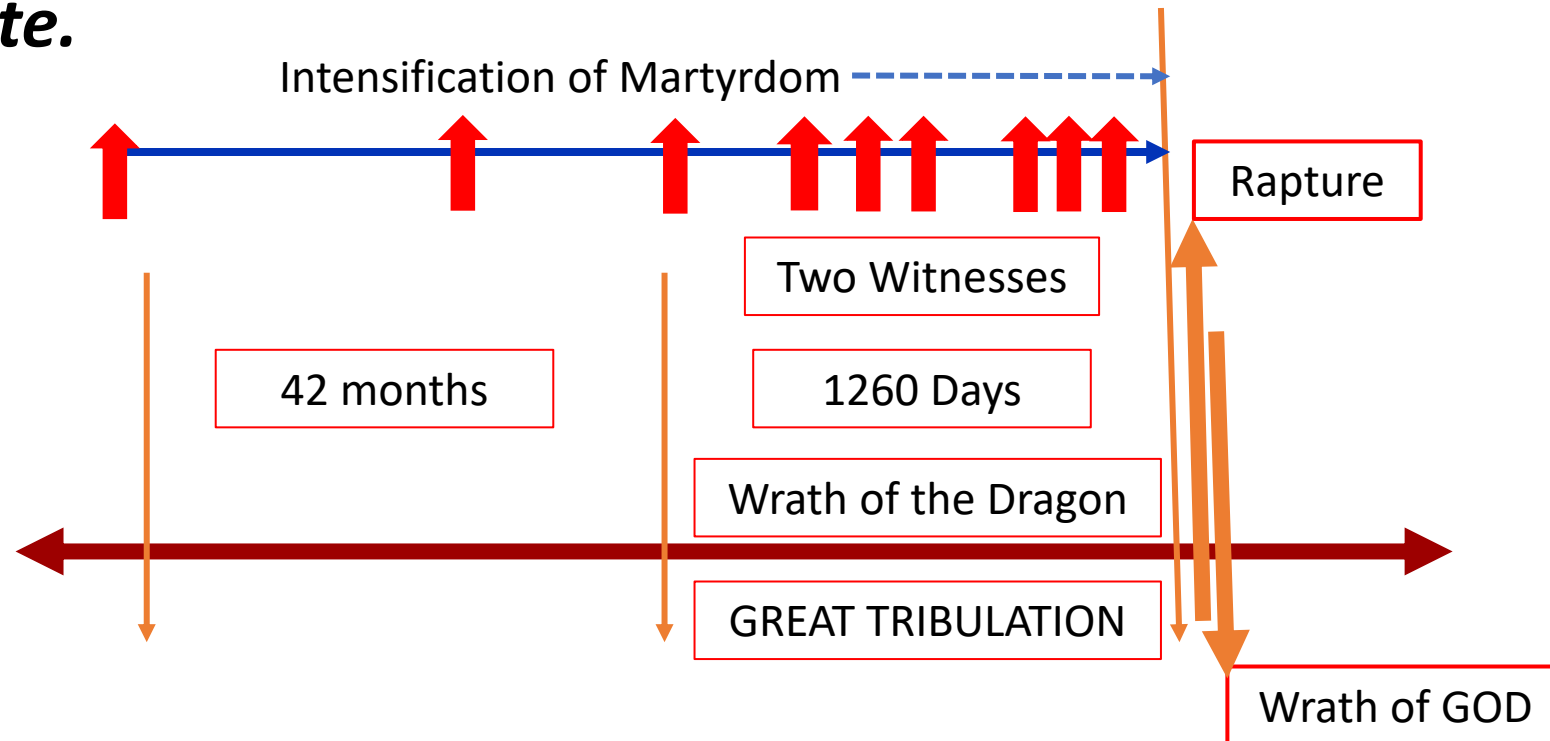

Seven Last Plagues – Wrath of God Rev 15:1

- **15** Then I saw *another sign in heaven*, great and marvelous: *seven angels* having the *seven last plagues*, for in them the *wrath of God is complete*.



