

The Seven Spirits of God

"John, to the seven churches which are in Asia: Grace to you and peace from Him who is and who was and who is to come, and from the **seven spirits** who are before His throne," - Revelation 1:4

"And to the angel of the church in Sardis write, 'These things says He who **has** the **seven Spirits of God** and the seven stars: "I know your works, that you have a name that you are alive, but you are dead." – Revelation 3:1

"And from the throne proceeded lightnings, thunderings, and voices. Seven lamps of fire *were* burning before the throne, which are the **seven Spirits of God**." – Revelation 4:5

"And I looked, and behold, in the midst of the throne and of the four living creatures, and in the midst of the elders, stood a Lamb as though it had been slain, **having seven horns and seven eyes**, which are the **seven Spirits of God** sent out into all the earth." – Revelation 5:6

The Role of these Seven Spirits of God

- Holy Spirit is GOD
- The Seven Spirits of God is not the Holy Spirit
- They are the seven lamps of God Revelation 4:5
- They are also the seven eyes of Yeshua Revelation 5:6
- The seven spirits are sentient beings (someone who can perceive how others are feeling)
- Their role is to equip, train, mandate us to become sons of God

Sons and Heirs Through Christ **4** Now I say *that* the heir, as long as he is a child, does not differ at all from a slave, though he is master of all, ² but is under guardians and stewards until the time appointed by the father." – Galatians 4:1-2

The seven spirits are tutors and governors

A tutor is someone who trains you in wisdom, understanding, counsel, might, knowledge and the reverential fear of God

A governor is someone who teaches you how to rule , or rules over you until you mature and able to assume rulership

Heir According to the Promise

- ²⁹ And if you *are* Christ's, then you are Abraham's seed, and heirs according to the promise." – Galatians 3:29
- Heir to the Promise
- What is the Promise?
 - "that the Gentiles should be fellow heirs, of the same body, and partakers of His promise in Christ through the gospel," – Ephesians 3:6
 - Co-heir with Yeshua sons of God
- To inherit the Promise of Joint-heir with Christ
 - Needs to be tutor, trained to rule

Compare these Two Verses

- ¹⁶ When He had been baptized, Jesus came up immediately from the water; and behold, the heavens were opened to Him, and He saw the *Spirit of God* descending like a dove and alighting upon Him. And suddenly a voice *came* from heaven, saying, *"This is My beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased." –* Matthew 3:17
- ⁵ While he was still speaking, behold, a bright cloud overshadowed them; and suddenly a voice came out of the cloud, saying, "This is My beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased. Hear Him!" Matthew 17:5


Isaiah 11:1-4

• There shall come forth a Rod from the stem of Jesse,

And a Branch shall grow out of his roots. ² The Spirit of the LORD shall rest upon Him, The Spirit of wisdom and understanding, The Spirit of counsel and might, The Spirit of knowledge and of the fear of the LORD.

³ His delight *is* in the fear of the LORD, And He shall not judge by the sight of His eyes, Nor decide by the hearing of His ears;
⁴ But with righteousness He shall judge the poor, And decide with equity for the meek of the earth; He shall strike the earth with the rod of His mouth, And with the breath of His lips He shall slay the wicked.

Who is the Holy Spirit?

- HE is GOD
- The Triune GOD God the Father, God the Son, and God the Holy Spirit
- God sits on the Throne
 - "And from the throne proceeded lightnings, thunderings, and voices. Seven lamps of fire were burning before the throne, which are the seven Spirits of God." – Revelation 4:5

Who are the Seven Spirits of God?

