
Keeping the Sabbath – 4th Commandment

- ⁸ “Remember the Sabbath day, to keep it holy. ⁹ Six days you shall labor and do all your work, ¹⁰ but the seventh day *is* the Sabbath of the LORD your God. *In it* you shall do no work: you, nor your son, nor your daughter, nor your male servant, nor your female servant, nor your cattle, nor your stranger who *is* within your gates. ¹¹ For *in* six days the LORD made the heavens and the earth, the sea, and all that *is* in them, and **rested the seventh day**. Therefore, the **LORD blessed the Sabbath day** and hallowed it.” – Exodus 20:8-11

The Blessing of Keeping Sabbath – Isaiah 58:13-14

- ¹³ “If you **turn away** your foot from the Sabbath,
From doing your pleasure on My holy day,
And call the Sabbath a **delight**,
The holy *day* of the LORD honorable,
And shall honor Him, **not doing your own ways**,
Nor finding your own pleasure,
Nor speaking *your own words*,
- ¹⁴ Then you shall delight yourself in the LORD;
And I will **cause you to ride** on the high hills of the earth,
And **feed you** with the heritage of Jacob your father.
The mouth of the LORD has spoken.”

Rest In the Waiting

Hebrews 4:1-3

Therefore, since the promise of entering his rest still stands, let us be careful that none of you be found to have fallen short of it. For we also have had the good news proclaimed to us, just as they did; but the message they heard was of no value to them, because they did not share the faith of those who obeyed. 3 Now we who have believed enter that rest...

Summary so far...How to Prepare

To know Yeshua intimately...HE is speaking to us directly through HIS Word

Pay close attention to the Word, lest we drift away

Remove our Unbelief – do not harden your heart, Trust & Obey

Work & Waiting from the position of Rest, doing ABBA's Business

Hear - Understand - Obey



Hebrews 6:1-3

“⁹ But, beloved, we are confident of better things concerning you, yes, things that accompany salvation, though we speak in this manner. ¹⁰ **For God is not unjust to forget your work and labor of love** which you have shown toward His name, *in that* you have ministered to the saints, and do minister. ¹¹ And we desire that each one of you show the same diligence to the **full assurance of hope** until the end, ¹² that you do not **become sluggish**, but **imitate those** who through **faith and patience inherit the promises.**” – Hebrew 6:9-12

What is the
Anchor of
Hope?

The Anchor of Our HOPE – Yeshua Our High Priest

- “¹³ For when God made a promise to Abraham, because He could swear by no one greater, He **swore by Himself**, ¹⁴ saying, “Surely blessing **I will bless you**, and **multiplying I will multiply you**.” ¹⁵ And so, after he had patiently endured, he **obtained the promise.**” – Hebrews 6:13-15
- So what is our HOPE?
- “¹⁹ This *hope* we have as an anchor of the soul, ***both sure and steadfast***, and which enters the *Presence* behind the veil, ²⁰ where the forerunner has entered for us, ***even Jesus, having become High Priest forever according to the order of Melchizedek.***” – Hebrews 6:19-20

A New & Better Covenant – Hebrews 8:10-12

- “¹⁰ For this *is* the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel after those days, says the LORD:
 - **I will put My laws in their mind** and
 - **write them on their hearts;** and
 - **I will be their God,** and
 - they shall be **My people.**
 - ¹¹ None of them shall teach his neighbour, and none his brother, saying, ‘Know the LORD,’ for **all shall know Me**, from the least of them to the greatest of them.
 - ¹² For I will **be merciful** to their unrighteousness, and
 - **their sins** and their **lawless deeds** I will **remember no more.**”

The Power of the Blood of Yeshua

- ¹³ For if the blood of bulls and goats and the **ashes of a heifer**, sprinkling the unclean, sanctifies for the purifying of the flesh, ¹⁴ **how much more shall the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit** offered Himself without spot to God, **cleanse your conscience from dead works to serve the living God?**” – Hebrews 9:13-14

The Knowing that Yeshua is Returning for Us

- **²⁷ And as it is appointed for men to die once, but after this the judgment, ²⁸ so Christ was offered once to bear the sins of many. To those who eagerly wait for Him He will appear a second time, apart from sin, for salvation.” – Hebrews 9:27-28**

What Yeshua Had Done on the Cross

- “⁸ Previously saying, “Sacrifice and offering, burnt offerings, and *offerings* for sin You did not desire, nor had pleasure *in them*” (which are offered according to the law), ⁹ then He said, “**Behold, I have come to do Your will, O God.**” He **takes away the first** that He may **establish the second.** ¹⁰ By that will **we have been sanctified through** the offering of the **body of Jesus Christ once *for all.***” – Hebrew 10:8-10
- Justified by HIS Death
- Sanctified by HIS Body
- Glorified by HIS Resurrection

Yeshua Has Perfected Us by His Sacrifice

- “¹¹ And every priest stands ministering daily and offering repeatedly the same sacrifices, which can never take away sins. ¹² But **this Man (Yeshua)**, after He had offered one sacrifice for sins forever, **sat down at the right hand of God**, ¹³ from **that time waiting till His enemies are made His footstool**. ¹⁴ For by **one offering** He has **perfected forever** those who are **being sanctified.**” – Hebrews 10:11-14

