Biblical Examples – The Centurion

- ⁵ Now when Jesus had entered Capernaum, a *centurion came to Him*, pleading with Him, ⁶ saying, "Lord, my servant is lying at home paralyzed, dreadfully tormented." ⁷ And Jesus said to him, "*I will come and heal him*."
- ⁸The centurion answered and said, "Lord, I am not worthy that You should come under my roof. But only speak a word, and my servant will be healed.
- ⁹ For *I also am a man under authority*, having soldiers under me. And I say to this one, 'Go,' and he goes; and to another, 'Come,' and he comes; and to my servant, 'Do this,' and he does it." Matthew 8:5-9

Learning Points on Honoring

- 1. The Centurion honored Yeshua by:
 - 1. Recognizing the person in (Yeshua) authority
 - Just speak the Word, and his servant would be healed
- 2. To have authority, requires to be under Authority
 - The Centurion is under the authority of the Roman Empire
 - Yeshua's submission to the Father unto death– accepting the Cross

God is the Ultimate Authority

"21 He who has My commandments and keeps them, it is he who loves Me. And he who loves Me will be loved by My Father, and I will love him and manifest Myself to him." - John 14:21



Cursed *is* the one who treats his father or his mother with contempt.' – Deuteronomy 27:16



Genesis 9:25-27

- ²⁵ Then he said:
- "Cursed be Canaan;
 A servant of servants
 He shall be to his brethren."
- ²⁶ And he said:
- "Blessed be the LORD,
 The God of Shem,
 And may Canaan be his servant.
 27 May God enlarge Japheth,
 And may he dwell in the tents of Shem;
 And may Canaan be his servant."

Moral Failure of Ham – Heart Issue

Brought curses to his descendants

The Canaanites were descendants of Ham

Destroyed by the children of Israel

Another Example – Reuben, First Born of Jacob

- He lost his birth right because he dishonored his father
 - He slept with his father concubine Bilhah
- Bilhah was Rachel's maid
- Reuben heart was grieved by Jacob's love for Rachel more than his mother
- Several incidences that cemented this resentment which fostered dishonor
 - 1. When Esau met Jacob Jacob placed Leah's family before Rachel's
 - 2. Jacob's favoritism over Rachel's son, Joseph
- "Now the sons of Reuben the firstborn of Israel—he was indeed the firstborn, but because he defiled his father's bed, his birth right was given to the sons of Joseph, the son of Israel, so that the genealogy is not listed according to the birth right;" – 1 Chronicles 5:1

What is the Lesson Here?

Was Jacob's behavior right with God?

Reuben was affected by his father's behavior towards his mother

This resentment brought bitterness

Bitterness brought dishonor

Do Not Allow Bad Behavior to Rob you of your Rewards



- Jacob's favored Rachel over Leah
 - Reuben lost his First-Born Rights
- The Israelites
 constant disobedient
 to the Lord in the
 wilderness
 - Caused Moses not able to enter the Promised Land

Honoring Parents — Two-Fold Rewards

First – It will go well with you

- Achieve success
- Peace, joy, love and health be with you

- you
live a
long life

- Not to die prematurely
- No fatal accident, unforeseen accident


Understand This Spiritual Law
