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

Understanding Bible Prophecy – Typological

- Double Fulfilment- literal fulfilment at one time in history, then fulfilled again some time in the future
- Examples:
 1. Daniel 11 – Antiochus Epiphanes placed abomination in the Temple
 2. Matthew 24 – Yeshua mentioned Daniel’s prophecy refers to the future Antichrist placing the abomination into the Temple
 3. Bible said John the Baptist came in the spirit of Elijah and another Elijah will come before the Day of the Lord



Understanding Bible Prophecy – Dual Purpose

- Dual purpose – it differs from the earlier type in that the future prophecy is not the EXACT copy of the first
- Examples:
 1. Jeremiah 23 predicts the Israelites will spend 70 years in Babylonian captivity. In Daniel 9, the angel Gabriel uses the 7-year captivity prophecy to reveal the 70 weeks of years prophecy
 2. Revelation 17 explains the seven heads of the beast to represent the seven hills on which the woman (city of Rome) sits and also represents the seven empires

1. Scriptural Basis

- **Yeshua** appeared to Daniel with a message on the *24th Day of Nisan*
- ⁴ Now on the twenty-fourth day of the first month, as I was by the side of the great river, that *is*, the Tigris, ⁵ I lifted my eyes and looked, and behold, a certain man clothed in linen, *whose waist was girded with gold of Uphaz!* ⁶ ***His body was like beryl***, his face like the ***appearance of lightning***, his ***eyes like torches of fire***, his arms and feet like burnished ***bronze in color***, and the *sound of his words like the voice of a multitude.*” – Daniel 10:4-6
- *Compare this description of Yeshua in Revelation 1:12-15*

Revelation 1:12-15

¹² I turned around to see the voice that was speaking to me. And when I turned I saw seven golden lampstands, ¹³ and among the lampstands was someone ***like a son of man***, dressed in a robe reaching down to his feet and with a golden sash around his chest. ¹⁴ The ***hair on his head was white like wool***, as white as snow, and ***his eyes were like blazing fire***. ¹⁵ His ***feet were like bronze*** glowing in a furnace, and ***his voice was like the sound of rushing waters***.

Prophecies Concerning Persia and Greece

These prophecies about Persia and Greece have come to pass

Notice that Biblical prophecies have multiple layers and re-occur also at different times

This gives the background that future events will also be like what happened in the past

Who Is the Prince of Persia?

¹² Then He said to me, “Do not fear, Daniel, for from the first day that you set your heart to understand, and (1) *to humble yourself* before your God, your words were heard; and (2) *I have come because of your words*. ¹³ But the (3) ***prince of the kingdom of Persia*** withstood me twenty-one days; and behold, ***Michael***, one of the chief princes, came to help me, for I had been left alone there with the kings of Persia. ¹⁴ Now I have come to ***make you understand*** what will happen to (4) ***your people*** in the (5) ***latter days***, for the vision (6) ***refers to many days yet to come.***” – Daniel 10:12-14

Princes of Satan and World Kingdoms

- The Prince (Satan) of the Kingdom of Persia (Daniel 10:13)
 - Opposing King Cyrus to let God's People return to rebuild the Temple
- Three Kings (Princes of Satan) yet to stand in Persian (Daniel 11:2; 10:21)
- The Prince (latter) to come - Daniel 8:25
- The Prince who is to come, Titus – Daniel 9:26


Prince of God's heavenly Kingdom

- God's angels sent to those who are heirs of God's salvation (Hebrews 1:14; Psalm 8:4-5)



¹⁵ While I, Daniel, was watching the vision and trying to understand it, there before me stood ***one who looked like a man***. ¹⁶ And I heard a man's voice from the Ulai calling, "Gabriel, tell this man the meaning of the vision."

Daniel 11:2

- ² And now I will tell you the truth: Behold, ***three more kings*** will arise in Persia, and the ***fourth shall be far richer*** than *them* all; by his strength, through his riches, he shall stir up all against the realm of Greece.
- Who are these four kings?