Scene In Heaven Rev 15:2-3

- ² And I saw *something* like a sea of glass mingled with fire, and those who have the **victory over the beast, over his image** and **over his mark and over the number of his name**, standing on the sea of glass, having harps of God. ³ They sing the **song of Moses**, the servant of God, and the **song of the Lamb**, saying:
- *Refer to Rev 14:9-10*
- ⁹ Then a third angel followed them, saying with a loud voice, “**If anyone worships the beast and his image, and receives his mark** on his forehead or on his hand, ¹⁰ he himself shall **also drink of the wine of the wrath of God**, which is poured out full strength into the cup of His indignation. He shall be tormented with fire and brimstone in the presence of the holy angels and in the presence of the Lamb.

Two Songs: Song of Moses & Song of the Lamb

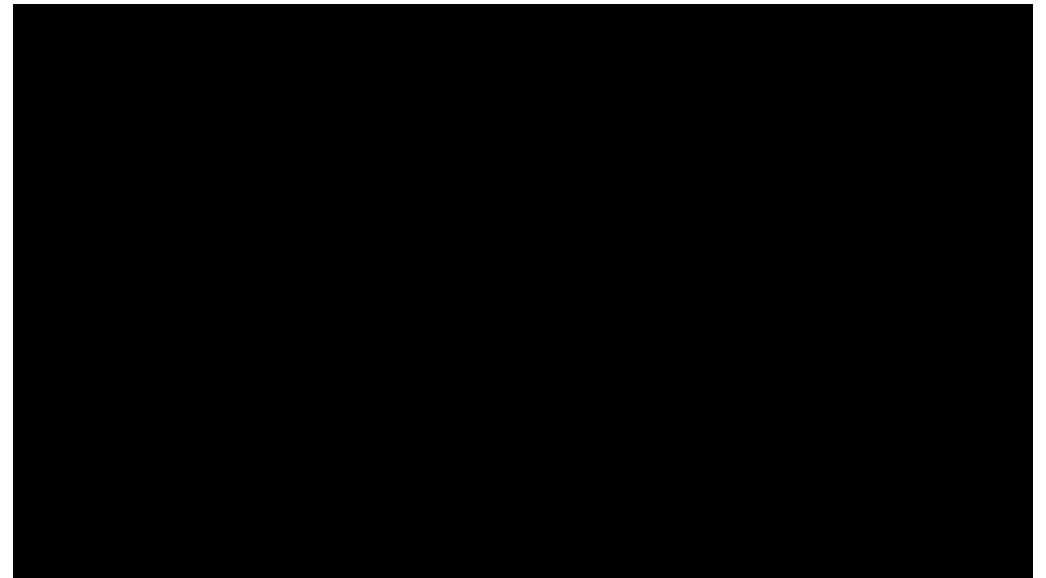
- ³ They sing the ***song of Moses***, the servant of God, and the ***song of the Lamb***, saying:
- “Great and marvelous *are* Your works,
Lord God Almighty!
Just and true *are* Your ways,
O King of the saints!
⁴ Who shall not fear You, O Lord, and glorify Your name?
For *You* alone *are* holy.
For all nations shall come and worship before You,
For Your judgments have been manifested.”

Song of Deliverance – Song of ~~Moses~~/Lamb (Exodus 15:1-19)

- **15** Then Moses and the children of Israel sang this song to the LORD, and spoke, saying:
 - “I will ***sing to the LORD***,
For He has triumphed gloriously!
The horse and its rider
He has thrown into the sea!
² The ***LORD is my strength and song,***
And He has become my salvation;
He *is* my God, and I will praise Him;
My father’s God, and I will exalt Him.
- 1. This Song should be the Song of the LAMB***
 2. What happened in the PAST is a pattern of what will happen in the FUTURE:
 - 3. What Happen During Moses’ Time?***

