The Feast of Atonement on Earth is a “copy and shadow of the heavenly things, as Moses
was divinely instructed when he was about to make the tabernacle...” - Hebrew 8:5a

Greatest of Christ's Sacrifice

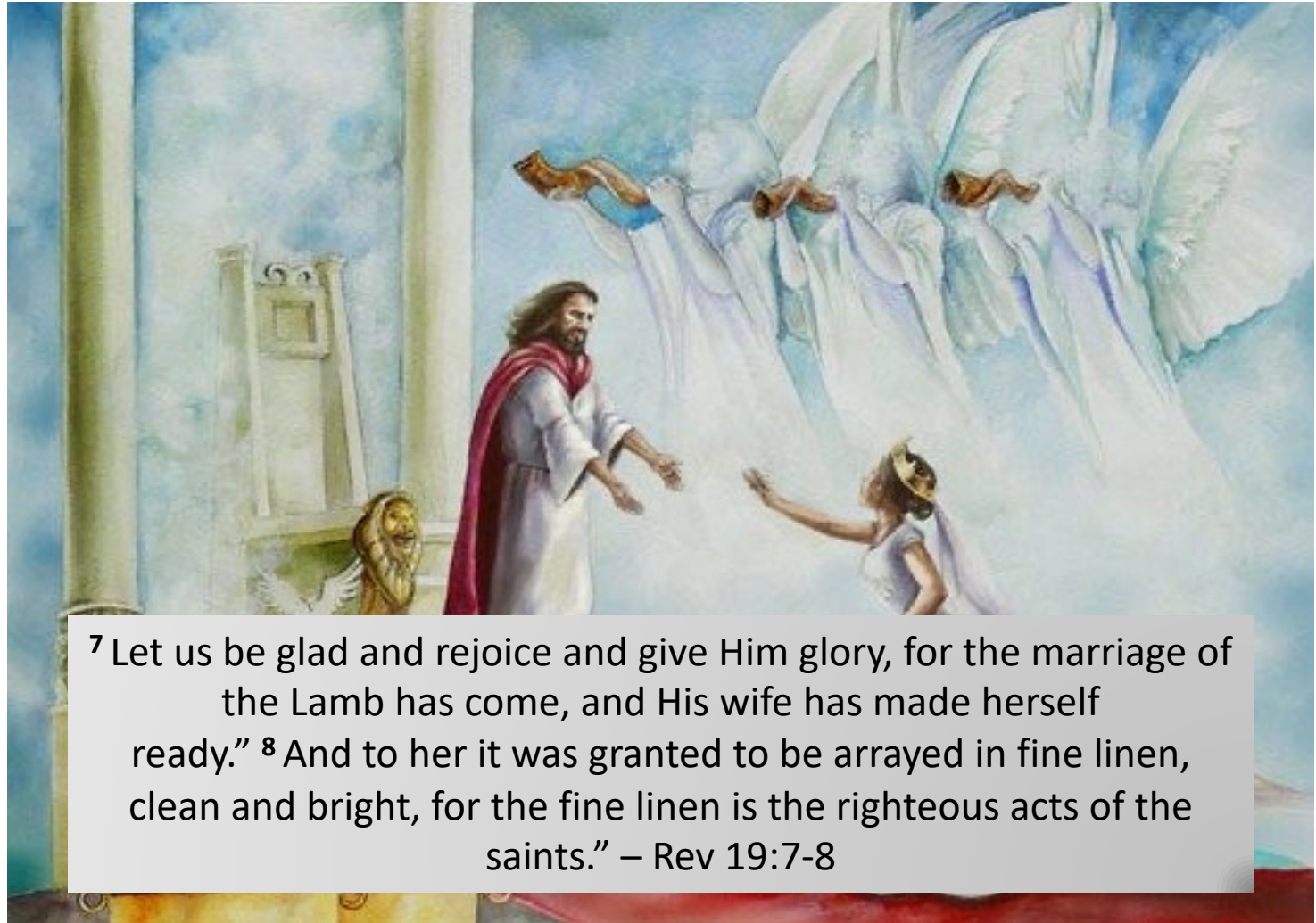
²³ Therefore *it was* necessary that the copies of the things in the heavens should be purified with these, ***but the heavenly things themselves with better sacrifices than these.*** ²⁴ For Christ has not entered the holy places made with hands, *which are* copies of the true, but into heaven itself, ***now to appear*** in the presence of God for us; ²⁵ not that He should offer Himself often, as the high priest enters the Most Holy Place every year with blood of another— ²⁶ He then would have had to suffer often since the foundation of the world; ***but*** now, once ***at the end of the ages***, He has appeared to put away sin by the sacrifice of Himself. ²⁷ And as it is appointed for ***men to die once, but after this the judgment,***” - Hebrew 9:23-27

