

† ISRAEL AND THE CHURCH



Yeshua
we pray
sanctify us in Your truth.
Amen

Today I am going to show you
in the Bible
that you are all Israel,
for the root of the church is Israel.

The Story of Esther
can help us understand
that the church is part of Israel.

There is a story in the Bible
about a young Jewish orphan girl name Esther
who was adopted by her Jewish uncle
name Mordechai
and she become a queen.

But the Bible tells us
that Esther's real name
was NOT Esther,
Esther's real name was a Jewish name
her name was Hadassah.

Esther was an orphan
and she was adopted
by Mordechai.

and because of persecution
Mordechai, Changed Hadassah's name
to a gentile's name - Esther.

And we know from the Bible
that Esther grew up in beauty
and married the king.

But Mordechai told Esther
not to reveal her identity.
not to reveal
who her people are.

Esther's Jewish roots
had to remind secret!

The Bible continues to tell us
that a man named Haman
rose in the king's palace.
he wanted to kill all the Jews.

But God had a plan!

Mordechai then
asked Esther to risk her life,
and to go before the king,
an action that was forbidden to do...

So Mordechai send Esther
a message saying:

Esther 4:13-14

Then Mordecai told them
to reply to Esther,

“Do not think to yourself
that in the king's palace
you will escape

any more than all the other Jews...

Esther 4:13-14

For if you keep silent at this time,
relief and deliverance will rise
for the Jews from another place,
but you and your father's house
will perish.

And who knows whether you
have not come to the kingdom
for such a time as this?

And Esther decided to risk her own life
and she said:
I will go before the king
and if I perish I perish.

And Esther
went before the king
and interceded for her people.

And the Bible tells us
that when the king saw Esther
he held out to her the golden scepter
and he said to her:

Esther 5:3

And the king said to her,
“What is it, Queen Esther?
What is your request?
IT SHALL BE GIVEN YOU,
even to the half of my kingdom.”

God used Esther
to save all His people.

This story of Esther
reveals to us
the story of the church!

Just like Esther,
the Jewish root of the Church
had to remain hidden.

At the time
because of persecution
the name of the church was changed
from a Jewish name
to a Gentile name.

The name Christian
comes from the Greek origin
and it means “anoointed”.

But in Israel
we are called Messianic,
which is a Hebrew for “anointed”.

It has the same meaning,
but one is Jewish
and one is Greek.

And the church,
just like Esther,
grows up in beauty
and become
the bride of the king.

But there is a spirit that wants,
as always,
to destroy the Jews.
But the words of Mordechai
are still calling
telling Esther, telling the church.

Esther 4:13-14

“Do not think to yourself
that in the king's palace
you will escape any more
than all the other Jews.

For if you keep silent at this time,
relief and deliverance will
rise for the Jews from another place,
but you and your
father's house will perish.

God is calling Esther-His church
to intercede for her people.

God is calling His church
to stand with their brothers Judah,
the Jews.

Esther risked her life
and went before the king
to save her people,

And what did the king do?
The king held out to Esther
the golden scepter
and said to her:...

everything you ask
will be given to you
even to the half of my kingdom.

This is the calling of the church!

You must understand who you are!

There is a hidden secret
in the identity of Israel!

At the time of Yeshua, Jesus on earth,
there were many thousand
and tens of thousand
of people **WHO DID** believe
that Yeshua was their promised Messiah.

Peter, in the day of Pentecost
evangelized 3000 people,
in one day.

Jesus, when He multiplied the food,
at one time there were 5000 people,
and another time 7000 people...

3 years
Jesus and His disciples
evangelized in Israel
many many thousand
and tens of thousands of people.

And at that time
the people of Israel became divided
into two groups:

Those who believed
that Yeshua was their promised Messiah,
and those who did not believe
that He was their Messiah.

Those who did not believe
that Jesus was their promised Messiah,
their descendants
are the Jews of today,
the Israel of today.

So now arises the question!

Where are the descendants
of those tens of thousands of Israelites
who DID believe
that Yeshua was their promised Messiah?

where are they TODAY?

What were Yeshua's
last instruction
before He left the earth?

Yeshua, after He rose from the dead,
He appeared to His disciples
and commissioned them.

Mark 16:15

And Yeshua said to them,
“Go into ALL THE WORLD
and proclaim the gospel
to the WHOLE CREATION.

