

Number 17

- In Hebrew is Yod Zayin which means VICTORY
- It also symbolizes "overcoming the enemy"
- The Flood came on the 17th of the second month
- Noah ark rested on the mountains of Ararat on the 17th of the seventh month
- The Third day of the Feast of Tabernacles


Number 17

⁴Then the ark rested in the **seventh month**, the **seventeenth day** of the month, on the mountains of Ararat. – Genesis 8:4

The Feast of Tabernacles starts on the 15th day of the Seventh month for seven days 15th day - Sabbath (Holy Convocation) 22nd day – Sabbath (Holy Convocation)

Number 17 and Abraham





A Prophecy Against Damascus – Isaiah 17


- 17 A prophecy against Damascus:

 - ³The fortified city will disappear from Ephraim, and royal power from Damascus;
 - the remnant of Aram will be like the glory of the Israelites," declares the LORD Almighty.