Scene In Heaven

- ¹⁵ The **seventh angel sounded his trumpet**, and there were loud voices in heaven, which said:
 - “The kingdom of the world has become the kingdom of our Lord and of his Messiah, and he will reign for ever and ever.” –Rev 11:15
- ¹⁹ Then the temple of God was opened in heaven, and the ark of His covenant was seen in His temple. And there were lightnings, noises, thunderings, an earthquake, and great hail. – Rev 11:19



Connecting the Dots...

- ⁵ Then the angel took the censer, filled it with fire from the altar, and threw *it* to the earth. And there were noises, **thunderings, lightnings**, and an **earthquake.**” – Rev 8:5
- **Sixth Seal: Cosmic Disturbances**
- ¹² I looked when He opened the sixth seal, and behold, there was a **great earthquake**; and the **sun became black** as sackcloth of hair, and the **moon became like blood.**” – Rev 6:12
- “The sun shall be turned into darkness, And the **moon** into **blood**, Before the coming of the great and **awesome day of the LORD.**” – Joel 2:31
- ¹⁷ For the **great day of His wrath** has come, and who is able to stand?” – Rev 6:17

Ten Virgins – Matthew 25:1-13

- Five were wise, five were foolish
- All are believers
- All have oil, but the foolish ones do not have sufficient oil
- Wise virgins (the Bride) went with the Bridegroom and the door was shut” – Matt 25:10b
- The foolish ones will be martyred to make it to the Marriage Supper of the Lamb



Matthew 25 – Parables of the Talents

- “For the kingdom of heaven is like a man travelling to a far country, who called his own servants and delivered his goods to them. ¹⁵ And to one he gave five talents, to another two, and to another one, to each according to his own ability; and immediately he went on a journey.”- Matthew 25:14-15 –
- Five talents becomes 10 talents
- Two talents become 4 talents
- One talent remains as one talent
- ²⁹ ‘For to everyone who has, more will be given, and he will have abundance; but from him who does not have, even what he has will be taken away. ³⁰ And cast the unprofitable servant into the outer darkness. There will be weeping and gnashing of teeth.’- Matthew 25:29-30

to See

The First Four Trumpets

- First Trumpet – Hail mingled with fire – a third of the trees were destroyed and all the green grass were burned up – Rev 8:7
- Second Trumpet – Something like a great mountain burning with fire was thrown into the sea, a third of sea became blood, a third of the sea creatures died, a third of the ships were destroyed – Rev 8:8

Notable Signs For All to See

The First Four Trumpets

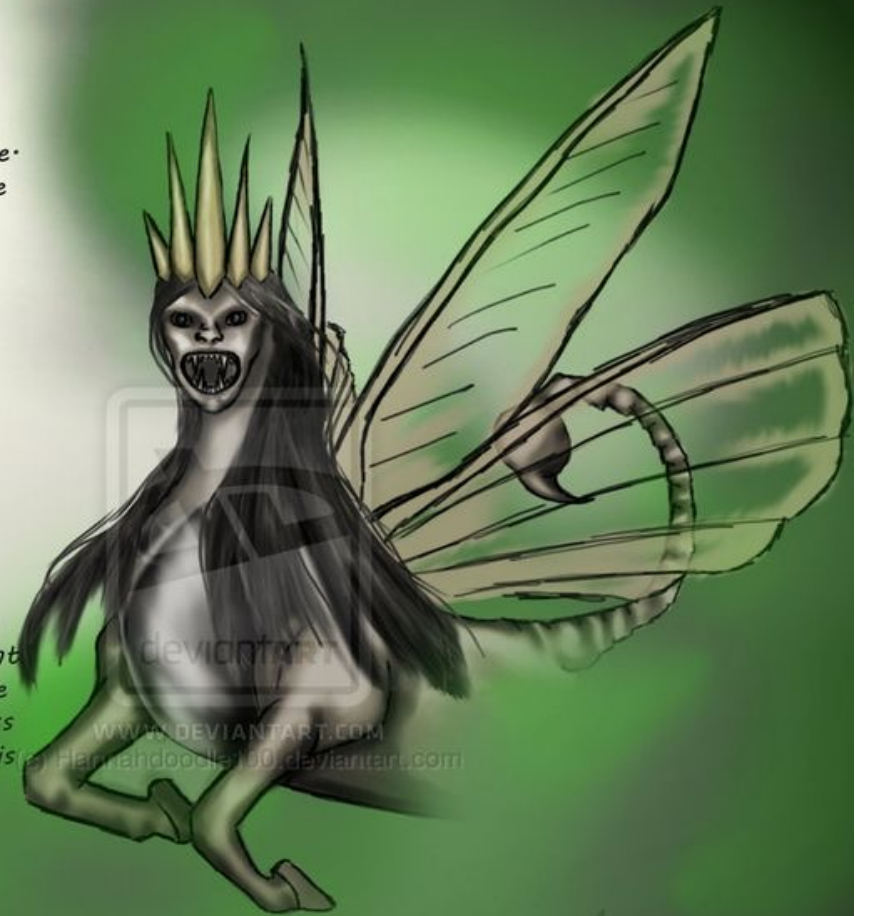
- Third Trumpet – A great star (meteorite?) known as Wormwood, a third of the rivers became polluted and many men died from the polluted water – Rev 8:11
- Fourth Trumpet - third of the sun was struck, a third of the moon, and a third of the stars, so that a third of them were darkened. A third of the day did not shine, and likewise the night. – Rev 12