“Go into ALL THE WORLD
and proclaim the gospel
to the WHOLE CREATION.

After the crucifixion of Yeshua
there was persecution
against the believers in Israel.

And the disciples of Yeshua
and many many thousands of believers
had to leave Israel.

And they went
to the four corner of the earth,
just as Jesus commanded them,
and they preached the Gospel.

They were scattered
throughout the world.

As Yeshua
commissioned them,
they established churches
all over the world.

They inter-married
with their fellow believers,
the Gentiles,
And today they are called Christians,
the Church,
the hidden part of Israel.

Just like Esther,
the church
Because of persecution
received a Gentile name.

Just like Esther
the Church grew up in beauty
and became the bride of the king.

And just like
Esther's Jewish identity
had to be hidden
until the right time...

In the same way
the identity of the church
is hidden until the right time.

For God has always a plan!
Praise Him!

The Bible reveals to us
that the New Jerusalem,
which is our future home,
has twelve Gates
and twelve foundations.

And that upon each gate
of the New Jerusalem,
the names of the twelve tribes of Israel
are inscribed.

And upon the foundation
of the New Jerusalem,
are the names
of the twelve apostles
of our Messiah Yeshua.

Revelation 21:12

It [New Jerusalem] had
a great, high wall, with twelve gates,
and at the gates twelve angels,
and on the gates the names
of the twelve tribes of the sons of Israel
were inscribed—

Revelation 21:14

And the wall of the city
had twelve foundations,
and on them were the twelve names
of the twelve apostles of the Lamb.

What can we understand
from these verses?

The first thing that we can understand is:
that the twelve tribes of Israel
and the twelve apostles of the Messiah
are INSEPARABLE,
they are ONE.

No house can stand
without its foundation,
and a foundation is useless
without the building.

And the second point
we see in these verses is:
that there is no other way
to enter the city of God.

The twelve apostles of Jesus
they were all from Israel,
so is Jesus,
and so is the Church.

The Church will enter
the New Jerusalem
through the gates
upon which are the names
of the twelve tribes of Israel.

Because the church is part of Israel.

Amen

Today in Israel
Are mainly 2 tribes,
the tribe Benjamin
and the tribe Judah
And a small part of the tribe of Levies.

But according to the Bible
Israel is made of twelve tribes.
So where are the missing other
ten tribes of Israel?

Who are the missing ten tribes of Israel?
And where are they today?

And
what is Israel?

Let us start with the fact
that Israel is the name
God Himself created.

It is the name God gave to Jacob,
one of Abraham's grandson.

Israel-ישראל

-שר ראה אל

Prince who sees God

ישר אל

Straight-God

The one who goes in the way of God

The Bible tells us
that Jacob, was born holding the heel
of his brother Esau,
therefore he was named Jacob...

The name Jacob,
means in Hebrew
akev - heel- עֲקֵב]
very low.

So God
took Abraham's grandson- Jacob
from that very "low" place-heel,
and lifted him up
and transformed him
to become Israel.

Because the covenant
God made with Abraham,
God transform Jacob's destiny,
to a man who will inherit God's kingdom.

Because God planned
to bring forth
out of Abraham's seeds
the kingdom nation.

What was the first thing
that God did with Abraham
and with his wife Sarah?

God changed their name!

God changed their destiny,
creating through them
the nation of God.

God changed the name
of Abram to Abraham,
and his wife Sarai to Sarah
by adding part of God's name
into their names.

YHVH-יהוה

Abram-אברם

Abraham-אברהם

Sarai-שרי

sarah-שרה

Names are very important,
they are a seal of our destiny!

In the Bible,
the name Israel
is used to
represents The ONE kingdom,
the united Israel,
the twelve tribes of Israel.

But, the Bible tells us,
that later on,
the kingdom of Israel
was divided into two kingdoms;...

The Kingdom of the north,
which were
the ten tribes
UNDER EPHRAIM,
they became known as Israel.

And the two tribes
Judah and Benjamin
(and part of Levi),
became the southern kingdom,
under Judah.

And they are
the Jews of today.

The name Israel is also used in the Bible
for the Promised Land,
that God gave to Abraham
and his descendants.

But let us keep in mind
that today's Israel,
is what we know
as the Jewish nation,
is only Judah

The whole Bible is about
Israel
going from the one kingdom
under one king,
known as
the Tabernacle of David...

then
its splitting into two,
known as
the fallen Tabernacle of David.