Daniel 11:2

Four kings are:-

1. Cyrus
2. Cambyses, son of Cyrus
3. Darius I Hystaspes – Darius the Great
4. ***Xerxes (the Ahasuerus of Esther)*** who was fabulously rich and has an army of one million men

Alexander The Great – Scripture Fulfilled

- ³ Then a ***mighty king*** shall arise, who shall rule with great dominion, and do according to his will. ⁴ And when he has arisen, ***his kingdom shall be broken up and divided toward the four winds of heaven***, but ***not among his posterity*** nor according to ***his dominion*** with which he ruled; for ***his kingdom shall be uprooted***, even for others besides these.” – Daniel 11:3-4
- He died at the age of 33, at the height of his power in Babylon
- After Alexander the Great, his kingdom divided into ***four regions***, each ruled by his four generals
- Two kings became dominant, king of the North & king of the South

Who are the Kings of the North of the South?

- King of the North – Syria
- King of the South - Egypt
- This a title representing king to king, over the successive years, example
 - Presidents of country
 - Prime ministers of country
- ***Palestine*, today's Israel** is the dividing land where wars were fought between these two kings (then and now as world powers)
- Particularly in a small place - Jerusalem
 - Only place where God's glory was manifest
 - Sacrifices acceptable to God was offered
 - Only place where God's name was recorded
 - The place where Yeshua ministered much

Vs.5	King of the South becomes strong, as well as one of his princes. He gains power over him. His dominion shall be a great dominion	Ptolemy was the first one of Alexander's generals to gain control of this portion of the Empire. First 'King of the South' – Egypt. Seleucus Nicator, 'one of his princes', over Babylonia. Then westward, founded the great Kingdom of Syria, taking territories of Cassander and Lysimachus. The stronger.
Vs.6	At the end of some years, they join forces. Daughter of King of the South goes to King of North and makes an agreement. She shall not retain power of her authority, neither shall his authority stand. She shall be given up with those who brought her, and with him who begot her, and with him who strengthened her in those times	After years of war, the two kingdoms sought to make peace by means of marriage with Berenice, daughter of Ptolemy II who was married to Antiochus II Theos, King of Syria, who put away his wife for this purpose. Berenice's brother, Ptolemy III, who had become King of Egypt, invades the north to avenge his sister's death. His army ravaged the area
Vs.8	He shall also carry their gods captive to Egypt with their princes, and their precious articles of silver, gold. He shall continue more years than the King of the North	Ptolemy carried off much plunder and many slaves, as well as the gods of Syria. He took much silver and gold and idols and vessels. Ptolemy lived about 5 years after the death of Seleucus II of Syria. He had to return home to Egypt because of a palace plot against him. Conflict ceased for some years
Vs.9	Also the King of the North shall come to the Kingdom of the King of the South, but shall return to his own land	Egypt was invaded by Seleucus II (BC.242) but little came of it and Seleucus returned home with nothing to show for the raid
Vs.10	However, his sons shall stir up strife and assemble a great	This occurred when the two sons of Seleucus II assemble a great army to move south.