First Woe – Fifth Trumpet

- Angel from heaven holds the key to the bottomless pit
- He opens the Bottomless Pit
- Like locusts – torment mankind for five months
- King over them is Abaddon

Revelations 9:7

7The locusts looked like horses prepared for battle. They had what looked like gold crowns on their heads, and their faces looked like human faces. 8They had hair like women's hair and teeth like the teeth of a lion. 9They wore armor made of iron, and their wings roared like an army of chariots rushing into battle. 10They had tails that stung like scorpions, and for five months they had the power to torment people. 11Their king is the angel from the bottomless pit; his name in Hebrew is Abaddon, and in Greek, Apollyon—the Destroyer.



Who Are These Locusts?

- ⁴ The Nephilim were on the earth in those days—and also afterward—when the sons of God went to the daughters of humans and had children by them. They were the heroes of old, men of renown.” – Genesis 6:4
- ⁵ They were not allowed to kill them but only to torture them for five months. And the agony they suffered was like that of the sting of a scorpion when it strikes.” – Rev 9:5
- Sexual perversion - hybrid (Nephilim) once again roam the earth, like in the Days of Noah

Who Is Abaddon?

God created Six Cherubin

1. Michael, the warring angel guarding Israel
 2. Gabriel, the messenger angel
 3. Uriel, the angel of light
 4. Raphael, the angel of healing
- Two Cherubin rebelled against God
1. Lucifer, the angel of worship – Isa 14:12-14
 2. Abaddon, the angel of the Bottomless Pit – Rev 9:1-11

Second Woe – Sixth Trumpet

- “Release the four angels who are bound at the great river Euphrates” – Rev 9:14
- A third of mankind killed
- Army of two hundred million strong – Armageddon War (Rev 16:16)
- ¹⁸ By these three *plagues* a third of mankind was killed—by the *fire* and the *smoke* and the *brimstone* which came out of their mouths.”
- In the Second Woe, we have the two witnesses
- Two witnesses killed by Abaddon
- Two witnesses resurrected after three-and-a-half days
- Great earthquake in Jerusalem and 7,000 people were killed Rev 11:13

Third Woe & The Seventh Trumpet (the Rapture)

- Kingdom of God proclaimed – Rev 11:15
- The wrath of God has come – Rev 11:18
- ¹⁹ Then the *temple of God was opened in heaven*, and the *ark of His covenant* was seen in His temple. And there were *lightnings, noises, thunderings, an earthquake, and great hail.*” – Rev 11:1
- The Seventh Trumpet sounded – Rapture of the Bride/Church follow soon by the opening of the Seventh Seal and the Marriage Supper of the Lamb – Rev 19:9