And Israel's long journey
back to unity,
back to oneness...

when Israel will surrender again
to the One King,
the Messiah son of David;
and her final return to God.

Amos 9:11:

*In that day I WILL RAISE UP
THE TABERNACLE OF DAVID*

that is fallen,

and close up the breaches thereof;

and I will raise up his ruins,

and I will build it

AS IN THE DAYS OF OLD:

Acts 15:16:

“After this I will return,
and will build again the
tabernacle of David,
which is fallen down;
and I will build again
the ruins thereof,
and I will set it up:”

And when all the tribes of Israel
will be united again
into one nation under one king
her Messiah,
together they will inherit
the golden promised holy City,
the New Jerusalem.

Amen.

The name Jerusalem literally means;
the inheritance of God's Shalom,
which is God's Kingdom.

Jerusalem - ירושלים

Inheritance - ירושה

Peace - שלום

So let us see and understand
the journey of Israel
in the Bible.

The Bible likens
the Kingdom of David
to the kingdom of the Messiah,
why?

David was a man after God's heart,
David fought God's battles,
David defeated God's enemies,
David established God's ways in Israel...

David established a constant worship to God
in Israel,

And David prepared all the materials
for the building of the Temple of God.

And God loved David
and God raised up
the tabernacle of David;
one nation
under one God
which always worshiped her God.

and God promised David
that David's throne
shall be established forever.

2 Samuel 7:16

And your house [David]
and your kingdom
[David]

shall be made sure forever before me.
Your throne shall be established forever.

In the time of king David's reign,
all the twelve tribes were
ONE PEOPLE
UNDER ONE KING
(The tabernacle of David).

But after the death of king David
and the death king Solomon
the twelve tribes of Israel
split into two kingdoms:

The kingdom of the north
which was
Ephraim
leading the other nine tribes.

And the kingdom of the south
Juda, Benjamin and part of the tribe of Levi.

The Bible tells us
that the ten tribes that followed Ephraim
were later scatter
among the nations of the world.

and only the kingdom of the south
remained in Israel,
under the leadership of Juda,
which are the Jews of our time.

This division of Israel
came as a consequence
of Solomon's sins,
of Solomon's disobedience to God.

The Lord was angry with Solomon
because he had turned his heart
and the heart of all the nation of Israel
away from the God of Israel.

1 Kings 11:11-13

11. Therefore the LORD said to Solomon,
“Since this has been your practice
and you have NOT kept My covenant
and My statutes that I have commanded you,
I WILL SURELY TEAR THE KINGDOM FROM YOU
and will give it to your servant...

1 Kings 11:11-13

12. Yet for the sake of David your father
I will not do it in your days,
but I will tear it
out of the hand of your son...

1 Kings 11:11-13

13. However,
I will not tear away all the kingdom,
BUT I WILL GIVE ONE TRIBE [JUDAH]
TO YOUR SON,
for the sake of David my servant
and for the sake of Jerusalem
that I have chosen.”

God was angry with Solomon
and God asked His prophet,
Ahijah the Shilonite,
אַחִיָּה הַשִּׁילֹנִי
to do a prophetic act to divide Israel.

to give ten tribes to Ephraim,
but God kept Juda
in the house of David.

1 Kings 11:30-32

30. Then Ahijah laid hold of the
new garment that was on him,
and TORE IT INTO TWELVE PIECES...

1 Kings 11:30-32

31. And he said to Jeroboam [Ephraim]

“Take for yourself TEN PIECES,
for thus says YHVH, the God of Israel,
‘Behold, I am about to tear the kingdom
from the hand of Solomon
and will give you TEN TRIBES...

1 Kings 11:30-32

32. BUT HE SHALL HAVE ONE TRIBE,
FOR THE SAKE OF MY SERVANT DAVID
and for the sake of Jerusalem,
the city that I have chosen
out of ALL THE TRIBES OF ISRAEL.

God took away from Solomon's son
ten tribes
and put them in the hand of Ephraim.
and the tribe of Benjamin
remained with Judah.

God kept Judah in the House of David,
in Israel!

But because of Solomon's sin
God afflicted the tribe of Judah.

David was of the tribe of Judah,
Solomon, David's son
was of the tribe of Judah,
so the whole tribe of Judah
had to pay of the sin of Solomon.