Song of Moses – Deuteronomy 31:30;32:1-4

- ³⁰ Then Moses spoke in the hearing of all the assembly of Israel the words of this song until they were ended:
- ¹ “Give ear, O heavens, and I will speak;
And hear, O earth, the words of my mouth.
² Let my teaching drop as the rain,
My speech distill as the dew,
As raindrops on the tender herb,
And as showers on the grass.
³ For I proclaim the name of the LORD:
Ascribe greatness to our God.
⁴ *He is* the Rock, His work *is* perfect;
For all His ways *are* justice,
A God of truth and without injustice;
Righteous and upright *is* He.
- Both these Songs are ***sung only on Sabbath, the Day of Rest***



Heaven Opens – Takes Place Shortly After the Seventh Trumpet has Sounded - Rev 15:5-8

- ⁵ ***After these things I looked***, and behold, the temple of the tabernacle of the testimony in ***heaven was opened***. ⁶ And out of the temple came the ***seven angels having the seven plagues***, clothed in pure bright linen, and having their chests girded with golden bands. ⁷ Then one of the four living creatures gave to the seven angels seven golden bowls full of the ***wrath of God*** who lives forever and ever. ⁸ ***The temple was filled with smoke*** from the ***glory of God and from His power***, and ***no one was able to enter the temple*** till the ***seven plagues of the seven angels were completed***.
- Connect to Rev 11:19
 - ¹⁹ Then the temple of God was opened in heaven, and the ark of His covenant was seen in His temple. And there were lightnings, noises, thunderings, an earthquake, and great hail.

Parable of the Wise and Foolish Virgins Matt 25:1-13

- **25** “Then the kingdom of heaven shall be likened to ten virgins who took their lamps and went out to meet the bridegroom. ² Now ***five of them were wise***, and ***five were foolish***. ³ Those who ***were foolish took their lamps and took no oil*** with them, ⁴ but the wise took oil in their vessels with their lamps. ⁵ But while the ***bridegroom was delayed***, they all slumbered and slept. ⁶ “And at ***midnight*** a cry was *heard*: ‘***Behold, the bridegroom is coming***; go out to meet him!’ ⁷ Then all those virgins arose and trimmed their lamps. ⁸ And the foolish said to the wise, ‘***Give us some of your oil***, for our lamps are going out.’ ⁹ But the wise answered, saying, ‘No, lest there should not be enough for us and you; but go rather to those who sell, and buy for yourselves.’ ¹⁰ ***And while they went to buy, the bridegroom came, and those who were ready went in with him to the wedding; and the door was shut.*** ¹¹ “Afterward the other virgins came also, saying, ‘Lord, Lord, open to us!’ ¹² But he answered and said, ‘***Assuredly, I say to you, I do not know you.***’ ¹³ “Watch therefore, for you know neither the day nor the hour in which the Son of Man is coming.

Ancient Temple Worship

- Two Worship Services
- Morning Service – At the break of Dawn
 - First Blast of the Shofar
 - Temple Door opens
- Second blast - Morning Service begins
- Third blast End of the Morning service
- Fourth blast – Beginning of the Evening service
- Fifth blast – End of the Evening service
- Sixth blast – Door closes, Darkness comes...
- Seventh blast – the Bride is caught up in the Air

When Does The Seven Plagues Happen?

- **After these things I looked...** Rev 15:5
- The Number of Martyrs is completed.
 - ¹¹ Then a white robe was given to each of them; and it was said to them that they should rest a little while longer, until ***both the number of their fellow servants and their brethren, who would be killed as they were, was completed.*** – Rev 6:11
- The Ending of the Wrath of the Dragon
- The Beginning of the Wrath of GOD
- Martyrs are Up in Heaven
- Saints-Brides are “Raptured” – 1 Thess 4:15-17

Seven Bowls – Chapter 16

- **16** Then I heard a loud voice from the temple saying to the seven angels, “Go and pour out the bowls of the wrath of God on the earth.”
- **First Bowl: Loathsome Sores**
- ² So the ***first went*** and poured out his bowl upon the earth, and a foul and ***loathsome sore*** came upon the men who had the mark of the beast and those who worshiped his image.
- Compare with the Sixth plague: Boils - Exodus 9:8-12

