Keeping the Sabbath – Isaiah 58:13- 14

- 13 “**If** you **turn away your foot** from the **Sabbath**, *From doing your pleasure* on My holy day, And **call the Sabbath a delight**, The holy *day* of the LORD honorable, And **shall honor Him**, **not doing** your own ways,
Nor finding your **own pleasure**,
Nor speaking *your own* words,

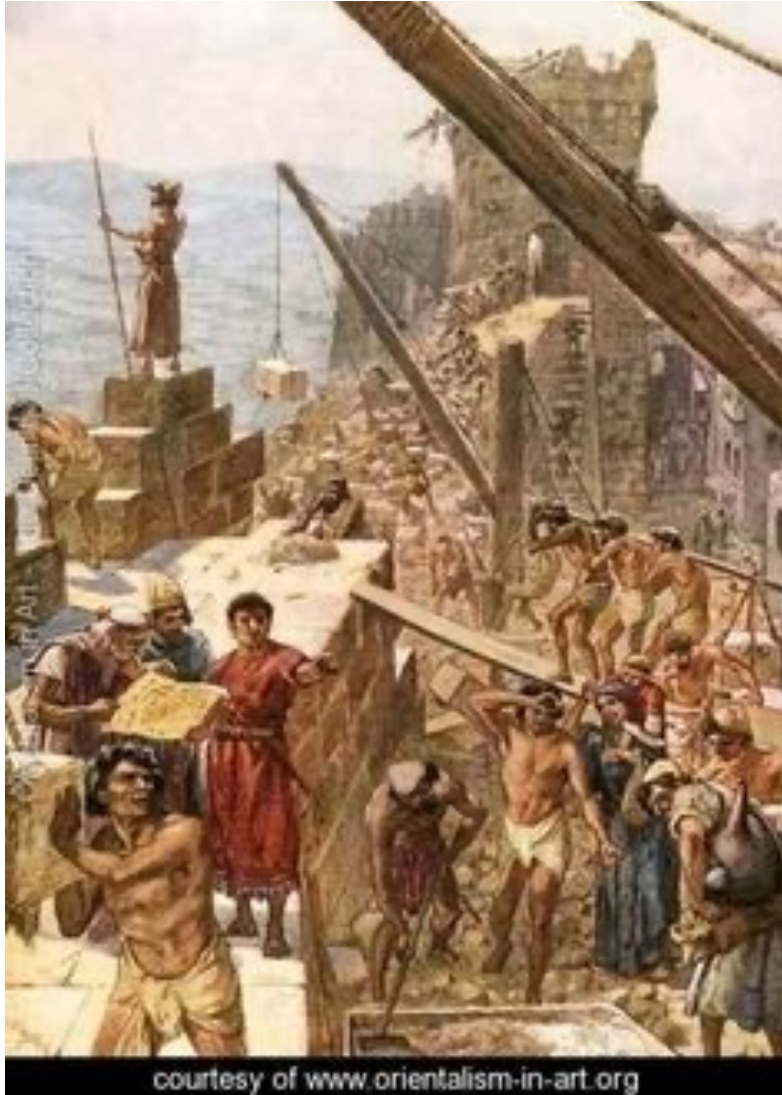
The Prophetic Book - Zechariah in OT complements the Book - Revelation in NT

Zechariah 1:4-6

Learn from the past

- ⁴ “**Do not be like your fathers**, to whom the former **prophets preached**, saying, ‘Thus says the LORD of hosts: “Turn now from your evil ways and your evil deeds.” ’ **But they did not hear** nor heed Me,” says the LORD.
- ⁵ “Your fathers, where *are* they?
And the prophets, do they live forever?
⁶ Yet surely My words and My statutes,
Which I commanded My servants the prophets,
Did they not overtake your fathers?
- “So they returned and said:
- ‘Just as the LORD of hosts determined to do to us,
According to our ways and according to our deeds,
So He has dealt with us.’ ” ’ ”

How Does the Book of Zechariah relate to The Day of the LORD?

- The Vision of the horses
- ⁷ On the **twenty-fourth day** of the **eleventh month**, the month of **Shebat**, in the second year of Darius, the word of the LORD came to the prophet Zechariah son of Berekiah, the son of Iddo.

The Book of Zechariah 1:8-10

- ⁸ I saw by night, and behold, a **man riding** on a **red** horse, and it **stood** among the myrtle trees in the hollow; and behind him *were* **horses: red, sorrel, and white**. ⁹ Then I said, “My lord, what *are* these?” So the angel who talked with me said to me, “I will show you what they *are*.”
- 10 And the man who stood among the myrtle trees answered and said, “These are the ones whom the Lord has sent to walk to and fro throughout the earth.”