1 Kings 11:39
And I will afflict
the offspring of David
because of this
[Solomon's sin],
BUT NOT FOREVER.

You need to understand
because of Abraham
God chose Jacob.
Because of David
God chose the house of Judah.

And God told David
that his kingdom
will be established forever.

So because of David
God chose the tribe of Juda to lead.

And God send Jesus to the world
through the tribe of Judah.

But after the death
of king David and king Solomon,
the other 10 tribes rebelled against
the plan of God
they did not want to remain
under the tribe of Judah.

The Bible tells us
that Ephraim came against Judah
together with her enemy,
to try to take the place of Judah.

And because of it,
God scattered Ephraim,
the ten tribes of Israel
among the nations of the world.

and God also said
that Ephraim was no longer
counted as a nation.

Isaiah 7:5-8

5. Because Syria, WITH EPHRAIM
and the son of Remaliah,
has devised evil against you [Judah], saying...

Isaiah 7:5-8

6. “Let us go up AGAINST JUDAH and terrify it,
and let us CONQUER IT FOR OURSELVES,
and set up the son of Tabeel
as king in the midst of it,” ...

Isaiah 7:5-8

7. thus says the Lord YHVH:

“It shall not stand, and
IT SHALL NOT COME TO PASS...

Isaiah 7:5-8

8. ...And within sixty-five years
EPHRAIM WILL BE SHATTERED
FROM BEING A PEOPLE.

Here God says that
EPHRAIM WILL BE SHATTERED
FROM BEING A PEOPLE.

what does it mean?
could it be
that it means that for a time
Ephraim will loose his identity as Israel?

Then

Psalms 78:67-68

67. He [YHVH] rejected the tent of Joseph;

HE DID NOT CHOOSE

THE TRIBE OF EPHRAIM...

Psalms 78:67-68

68. BUT HE CHOSE THE TRIBE OF JUDAH,
Mount Zion, which he loves.

Ephraim rebelled against God's plan
and all the other nine tribes followed him

But the tribe of Benjamin
remain faithful to Judah.

Who was Ephraim?

Ephraim was one of the sons of Joseph
born to his Gentile wife,
a daughter of an Egyptian priest.

which make the two sons,
Ephraim and Menashe,
Gentiles.

Genesis 46:20

“And to Joseph in the land of Egypt
were born Manasseh and Ephraim,
whom Asenath, the daughter of Poti-Pherah
priest of On,
bore to him.”

But the Bible tells us
that Jacob has adopted them,
and gave them his name
and the name of Abraham and Isaac.

Genesis 48:16

“The Angel who has
redeemed me [Jacob] from all evil,
Bless the lads [Ephraim and Menashe];
Let MY NAME BE NAMED UPON THEM,
AND THE NAME OF MY FATHER'S ABRAHAM AND ISAAC;
And let them grow into a multitude in the
midst of the earth.”

Manasseh and Ephraim,
of a Gentile mother,
were adopted by Jacob-Israel.

Genesis 48:5:
And NOW YOUR TWO SONS,
who were born to you in the land
of Egypt before I came to you in Egypt,
ARE MINE;
Ephraim and Manasseh
SHALL BE MINE,
as Reuben and Simeon are.

Ephraim and Menashe received
from their grandfather Jacob
HIS NAME,
the name Israel,
which was given to him by God Himself,
and the name of Abraham and Isaac.

So these two, Ephraim and Menashe
became Israel,
otherwise they would not have been
entitled to the inheritance
God gave to Abraham Isaac and Jacob.

God made it all legal!

The Church;
some are the descendants
of the Israelites and of the apostles
that were scattered around the world
to preach the Gospel.

And some are
the one who were adopted in.

Ephesians 2:12-15

12. remember that you were
at that time separated from Christ,
alienated from the commonwealth of Israel
and strangers to
the covenants of promise, having no hope
and without God in the world...

Ephesians 2:12-15

13. But now in
Christ Jesus
you who once were far off
have been
brought near
by the blood of Christ...

Ephesians 2:12-15

14. For He himself is our peace,
who has MADE US BOTH ONE
and has broken down in His flesh
the dividing wall of hostility...

Ephesians 2:12-15

15. by abolishing the law of commandments
expressed in ordinances,
that he might create in Himself
ONE NEW MAN
in place of the two,
so making peace.

They all become legally Israel,
and together
they will receive the inheritance
of Abraham Isaac of Jacob.