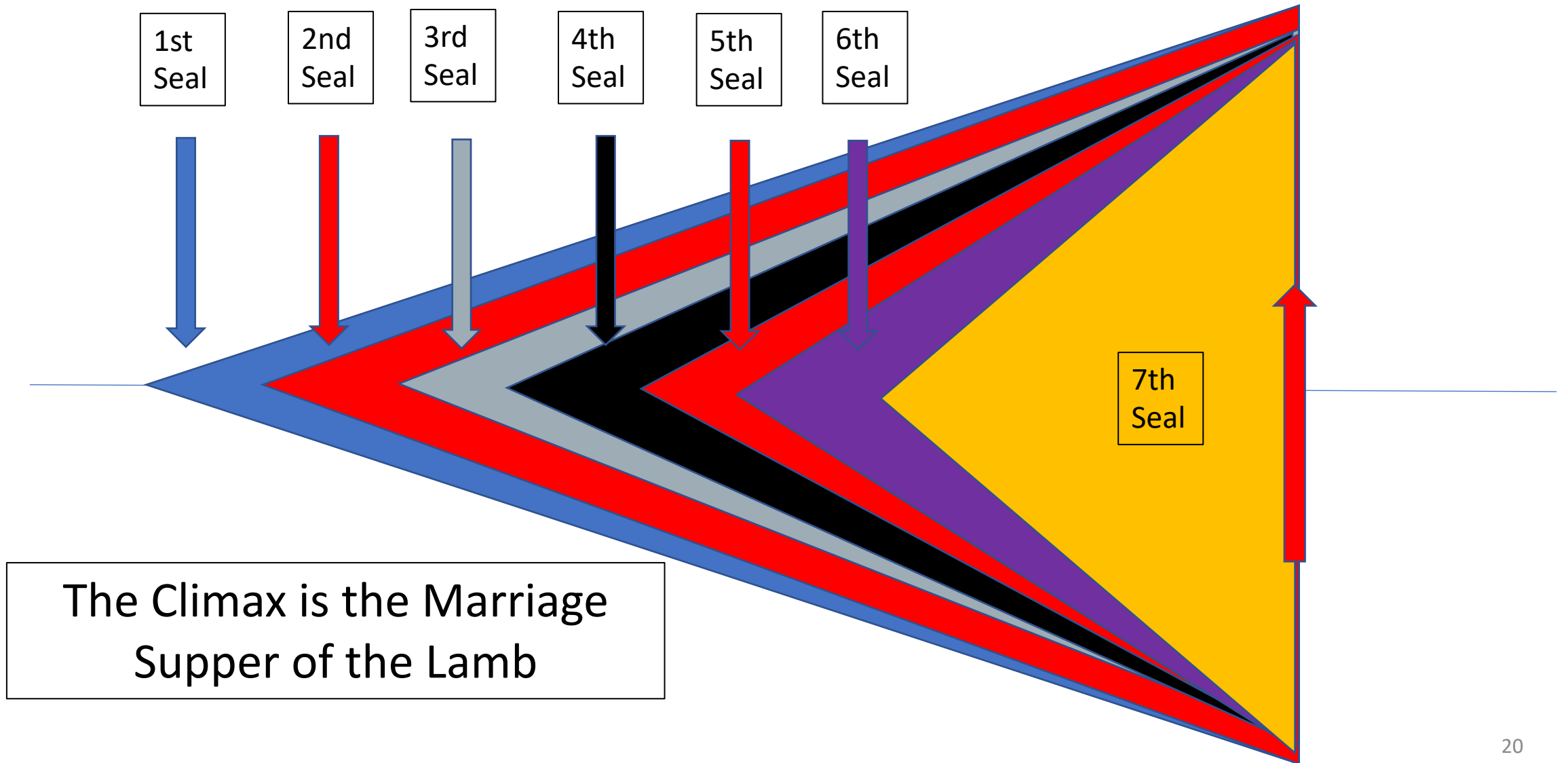
Where Do We Place all the Seven Trumpets?