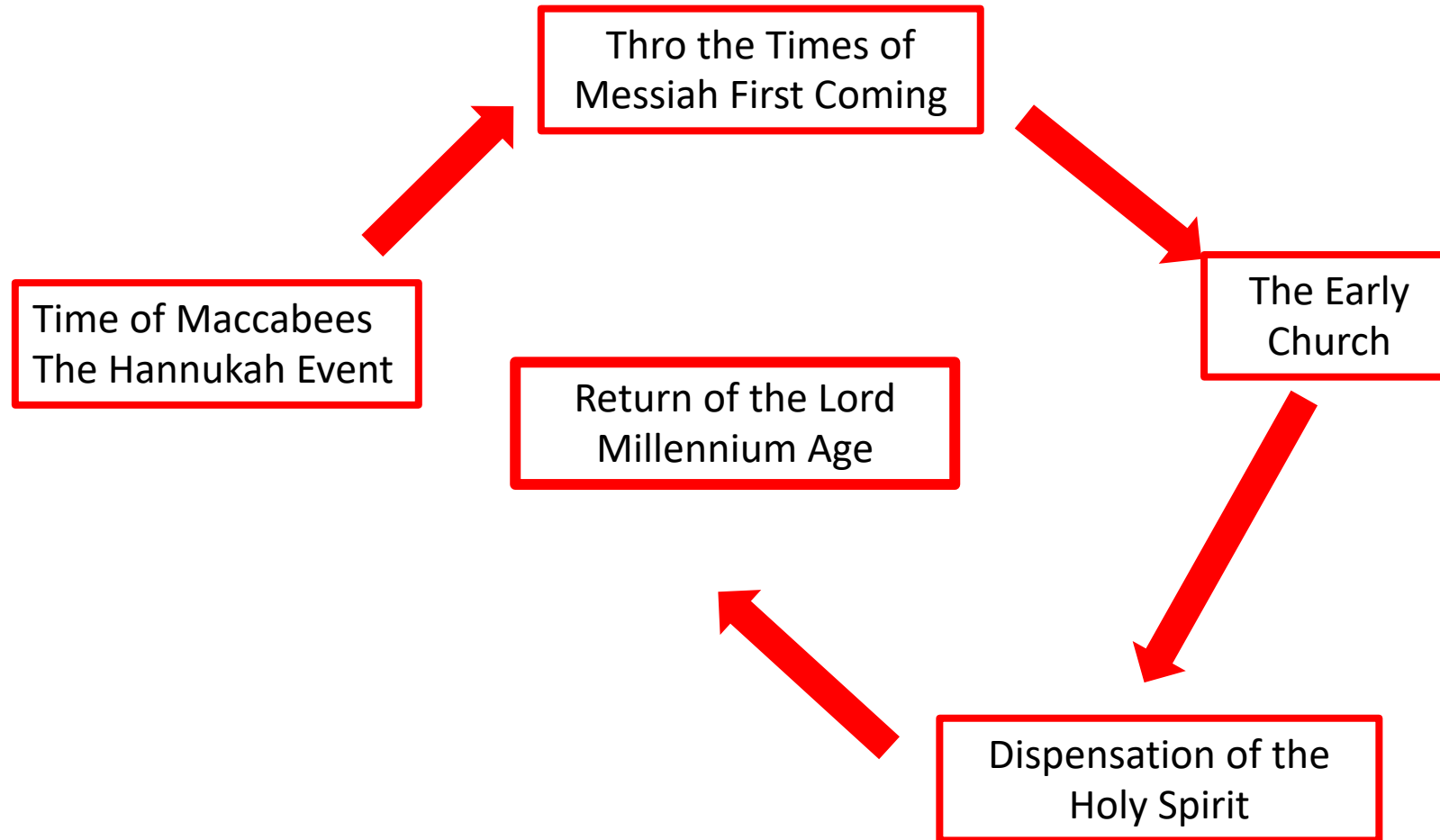
Just to show a glimpse from the Book of Daniel written by Dr. Kevin J. Conner to illustrate Daniel prophecies have been fulfilled in the PAST and we could use this to map out what is to come.

Verse	The Prophecy	Historical Outworking
Vs.21	In his place shall arise a vile person to whom they will not give the honour of royalty, but he shall come in peaceably and seize the Kingdom by intrigue	Antiochus (Epiphanes, the Illustrious) was not the true heir. Demetrius was. With the help of supporters, Antiochus overthrew opposition and seized the throne
Vs.22	With the force of a flood they shall be swept away from before him and be broken, and also the Prince of the Covenant	So Antiochus overthrew those who resisted him, including the High Priest, Onias, who was the Prince of God's Covenant. He put Jason in as High Priest (2Macc.4:4-10) who
Vs.23	And after the league made with him, he shall act deceitfully, for he shall come up and become strong with a small number of people	History records that the agreement between this pagan King Antiochus and the High Priest Jason was broken, and so the King put in a wicked High Priest named Menelaus

Who is the King of the South?