And what is that inheritance
of Israel?

A covenant with God.

Eternity with God.

The Promised Land.

The New Jerusalem.

So the ten missing tribes of Israel
that are scattered around the world,
some of them are
of the offspring of Abraham...

And some of them
are of the offspring
of Ephraim and Menashe
which were adopted by
Jacob-Israel.

But all are legally
Israel

The Bible reveals
that this division
between the twelve Tribes of Israel,
between Judah and Ephraim
will not be forever.

and that Ephraim
will not be scattered forever.

God the Father sends the Messiah
from eternity to earth
to save us all...

But, for the sake of the gentiles,
for the sake of Ephraim,
God TEMPORARILY closed the eyes
of the Jews.

until the whole house of
Israel, Judah and Ephraim are united
as the One New Man.

However, all this time,
God has kept the Jews
under His protection
according to the covenant
that He made with Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob.

How can we accuse God
of being a covenant breaker?
God has said:

Jeremiah 33:23-26

23. The LORD gave another message
to Jeremiah. He said...

Jeremiah 33:23-26

24. “Have you noticed what people are saying?—
‘The LORD chose Judah and Israel
and then abandoned them!’
They are sneering and saying
that Israel is not worthy to be
counted as a nation....

Jeremiah 33:23-26

25. But this is what the LORD says:
I would no more reject my people
than I would change my laws
that govern night and day,
earth and sky...

Jeremiah 33:23-26

26. I will never abandon the descendants
of Jacob or David,
my servant,
or change the plan that David's descendants
will rule the descendants
of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob.
Instead, I will restore them to their land
and have mercy on them.”

Psalms 94:14:
For YHVH will NOT FORSAKE His people;
He will NOT
ABANDON His heritage;

Isaiah 45:17:
...Israel is saved by YHVH
with EVERLASTING SALVATION;
you shall not be put to shame
or confounded TO ALL ETERNITY.

God desires to be united
with His people,
God desires to unite His people,
God has a plan to restore
the Tabernacle of David.

to bring all the brothers,
all the twelve tribes,
together again as one people
under One King, the Messiah Yeshua.

And we see how God
sent His prophet Ezekiel
to perform the necessary prophetic act,
to reunite all the twelve tribes of Israel.

Ezekiel 37:15-23

15. ...The word of the LORD came to me:

16. “Son of man, take a stick and write on it,

‘For JUDAH, and the people of Israel
associated with him’;

then take another stick and write on it,

‘For Joseph (the stick of EPHRAIM)
and all the house of Israel
associated with him.’...

Ezekiel 37:15-23

17. AND JOIN THEM ONE TO ANOTHER
INTO ONE STICK,
THAT THEY MAY BECOME
ONE IN YOUR HAND...

Ezekiel 37:15-23

18. And when your people say to you,
Will you not tell us
what you mean
by these?...

Ezekiel 37:15-23

19. say to them, Thus says

YHVH GOD:

Behold, I am about to take the stick of
Joseph (that is in the hand of Ephraim)
and the tribes of Israel
associated with him.

And I will join with it the stick of Judah,
and MAKE THEM ONE STICK,
THAT THEY MAY BE ONE IN MY HAND...

Ezekiel 37:15-23

20. When the sticks on which you write
are in your hand before their eyes...

Ezekiel 37:15-23

21. then say to them,

Thus says YHVH GOD:

Behold, I will take the people of Israel
from the nations among
which they have gone,
and will gather them from all around,
and bring them to their own land...

Ezekiel 37:15-23

22. And I will make them
ONE NATION in the land,
on the mountains of Israel.

And ONE KING SHALL BE
KING OVER THEM ALL,

and they shall be no longer two nations,
and no longer divided into two kingdoms...

Ezekiel 37:15-23

23. They shall not defile
themselves anymore with their idols
and their detestable things,
or with any of their transgressions.

But I WILL SAVE THEM
from all the backslidings
in which they have sinned,
and WILL CLEANSE THEM;
and they shall be my people,
AND I WILL BE THEIR GOD.

The complete Israel is ;
Judah & Ephraim,
the Jews and the Christians
joined as one stick in God's Hand:
the One New Man.