5975 'āmaḍ – stand, take one's stand and present oneself; attend to, persevering in a commitment. This term is also used in connection with waiting to receive a revelation from the Lord (His impartation of faith)

The Book of Zechariah – 1:11-13

- ¹¹ And **they** reported to the **angel of the LORD** who was standing among the myrtle trees, “We have gone throughout the earth and **found the whole world at rest and in peace.**”
- ¹² Then the angel of the LORD said, “LORD Almighty, how long will you withhold mercy from Jerusalem and from the towns of Judah, which you have been angry with these **seventy years?**” ¹³ So the LORD spoke kind and comforting words to the angel who talked with me.

The Book of Zechariah 1:14-17

- **The Vision of the horses**
- ¹⁴ Then the angel who was speaking to me said, “Proclaim this word: This is what the LORD Almighty says: **‘I am very jealous for Jerusalem and Zion,** ¹⁵ and I am **very angry with the nations** that feel secure. I was only a little angry, but they **went too far** with the punishment.’
- ¹⁶ “Therefore this is what the LORD says: ‘I will return to Jerusalem with **mercy**, and there **my house will be rebuilt**. And the measuring line will be stretched out over Jerusalem,’ declares the LORD Almighty.
- ¹⁷ “**Proclaim further:** This is what the LORD Almighty says: ‘My towns will again overflow **with prosperity**, and the **LORD will again comfort Zion and choose Jerusalem.**’”

In That Day – The Day of the Lord

- ¹⁰ “Shout and be glad, Daughter Zion. For I am coming, and I will **live** among you,” declares the LORD. ¹¹ “Many nations will be **joined** with the LORD **in that day** and **will become** my people. I will **live** among you and you will **know** that the LORD Almighty has sent me to you.” – Zech 2:10-11

The OT (Hebrew) **conjunctive perfect** underlines information with ***certain-and-solemn*** significance in the storyline – data set off as *integral (central)* to the message of the passage.

The Four Horses of Zechariah 6:1-6

- **6** Then I turned and raised my eyes and looked, and behold, four chariots *were* coming from between two mountains, and the mountains *were* mountains of bronze. ² With the first chariot *were* **red horses**, with the second chariot **black horses**, ³ with the third chariot **white horses**, and with the fourth chariot **dappled horses**—strong *steeds*. ⁴ Then I answered and said to the angel who talked with me, “What *are* these, my lord?”
- ⁵ And the angel answered and said to me, “These *are* **four spirits of heaven**, who go out from *their* station before the Lord of all the earth. ⁶ The one with the **black horses** is going **to the north country**, the **white** are going **after them**, and the **dappled** are going **toward the south country**.”

The Four Horses of Zechariah 6:7-8

- ⁷ Then the strong *steeds* went out, eager to go, that they might walk to and fro throughout the earth. And He said, “Go, walk to and fro throughout the earth.” So they walked to and fro throughout the earth. ⁸ And He called to me, and spoke to me, saying, “See, **those who go toward the north country** have given **rest** to My Spirit in the north country.”

47b (SN 5117) *nûah* – properly, to rest, repose; (figuratively) **settled in, enjoying *reposeful security***, especially after *triumph* (TWOT); quiet, resting securely – with the “overtone of finality” (TWOT); quietness; a quieting, soothing (also the term for “*sweet savor* offering”); a place of quiet and rest (*mēm locale* form).

Compare to the Book of Revelation 6:1-4

- **6** Now I saw when the Lamb opened one of the seals; and I heard one of the four living creatures saying with a voice like thunder, “Come and see.” ² And I looked, and behold, **a white horse**. He who sat on it had a bow; and a crown was given to him, and he went out conquering and to conquer.
- **Second Seal: Conflict on Earth**
- ³ When He opened the second seal, I heard the second living creature saying, “Come and see.” ⁴ Another horse, fiery **red**, went out. And it was granted to the one who sat on it to take peace from the earth, and that *people* should kill one another; and there was given to him a great sword.

Compare to the Book of Revelation 6:1-5-8

Third Seal: Scarcity on Earth

- ⁵ When He opened the third seal, I heard the third living creature say, “Come and see.” So I looked, and behold, a **black horse**, and he who sat on it had a **pair of scales** in his hand. ⁶ And I heard a voice in the midst of the four living creatures saying, “A quart of wheat for a denarius, and three quarts of barley for a denarius; and do not harm the oil and the wine.”