- Ptolemy – King of the South
- Egypt is featured in the Bible
- Joseph and Mary took baby Yeshua to Egypt to escape from King Herod – Matthew 2:13-15



Who Took the Gospel to Egypt

- According to traditions, St Mark brought the Gospel to Egypt
- More substantial recorded sources came in second century
 - Bishop Demetrius (AD 189-221)
 - Coptic Christians
- Alexandria located in Egypt on the Southern coast of the Mediterranean became a great Christian centre



Coptic Faith vs Roman Catholic Faith

- Unlike Roman Catholics, they do not believe
 - In papal infallibility or purgatory
- They believe in the virgin birth of Yeshua
- Their priests can marry
- King Henry VIII broke away from the Roman Catholic Church to form the Church of England (Anglican church) because the Pope refused for him to divorce Queen Catherine, his influential wife, the aunty of the Emperor of Rome

Christopher Columbus – Discover of New World?



- He did not really “discover” the so-called New World—millions of people already lived there
 - his journeys marked the beginning of centuries of exploration
 - His initial dream was to find a sea-route to the Far East
- Born in Genoa, Italy in 1451
- Studied mathematics, astronomy, cartography and navigation

Who Discovered America for England?

- In 1497 John Cabot commissioned by England King Henry VII landed in America
- In 1620, the Pilgrims were separatists who first settled in Plymouth, Mass.,
- In 1630, the Puritans came to continue practice their faith in New America
- The Puritans believed in education and founded Harvard in 1636. ...
- Women played an important role in Puritan life.

Constantine – Roman Emperor

- Constantine completely altered the relationship between the church and the imperial government, merging Religion and Government
- Made Christianity the official religion of the empire.
- Many new converts were won, including those who converted only with the hope of advancing their careers.
- Poisoned the Christian Faith by introducing Pagan worship



King of the North

- CONSTANTINOPLE, THE NEW ROME
- Darius I of Persia, the Delian League, the Spartans, and Alexander the Great all had ruled the area of the city of Constantinople.
- Roman emperor Septimius Severus destroyed the city in A.D. 196 and rebuilt a grander version
- Constantine established his new capital in A.D. 330 give the City his name – Constantinople
- Constantine expanded his New Rome. The city became a prosperous and important centre of faith, power, trade, and architecture. The landmark Hagia Sophia was built by Emperor Justinian during the sixth century, the peak of Constantinople's glory.

Church – Mosque

Originally built as a Christian Orthodox church and serving that purpose for centuries, Hagia Sophia was transformed into a mosque by the Ottomans upon their conquest of Constantinople in 1453.





Hagia Sophia has been converted back into a mosque, but the veiling of its figural icons is not a Muslim tradition

The King of the North

- Constantinople is generally considered to be the center and the "**cradle of Orthodox** Christian civilization". From the mid-5th century to the early 13th century, Constantinople was the largest and wealthiest city in Europe
- Currently, Orthodox majority countries are Armenia, Bulgaria, Georgia, Greece, Romania, **Russia**, Serbia and Ukraine

Who is the Anti-Christ

- He will appear at the middle of the last seven years
- ²⁷ He will ***confirm a covenant with many*** for one 'seven.' In the middle of the 'seven' he will put an end to sacrifice and offering. And at the temple he will set up an abomination that ***causes desolation***, until the end that is decreed is poured out on him."- Daniel 9:27
- Third Temple will be built
- Priesthood & Temple need to be purified
- Covenant with death – Isaiah 28:15
- Timing WHEN ALL THESE EVENTS UNFOLD