These Are Our Assignments – Hebrews 10:19-23

“¹⁹ Therefore, brethren, having boldness to **enter the Holiest** by the **blood of Jesus**, ²⁰ by a new and living way which He consecrated for us, **through the veil, that is, His flesh**, ²¹ and *having* a High Priest over the house of God, ²² let us draw near with a true heart in full **assurance of faith**, having our hearts sprinkled from an evil conscience and our bodies washed with pure water. ²³ Let

- **us hold fast the confession of *our* hope**
- **without wavering**, for He who promised *is* faithful. ²⁴ And let
- **us consider one another** in order
- **to stir up love and**
- **good works**, ²⁵
- **not forsaking the assembling of ourselves** together, as *is* the manner of some, but
- **exhorting *one another***, and
- **so much the more as you see the Day approaching.**

Strong Advice – Persevere to Finish Well

“³² Remember those earlier days after you had received the light, when **you endured** in a great conflict full of suffering. Hebrew 10:32 (NIV)

³⁵ So do not throw away your confidence; it will be richly rewarded. ³⁶ You need to persevere so that **when you have done** the will of God, you **will receive** what he has promised. **³⁷ For, “In just a little while, he who is coming will come** and will not delay.**³⁸ And “But my righteous one will live by faith. And I take no pleasure in the one who shrinks back. ³⁹ But we do not belong to those who shrink back and are destroyed, but to those who have faith and are saved.”** – Hebrew 10:35-39

Doctrine of Faith

- “**11** Now faith is the **substance of things** (NIV: confidence) **hoped for**, the **evidence of things not seen** (NIV: assurance about what we do not see). ² For by it the elders obtained a *good* testimony.
- ³ By faith we understand that the worlds (NIV: universe) were framed by the word of God (NIV: command of God), so that the things which are seen were not made of things which are visible. – Hebrews 11:1-3

How To Please GOD?

- “⁶ But **without faith** *it is impossible to please Him*, for he who comes to God **must believe** that **He is**, and *that He is a rewarder* of those who **diligently seek Him.**” – Hebrews 11:6

How Not To Lose Heart despite Persecution

- **12** Therefore we also, since we are **surrounded by** so great **a cloud of witnesses**, let us **lay aside** every weight, **and the sin** which so easily ensnares *us*, and let us **run with endurance** the race that is set before us, ² **looking unto Jesus**, the author and finisher of *our* faith, who for the **joy that was set before Him** endured the cross, despising the shame, and has sat down at the right hand of the throne of God.
 1. Move away from sinful acts
 2. Race requires Endurance & Perseverance
 3. Focus on Yeshua
 4. Be motivated by our eternal rewards

Abba Father Encourages Us

- ⁴ In **your struggle against sin**, you have **not yet resisted** to the point of **shedding your blood**. ⁵ And have you completely forgotten this **word of encouragement** that addresses you as a father addresses his son? It says,
- “My son, do not make light of the Lord’s discipline,
and **do not lose heart** when he rebukes you,
⁶ because **the Lord disciplines the one he loves**,
and he **chastens everyone** he **accepts as his son.**” – Hebrews 12:4-6 (NIV)

Live a Life of Holiness

- ¹⁴ Make **every effort to live in peace** with everyone and to **be holy**; without holiness no one will see the Lord. ¹⁵ See to it that no one falls ***short of the grace of God*** and that no **bitter root grows** up to cause trouble and defile many.” – Hebrews 12:14-15

All Things Will Be Shaken – But No Fear

²⁶ At that time his voice shook the earth, but now he has promised, “Once more I will **shake not only the earth but also the heavens.**” ²⁷ The words “once more” indicate the removing of what **can be shaken—that is, created things—so that what cannot be shaken may remain.** ²⁸ Therefore, since we are receiving a kingdom that **cannot be shaken**, let us be thankful, and so worship God acceptably with reverence and awe, ²⁹ for our “**God is a consuming fire.**” – Hebrews: 12:26-29

Concluding Exhortations – Hebrews 13

- ¹ Keep on **loving one** another as brothers and sisters.
- ² **Do not forget to show hospitality** to strangers, for by so doing some people have shown hospitality to angels without knowing it.
- ³ **Continue to remember those in prison** as if you were together with them in prison, and those who are mistreated as if you yourselves were suffering.
- ⁴ Marriage should be honored by all, and **the marriage bed kept pure**, for God will judge the adulterer and all the sexually immoral.
- ⁵ **Keep your lives free from the love of money** and be content with what you have, because God has said,
- **“Never will I leave you;
never will I forsake you.”**

Concluding Exhortations – Hebrews 13

- ⁶ So we say with confidence,
- **“The Lord is my helper; I will not be afraid.**
What can mere mortals do to me?”
- ⁷ **Remember your leaders**, who spoke the word of God to you. Consider the outcome of their way of life and **imitate their faith**.
- ⁸ **Jesus Christ is the same yesterday and today and forever.**
- ¹⁵ Through Jesus, therefore, let us continually **offer to God a sacrifice of praise**—the fruit of lips that openly profess his name. ¹⁶ And do not forget to do good and to share with others, for with such sacrifices God is pleased.
- ¹⁷ **Have confidence in your leaders** and **submit to their authority**, because they **keep watch over you** as those who **must give an account**. Do this so that their work will be a joy, not a burden, for that would be of no benefit to you.