Ephesians 2:14

For He [Yeshua] Himself is our peace,
WHO HAS MADE US BOTH ONE
and has broken down in His flesh
THE DIVIDING WALL OF HOSTILITY

John 17:22-23

22. The glory that You have given Me
I have given to them,
that they may be ONE
even as We are ONE...

John 17:22-23

23. I in them and You in Me,
that THEY MAY BECOME PERFECTLY ONE,
so that the world may know
that You sent me
and loved them even as You loved Me.

At the end,
they will all be one
as we see in the prophesy of Isaiah.

Isaiah 11:12-14

12. YHVH will raise a signal for the nations
and WILL ASSEMBLE
THE BANISHED OF ISRAEL,
and gather THE DISPERSED OF JUDAH
from the four corners
of the earth...

Isaiah 11:12-14

13. The jealousy of Ephraim shall depart,
and those who harass Judah
shall be cut off;
Ephraim shall not be jealous of Judah,
and Judah shall not harass Ephraim...

Isaiah 11:12-14

...and TOGETHER they shall plunder
the people of the east...

This scripture is a prophetic foretelling
of reconciliation and unity;

EPHRAIM-THE NATIONS, The Church,
will no longer envy JUDAH- THE JEWS,
and the Jews will no longer harass the nations.

The Messiah broke the wall of enmity
and created One out of the two!
The "One New Man",
Jew and Gentile.

Judah and the Church
as the “One New Man”,
they become one united Israel.

Just as in the wilderness
God ordained the tribe of Judah
to be the first to lead
all the tribes of Israel
into the Promised Land,

The scriptures tells us
that at the end
the ten tribes of Israel-Ephraim
will acknowledge God's plan
and again follow Judah
into the Promised Land.

Zechariah 8:23

Thus says the LORD of hosts:

In those days

ten men from the nations

of every tongue

shall take hold of the robe of a Jew,

saying, 'Let us go with you,

for we have heard that God is with you.'"

I believe
that this 10 man from the nations
refers to the 10 tribes of Israel-Ephraim.

And together,
united in the Messiah Yeshua,
we will inherit the Eternal City,
the New Jerusalem!

In the end,
just as
We need to realize that today's Israel,
Judah-the Jews,
they are still under YHVH,
under God the Father...

In the same way
the remaining tribes of Israel,
which were scattered
among the nations of the world,
are the Church
and they are under the Messiah Yeshua.

Then, the Father will unite them
all again as one.

That is the restoration of
the fallen Tabernacle of David.

This union will bring forth
the One New Man
which in turn
will bring the Messiah to earth.

At the end,
we will all become one people,
the twelve tribes of Israel,
under One King...

and each of us
will be mark on our foreheads
with the name of God
and the name of the city of God
Jerusalem.

which will enable us
to enter
the magnificent city
that God has prepared for us,
the New Jerusalem,
our inheritance.

Each will enter the city
through his own gate
into eternity...

God the Father has made
Yeshua THE DOOR
through which we are given the right
TO BECOME THE CHILDREN of
GOD THE FATHER.

a place where the streets
are made of gold
and a rushing living water
flows in the midst of the city,...

a place where there is no night, no death,
no tears or pain,
only the glorious presence of God.
Hallelujah.

But to hurry it up
Our Messiah Yeshua
needs the Jews to call upon Him:
Blessed is He who comes
in the name of the Lord!

God revealed to me
something so urgent
that the church must do
in order for all Israel be saved.

We know from the scriptures
that in order to receive salvation,
in order that all our sins be forgiven us.
we also must forgive
all those who sinned against us.

Just like the parable that Jesus tells us
of the unforgiving servant
in **Matthew 18:23:**

Jesus tells of a man
that owed his king 10,000 talents.
and how the king forgives the slave's debt,
but then this same man
finds a man who owes him 100 talents
and he does not forgive him his debt...

And when the king finds out
that his servant did not forgive that other man,
the king reinstates the debt
and requires a full payment
back from the servant.

Then Jesus says

Matthew 18:35

So also my heavenly Father will do
to every one of you,
if you do not forgive your brother
from your heart.”

who as consequence killed 6 million Jews.

Then were the crusaders
that aimed to entirely eliminate

either by converting them to Christianity,
or, if they refused, by killing them.

These brutal attacks on the Jews
are just few example of many
of the antisemitism which was widespread
throughout Christianity.

But in order to receive salvation
the Jews must forgive the Christians,

Christians-the church
must ask the Jews for forgiveness.

Zechariah 12:7