• Fourth Seal: Widespread Death on Earth

- ⁷ When He opened the fourth seal, I heard the voice of the fourth living creature saying, “Come and see.” ⁸ So I looked, and behold, a pale horse. And the name of him who sat on it was Death, and Hades followed with him. And power was given to them over a fourth of the earth, to kill with sword, with hunger, with death, and by the **beasts** of the earth.

What is The Day of the LORD?

- 495 X mentioned on the combination of “Day” the LORD”
- First mentioned in Genesis 3:8
 - Then the man and his wife heard the sound of **the LORD** God as he was walking in the garden in the cool of the **day**, and **they hid** from **the LORD** God among the trees of the garden.
- **It was the Day man sinned and felt the fear of the LORD**



What is The Day of the LORD?

Judgment on the Whole Earth in the Day of the LORD

- “I will sweep away everything from **the face of the earth**,” declares **the LORD**.” – Zephaniah 1:2
- “And it shall come to pass **at that time** that I will search Jerusalem **with lamps**, and **punish the men** who are settled in **complacency**, Who say in their heart, ‘The Lord will not do good, Nor will He do evil.’ – Zephaniah 1:12

The Mark of the Anti-Christ Zechariah 11:17

- ¹⁶ For indeed I will raise up a **shepherd** in the land **who will not care** for those who are cut off, nor seek the young, nor heal those that are broken, nor feed those that still stand. But he will eat the flesh of the fat and tear their hooves in pieces.
- ¹⁷ “Woe to the worthless shepherd,
Who leaves the flock!
A sword *shall be* against his arm
And against his right eye;
His arm shall completely wither,
And his right eye shall be totally blinded.”

Revelation 13:2-3

- ² Now the beast which I saw was like a leopard, his feet were like *the feet of* a bear, and his mouth like the mouth of a lion. The dragon gave him his power, his throne, and great authority. ³ And I saw one of **his heads** as if it had been mortally wounded, and his **deadly wound was healed**. And all the world marvelled and followed the beast.

The Day of the LORD – Zechariah 13:2-3

- ² “It shall be **in that day**,” says the LORD of hosts, “*that* I will **cut off** the names of the idols from the land, and they shall **no longer be remembered**. I will also cause the prophets and the unclean spirit **to depart** from the land. ³ It shall come to pass *that* **if anyone still prophesies**, then his father and mother who begot him will say to him, ‘**You shall not live, because you have spoken lies** in the name of the LORD.’ And his father and mother who begot him shall thrust him through when he prophesies.

The Day of the Lord – Zechariah 14:1-15

- **14** Behold, the day of the LORD is coming,
And your spoil will be divided in your midst.
² For I will **gather all the nations to battle against Jerusalem;**
The city shall be taken,
The houses rifled,
And the women ravished.
Half of the city shall go into captivity,
But the remnant of the people shall not be cut off from the city.

The Day of the Lord – Zechariah 14:1-15

- ³Then the **LORD will go forth And fight** against those nations,
As He fights in the day of battle.
⁴And in that day His feet will stand on the Mount of Olives,
Which faces Jerusalem on the east.
And the **Mount of Olives shall be split in two**,
From east to west, *Making* a very large valley;
Half of the mountain shall move toward the north
And half of it toward the south.

The Day of the Lord – Zechariah 14:1-15

- ⁵ Then you shall **flee *through* My mountain valley**,
For the mountain valley shall reach to Azal.
Yes, **you shall flee As you fled from the earthquake**
In the days of Uzziah king of Judah.
- Thus the LORD my God will come, *And* all the saints with You.
- ⁶ It shall come to pass in that day
That there **will be no light**;
The lights will diminish.

The Day of the Lord – Zechariah 14:1-15

- ⁷ It shall be one day Which is known to the LORD —
Neither day nor night. But at evening time it shall happen
That it will be light.
- ⁸ And in **that day** it shall be
That living waters shall flow from Jerusalem,
Half of them toward the eastern sea
And half of them toward the western sea;
In both summer and winter it shall occur.

The Day of the Lord – Zechariah 14:1-15

- ⁹ And the **LORD shall be King over all the earth.**
In that day it shall be— “**The LORD is one,**” And His name one.
- ¹⁰ All the **land shall be turned into a plain** from Geba to Rimmon south of Jerusalem. ***Jerusalem* shall be raised** up and inhabited in her place from Benjamin’s Gate to the place of the First Gate and the Corner Gate, and *from* the Tower of Hananel to the king’s winepresses.
- ¹¹ *The people* shall dwell in it; **And no longer shall there be utter destruction,** But Jerusalem shall be safely inhabited.