	Rev 6:12-17 Sixth Seal	Rev 8:2-13, Rev 9 (Woe1&2), Rev 12:7-12 (Woe3)
Intro	Rev 6:12a –Great Earthquake	Rev 8:5 – noises, thunderings, lightnings, earthquake
1	Rev 6:12a - Sun became black	1 st Trumpet – hail and fire mingled with blood
2	Rev 6:12b - Moon became like blood	2 nd Trumpet – great mountain burning with fire, sea - blood
3	Rev 6:13 – Stars of heaven fell to earth	3 rd Trumpet – great star from heaven, water became bitter
4	Rev 6:14 – the sky receded as a scroll	4 th Trumpet – 1/3 sun, moon, star darkened
5	Rev 6:15 – men hid themselves in the caves	5 th Trumpet – Woe number 1, locusts from the bottomless pit led by fallen angel, Abaddon, the angel of abyss
6	Rev 6:16 - Men unrepentant, wrath of the Lamb	6 th Trumpet – Woe number 2, Global war, 1/3 mankind killed. 200 million army strong
7	Marriage Supper of the Lamb in heaven. Rev 6:17 – Great day of God’s wrath has come	7 th Trumpet – Woe number 3, Rev 12:12 “Therefore rejoice, O heavens and you who dwell in them! Woe to the inhabitants of the earth and the sea! For the devil has come down to you, having great wrath, because he knows that he has a short time.”

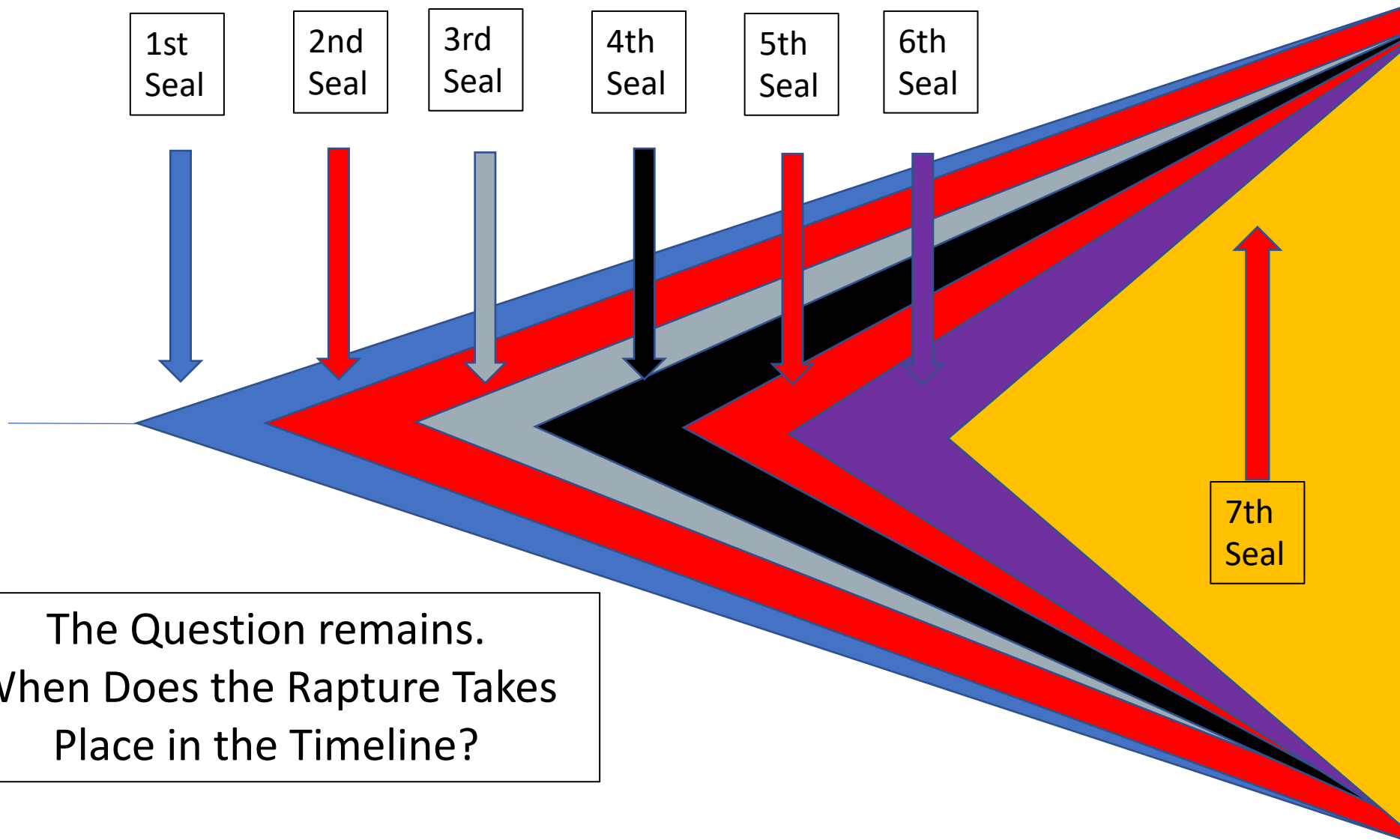
How Do We Know Rapture is the Last Trumpet?

