Is the Omega of the Bible


Bible started from Genesis which is the Alpha, the Fall of Man and the of all things

What the Book of Revelation is

- NOT a book of gloom and doom
- It is about Victory and Triumph of good over evil
- It is about the Overcomers made victorious by
 - the Blood of the Lamb and by
 - their testimony Rev 12:11
- It is about the return of conquering King with the Saints over Satan Rev 20:6
- It is about the Marriage Supper of the Lamb Rev 19:6-9
- It is about 1,000 years rule and reign with Christ – Rev 20:6
- Is about the New Jerusalem Rev 21:1-3

Apokalupsis

GOD does not want you to live in IGNORANCE

HE reveals what is to come so you could be PREPARED

It is the REVELATION of Jesus Christ

Greek Word of Revelation is "Apokalupsis" – uncovering, or drawing away of the veil of darknessThis revelation does not **come** from man BUT **from GOD** Himself to HIS Son

Our **natural mind cannot** understand spiritual things

• ¹⁴ But the natural man does not receive the things of the Spirit of God, for they are foolishness to him; nor can he know *them*, because they are spiritually discerned. – 1 Cor 2:14

Revelation is from Abba Father God

- 2. The Alpha & Omega
- 3. King of kings
- 4. The Lamb of GOD
- 5. Lion of the tribe of Judah
- 6. The great shepherd
- 7. The Lord of the harvest
- 8. The mighty, conquering warrior Messiah

Use your spirit being...

- Do not try to understand the Book of Revelation by your natural being
- Is Spirit to spirit "17" He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches." Rev 2:17a
- "9 But as it is written: "Eye has not seen, nor ear heard, Nor have entered into the heart of man the things which God has prepared for those who love Him."
 10 But God has revealed them to us through His Spirit. For the Spirit searches all things, yes, the deep things of God." 1 Cor 2:9-10

The Time is NOW

- The Time is at hand Is Harvest Time
- To help you to know the signs of the Times
- It's Time to Prepare, to Watch, and to be Ready

The Sevenfold Blessings (brachot) Revelation Rev 1:3 "Blessed *is* he who **reads** and those who **hear** the words of this prophecy and **keep** those things which are written in it; for the **time** *is* near."

A1 - Rev 14:13 "Then I heard a voice from heaven saying to me, "Write: 'Blessed are the dead who die in the Lord from now on."

B1 - Rev 16:15 "Behold, I am coming as a thief. Blessed *is* he who watches, and keeps his garments, lest he walk naked, and they see his shame."

The Sevenfold Blessings (brachot) Revelation

C1 - Rev 19:9 "Then he said to me, "Write: 'Blessed *are* those who are called to the marriage supper of the Lamb!' " And he said to me, "These are the true sayings of God"

C2 - Rev 20:6 "Blessed and holy is he who has part in the first resurrection. Over such the second death has no power, but they shall be priests of God and of Christ, and shall reign with Him a thousand years."

B2 - Rev 22:7 "Behold, I am coming quickly! Blessed *is* he who **keeps** the words of the prophecy of this book."

A2 - Rev 22:14 "Blessed *are* those who **do His commandments**, that they may have **the right to the tree of life**, and may **enter through the gates into the city."**

Seven Blessings – Beautiful Pattern (Chiasm)

Rev 1:3 is the summary Statement of the remaining six blessings

A1 – Rev 14:13 (speak of life of the believer and his eternal destiny)


B1 – Rev 14:13 (need for vigilance – the Lord is returning)

C1 – Rev 16:15 (Blessed future – wedding of the Lamb)

C2 - Rev 20:6 (Blessed future - resurrection)

B2 - Rev 22:7 (need for vigilance – the Lord is returning)

A2 - Rev 22:14 (speak of life, the right to the tree of life)





Hebrew Interpretation of Scripture – 4 Levels

P'Shat – Direct and Simple instruction

Remez – Hinting or implied meaning

Darash – Commentary and comparison

Sod – with deep and hidden meaning

The Hebraic Interpretation

P'Shat – Seven letters written to the seven churches

Remez – Is a Apokalupsis (Uncovering) of events to come

Darash – Comparing the condition (image) of the seven churches as representative of the churches in John's days and our time

Sod – Spiritual conditions existing in church spanning the time to the Millennium era