Adolf Hitler, Alexander the Great, Antiochus Epiphanes

First symptom of syphilis : Ugly and painful sores that breaks out upon the genitalia

Second Bowl: The Sea Turns to Blood

- ³ Then the ***second angel*** poured out his bowl on the sea, and it became ***blood*** as of a dead *man*; and every living creature in the sea died.
- Compare with the First plague: Waters become Blood - Exodus 7:14-25

Second symptom of syphilis: The disease retreats into the bloodstream

Third Bowl: The Waters Turn to Blood

- ⁴ Then the ***third angel*** poured out his bowl on the rivers and springs of water, and they ***became blood***. ⁵ And I heard the angel of the waters saying:
- “You are righteous, O Lord,
The One who is and who was and who is to be,
Because You have judged these things.
⁶ For they have shed the blood of saints and prophets,
And You have given them blood to drink.
For it is their just due.”
- ⁷ And I heard another from the altar saying,
“Even so, Lord God Almighty, true and
righteous *are* Your judgments.”

Third symptom of syphilis: The disease retreats deeper into the body and the tissue and between the cells spaces. Random internal capillary bleeding occurs

Fourth Bowl: Men Are Scorched

- ⁸ Then the ***fourth angel*** poured out his bowl on the ***sun, and power*** was given to him to ***scorch men*** with fire. ⁹ And men were scorched with great heat, and they blasphemed the name of God who has power over these plagues; and they did not repent and give Him glory.
- Compare with the Ninth plague: Darkness – Exodus 10:21-29

The Fourth symptom of syphilis: Scorching fever and intense flu-like symptoms

Fifth Bowl: Darkness and Pain

- ¹⁰ Then the ***fifth angel*** poured out his bowl on the throne of the beast, and his kingdom became ***full of darkness***; and they gnawed their tongues because of the pain. ¹¹ They blasphemed the God of heaven because of their pains and their sores, and did not repent of their deeds.
- Compare with the Ninth plague:
Darkness – Exodus 10:21-29

Fifth Symptom of syphilis: Blindness and blistering sore on the tongue, the roof of the mouth, and the soft tissue of the body

Sixth Bowl: Euphrates Dried Up

- ¹² Then the **sixth angel** poured out his bowl on the great river **Euphrates, and its water was dried up**, so that the way of the **kings** from the east might be prepared. ¹³ And I saw three unclean spirits like frogs *coming* out of the mouth of the dragon, out of the mouth of the beast, and out of the mouth of the false prophet. ¹⁴ For they are spirits of demons, performing signs, *which* go out to the kings of the earth and of the whole world, to gather them to the battle of that great day of God Almighty.
- ¹⁵ “Behold, ***I am coming as a thief. Blessed is he who watches, and keeps his garments***, lest he walk naked and they see his shame.”
- ¹⁶ And they gathered them together to the place called in Hebrew, **Armageddon**.

Sixth symptom of syphilis:
Dehydration, insanity, and
hallucination



Seventh Bowl: The Earth Utterly Shaken

- ⁷ Then the ***seventh angel*** poured out his bowl into the air, and a loud voice came out of the temple of heaven, from the throne, saying, “***It is done!***” ¹⁸ And there were noises and thunderings and lightnings; and there was a great earthquake, such a mighty and great earthquake as had not occurred since men were on the earth. ¹⁹ Now the ***great city was divided into three parts***, and ***the cities of the nations fell***. And ***great Babylon*** was remembered before God, to give her the cup of the wine of the fierceness of His wrath. ²⁰ Then every island fled away, and the mountains were not found. ²¹ And great hail from heaven fell upon men, *each hailstone* about the weight of a talent. Men blasphemed God because of the plague of the hail, since that plague was exceedingly great.
- Compare with the Tenth plague: Death to the Firstborn – Exodus 11:1-10