- “For the Lord Himself will descend from heaven with **a shout**, with the **voice of an archangel**, and with the **trumpet of God**. And the dead in Christ will rise first. ¹⁷ Then we who are alive *and* remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air. And thus we shall always be with the Lord.” - 1 Thess 4:16-17
- “Then the **seventh angel sounded**: And there were **loud voices** in heaven, saying, “**The kingdoms of this world have become *the* kingdoms of our Lord and of His Christ, and He shall reign forever and ever!**” ¹⁶ And the twenty-four elders who sat before God on their thrones fell on their faces and worshiped God,” – Rev 11:15

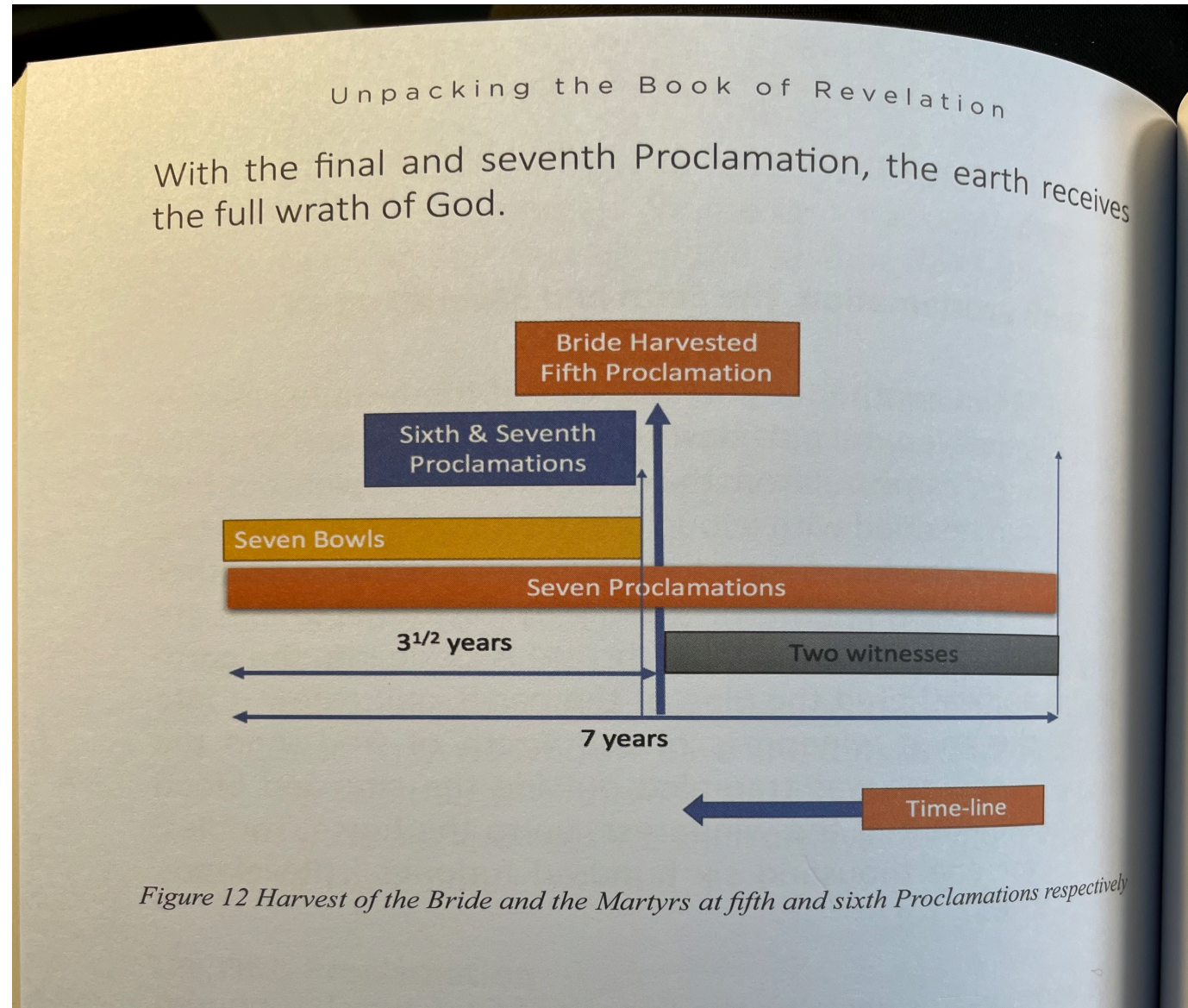
When All the Seals are Opened



All Seals Climax At the End of the Wrath of the Dragon is completed. The comes the WRATH OF THE LAMB – REV 6:11,17