The Day of the Lord – Zechariah 14:1-15

- ¹² And this shall be the plague with which the LORD will strike all the people who fought against Jerusalem:
- Their **flesh shall dissolve** while they stand on their feet,
Their **eyes shall dissolve** in their sockets,
And their **tongues shall dissolve** in their mouths.
- ¹³ It shall come to pass in that day
That a great panic from the LORD will be among them.
Everyone will seize the hand of his neighbor,
And raise his hand against his neighbor's hand;

The Day of the Lord – Zechariah 14:1-15

- ¹⁴ Judah also will fight at Jerusalem.
And the **wealth of all the surrounding nations**
Shall be gathered together:
Gold, silver, and apparel in great abundance.
- ¹⁵ Such also shall be the plague
On the horse *and* the mule,
On the camel and the donkey,
And on all the cattle that will be in those camps.
So *shall* this plague *be*.

What is The Day of the LORD?

- The Day of the LORD is GOD's Wrath
- Not reserved for HIS sons and daughters
- ““If **the Lord** had not cut short those **days**, no one would survive. But for **the** sake **of the** elect, whom he has chosen, he has shortened **them**.” – Mark 13:20
- “For God did not appoint us to **wrath**, but to obtain salvation through our Lord Jesus Christ,” – 1 Thess 5:9









The Nations Worship the King – Zechariah 14:16-17

- ¹⁶ And it shall come to pass *that* everyone **who is left of all the nations** which came against Jerusalem shall go up from year to year to worship the King, the LORD of hosts, and to keep the **Feast of Tabernacles**. ¹⁷ And it shall be *that* whichever of the families of the earth do not come up to Jerusalem to worship the King, the LORD of hosts, on them there will be no rain.

Ezekiel 38:1-6: ?? Gog {Satan}; Magog {Russia}; Persia {Iran}; Cush {Ethiopia}; Phut/Libya {Libya}; Gomer {Europe}; Togarmah {Turkey / Armenia}; Meshech {Turkey}; Rosh {Russia}; Tubal {Eastern Turkey}

Ezekiel 38:13

- ¹³ Sheba, Dedan, the merchants of Tarshish, and all their young lions will say to you, '**Have you come to take plunder?** Have you gathered your army to take booty, to carry away silver and gold, to take away livestock and goods, to take great plunder?'

The Day of the LORD

- ³ And there *was* the angel who talked with me, going out; and another angel was coming out to meet him, ⁴ who said to **him**, “Run, speak to this young man, saying: ‘**Jerusalem shall be inhabited *as towns without walls***, because of the multitude of men and livestock in it. — **Zechariah 2:3-4**
- ¹⁰ ‘Thus says the Lord GOD: “**On that day** it shall come to pass *that* thoughts will arise in your mind, and you will make an evil plan: You will say, ‘I will go up against **a land of unwalled villages**; I will go to a peaceful people, who dwell safely, all of them dwelling **without walls**, and having neither bars nor gates’ — **Ezekiel 38:10-11**

Who Are These People?

- **38** Now the word of the LORD came to me, saying, ² “Son of man, set your **face against Gog**, of the land of **Magog**, the prince of **Rosh, Meshech, and Tubal**, and prophesy against him, ³ and say, ‘Thus says the Lord GOD: “Behold, I *am* against you, O Gog, the prince of Rosh, Meshech, and Tubal. ⁴ I will turn you around, put hooks into your jaws, and lead you out, with all your army, horses, and horsemen, all splendidly clothed, a great company *with* bucklers and shields, all of them handling swords. ⁵ **Persia, Ethiopia, and Libya** are with them, all of them *with* shield and helmet; ⁶ Gomer and all its troops; the house of **Togarmah** *from* the far north and all its troops—many people *are* with you. _Ezekiel 38:1-6
- “The **sons of Japheth** were Gomer, Magog, Madai, Javan, Tubal, Meshech, and Tiras.” – Genesis 10:2

- ² For you yourselves know perfectly that the day of the Lord so comes as a **thief in the night**. ³ For when they say, “**Peace and safety!**” then sudden destruction comes upon them, as labor pains upon a pregnant woman. And they shall not escape. ⁴ But you, brethren, are **not in darkness**, so that this **Day should overtake you as a thief**. ⁵ You are **all sons of light** and **sons of the day**. We are not of the night nor of darkness. ⁶ Therefore let us not sleep, as others *do*, but let us watch and be sober. – 1 Thess 5:2-6
