sir, you know.”
- So, he said to me, “These are the ones who ***come out of the great tribulation*** and washed their robes and made them white in the blood of the Lamb. ¹⁵ Therefore they ***are before the throne of God*** and serve Him day and night in His temple. And He who sits on the throne will dwell among them.



- ¹⁶ For the Lord Himself will descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of an archangel, and with the trumpet of God. And the **dead in Christ** *will rise first.* - 1 Thess 4:16
- “Write: ‘**Blessed are the dead** who *die in the Lord from now on.*’ (Martyrs)” “Yes,” says the Spirit, “that they may *rest from their labors,* and their *works follow them.* – Rev 14:13



What Did Yeshua Say?

10 Blessed are those who are persecuted ' sake, For theirs is the kingdom of heaven. 11 Blessed are you when they revile and persecute you, and say all kinds of evil against you falsely for My sake. 12 Rejoice and be exceedingly glad, for great is your reward in heaven, for so they persecuted the prophets who were before you." – Matt 5:10-12

Barley Harvest

- Which Miracle of Yeshua was recorded in all the Four Gospels?
- The Miracle of feeding the 5,000
 - Matthew 14:13-21,
 - Mark 6:32-44,
 - Luke 9:12-17, and
 - John 6:1-14.





Barley Offering – the First Fruit Offering

John 6 – Feeding the 5,000

Fed 5 loaves 5,000
(Grace multiplied)

- ⁴ Now ***the Passover***, a feast of the Jews, was near. ⁵ Then Jesus lifted up *His* eyes, and seeing a great multitude coming toward Him, He said to ⁸ One of His disciples, Andrew, Simon Peter's brother, said to Him, ⁹ "There is a lad here who has ***five barley loaves*** and ***two small fish***, but what are they among so many?" Philip, "Where shall we buy bread, that these may eat?"
- ¹³ Therefore they gathered *them* up and ***filled twelve baskets*** with the fragments of the five barley loaves which were left over by those who had eaten. - John 6:4-9;13

Hosea 3:1-3

- Then the LORD said to me, “Go again, love a woman *who is* loved by a lover and ***is committing adultery***, just like ***the love of the LORD for the children of Israel***, who look ***to other gods*** and love *the* raisin cakes *of the pagans*.” ² So ***I bought her*** for myself for ***fifteen shekels*** of silver, and ***one and one-half homers of barley***. ³ And I said to her, “You shall stay with me many days; you shall not play the harlot, nor shall you have a man—so, too, *will I be* toward you.”
- Barley Harvest – **Those who are taken at the First Harvest**

Story of Ruth

- ²² So Naomi returned, and Ruth the Moabitess her daughter-in-law with her, who returned from the country of Moab. Now they came to Bethlehem at the beginning of barley harvest. – Ruth 1:22
- ² Now Boaz, whose young women you were with, *is he* not our relative? In fact, he is winnowing barley tonight at the threshing floor - Ruth 3:2
- First Harvest you winnowing the Barley
 - Throw the Barley into the wind
- ¹⁵ Also he said, “Bring the shawl that *is* on you and hold it.” And when she held it, he measured ***six ephahs of barley***, and laid *it* on her. Then she went into the city.
- Can these be the 144,000 – Among First Harvest (Wife – Israel)

John 4:35

- ³⁵ Do you not say, ‘There are ***still four months*** and *then* comes the ***harvest***’? Behold, I say to you, lift up your eyes and look at the fields, for they are already white for ***harvest***!
- Jewish Feasts 2022
- Passover (Pesach - Barley) – 15 April 2022
- Pentecost (Shavuot - **Wheat**) – 4 June 2022
- Tabernacles (Sukkot) – 9 October 2022

The Fifth Angel Proclamation – Rev 14-16 (The Bride)

- ¹⁴ Then I looked, and behold, a white cloud, and on the cloud ***sat One like the Son of Man***, having on His head a golden crown, and in His hand a sharp sickle. ¹⁵ And ***another angel*** came out of the temple, crying with a **loud voice to Him who sat on the cloud**, “Thrust in Your sickle and reap, for the time has come for You to reap, for the ***harvest of the earth is ripe*** (G3583 Xeraino-mature).” ¹⁶ ***So He who sat on the cloud thrust*** in His sickle on the earth, and the ***earth was reaped***.
- ⁶² Jesus said, “I am. And you ***will see the Son of Man*** sitting at the right hand of the Power, and ***coming with the clouds of heaven***.” –Mark 14:62

Matthew 13:25-30 – The Bride Goes Up, the Wicked (Tares) bind-up For Judgment

- ²⁵ but while men slept, his enemy came and **sowed tares** among the wheat and went his way. ²⁶ But when **the grain had sprouted** and produced a crop, then **the tares also appeared**. ²⁷ So the servants of the owner came and said to him, ‘Sir, did you not sow good seed in your field? How then does it have tares?’ ²⁸ He said to them, ‘**An enemy has done this.**’ The servants said to him, ‘Do you want us then to go and gather them up?’ ²⁹ But he said, ‘**No, lest** while you gather up the tares you **also uproot the wheat** with them. ³⁰ **Let both grow together until the harvest**, and at the **time of harvest** I will say to the reapers, “**First gather together the tares** and bind them in bundles **to burn them**, but gather the wheat into my barn.”

The Sixth Angel
Proclamation –
Rev 14:17-20
(The Martyrs
together with
the wicked)

- ¹⁷ Then ***another angel*** came out of the temple which is in heaven, he also having a sharp sickle. ¹⁸ And another ***angel came out from the altar***, who had power over fire, and he **cried with a loud cry to him who had the sharp sickle**, saying, “Thrust in your sharp sickle and gather the clusters of the ***vine of the earth, for her grapes are fully ripe*** (G187 Akmazo-fully ripe).” ¹⁹ So the angel thrust his sickle into the earth and gathered the vine of the earth, and threw *it* into the ***great winepress of the wrath of God***. ²⁰ And the winepress was trampled outside the city, and blood came out of the winepress, up to the horses’ bridles, for one thousand six hundred furlongs.

Martyrs Crying Out for Justice – Fifth Seal

- ¹⁰ And they cried with a loud voice, saying, “How long, O Lord, holy and true, until You judge and avenge our blood on those who dwell on the earth?” – Rev 6:10



Isaiah 63:2-6

² Why *is* Your apparel red, And Your garments like one who treads in the winepress? ³ “I have trodden the winepress alone, And from the peoples no one *was* with Me. For I have trodden them in My anger, and trampled them in My fury; Their blood is sprinkled upon My garments, and I have stained all My robes. ⁴ For the day of vengeance *is* in My heart, and the year of My redeemed has come. ⁵ I looked, but *there was* no one to help, and I wondered that *there was* no one to uphold; Therefore My own arm brought salvation for Me; And My own fury, it sustained Me. ⁶ I have ***trodden down the peoples in My anger***, Made them drunk in My fury, And brought down their strength to the earth.”

The Seventh Angel Proclamation – Rev 16:1

- **16** Then I heard a **loud voice** from the temple saying to the seven angels, “Go and pour out the bowls of the wrath of God on the earth.” – Revelation 16:1
- Chapter 15 – An Interlude Chapter
- The Seventh Proclamation that ushers in the Seven Bowls of Judgment