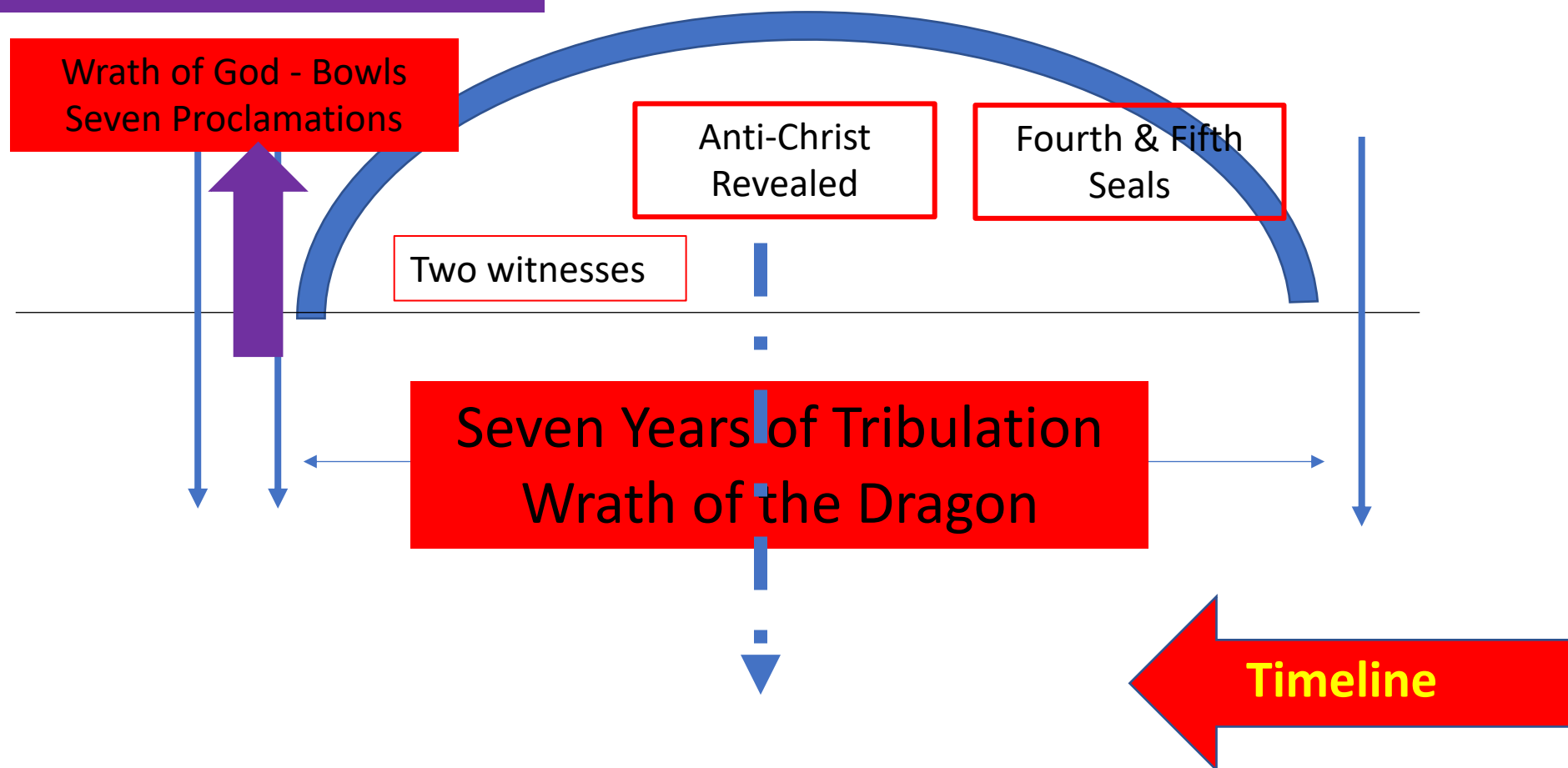