- The seven spirits of God burns before the throne
- These are seven individual (sentient) beings
 - Tutors and governor to prepare us for sonship
- If the Spirit of the Lord is the Holy Spirit
 - then there remain only six spirits of God
 - Six is not the number associated with God, is always SEVEN
- The Spirit of the Lord plays the "Governor role"
 - Teaches us to govern in righteousness and justice
- The seven spirits are sent out to see who is ready to be trained as a son
 - There are the eyes of the Lamb of God



The Role of the Seven Spirits of God

- These are tutors and governors to empower the sons of God to establish God's Kingdom on earth
- They prepare us to be sons of God because of the Covenant of Adoption

The Seven Spirit of God is Not GOD

- Not omnipresent BUT
- The classrooms are omnipresent meaning there can be everywhere where needed
- They are powerful beings, training us to be like them
- Training us to take our place, sitting on the throne reserved for us

Role of Each Spirit of God

- The Spirit of the Lord: Mandates us for Position
 - This is position in the center
 - It holds the whole seven spirits together
 - It prepares us to know the dimensions of the Kingdom
 - About the Throne room
 - Power and authority
 - Dominion,
 - Sonship & Rulership
 - It teaches us how to bring characteristics of Heaven to earth
 - It teaches the glory and realm of God
 - How to exercise dominion on earth

The Spirit of Wisdom: Equips us for Position

- Solomon is a prime example of the Spirit of Wisdom fully manifested on the face of the earth
- Equips us to prosper and delight in God
- Teaches us to judge and to bring justice
- Teaches us to rule with righteousness
- Teaches us the realm of rulership as a son
- Releases contentment and joy not only for you but also for all those that are around you

The Spirit of Understanding: Authorizes us for Position

- Teaches us where and how to access the realm of God
- Teaches us how to use what we have at the right time
- Helps us to understand revelation and visions
- Teaches us how to perceive and how to teach and inform others about the realm of the Kingdom
- Teaches us how to rule in the realm of God as a son

The Spirit of Counsel: Prepares us for Position

- Teaches us ways to rule as son
- Teaches us how to access the counsels of God
- Teaches us how to consult with the counsels of God
- Teaches us how to resolve issues and advise those around us
- Teaches us how to commune with God and gain His advice
- Teaches us the role of the Holy Spirit and about the Son
- Teaches us about the triune God and their role in our lives today

The Spirit of Might: **Reveals** us for Position

- Teaches us how to access the supernatural realm of God to reveal the power of God
- Teaches us the dominion of God and how to exercise it in the world, earth and the spirit realm around us
- Teaches us the Council Chamber of War
- Teaches us how to war in the spirit realm in the heavenlies
- Teaches us about the heavenly places of God
- Teaches us the seats of rulership and the governmental arenas that we operate in as a king

The Spirit of Knowledge: **Empowers** us for Position

- Teaches us how to access the knowledge of God
- Teaches us how to apply that knowledge to the world
- Teaches us to gain access to knowledge about the supernatural realms of God
- Teaches us how to operate and function in this realm
- Teaches us how to retain, process and store information until it becomes permanent in us
- Teaches us how to meditate and receive divine insight and revelation into circumstances through visions, visitations and dreams

The Spirit of the Fear of God: Brings us into Accountability for Position

- This fear is not being afraid but rather an understanding of the awe, wonder, majesty, might and dominion of the person of God
- Teaches us about the realm of holiness, intimacy, worship, reverence and righteousness
- Teaches us to access and bring divine order and its application to the world around us

The Seven Colours of the Spirit of God

- 1. The Spirit of the Lord Red and mandates us for position
- 2. The Spirit of Wisdom Orange and equips us for position
- 3. The Spirit of Understanding Yellow and authorizes us for position
- 4. The Spirit of Counsel Green and prepares us for position
- 5. The Spirit of Might Blue and reveals us for position
- 6. The Spirit of Knowledge Indigo and empowers us for position
- 7. The Spirit of the Fear of the God Violet (Purple) and brings accountability for position

A Warning

- Do not do spiritual warfare without been trained to do the works of God by the Seven Spirits of God
- You cannot do so by your own human strength and knowledge of man and not the wisdom of God
- Do not focus on the demonic realm BUT into the realms of angels and the Power of God
- We need to activate the angels to do their work

The Effects of the Seven Spirits of God

- Seal us for our Position as the manifested sons of God
- Yeshua learned how to operate in, function in, and reveal the characteristic traits and nature of all these Seven Spirit of God
- He was a mature Son
- That is why Yeshua transfigured into pure light before His death to demonstrate to His disciples what they could become

How to Access the Seven Spirits of God?

- Start from inside our spirit man. Willing to be tutored by the seven spirits of God
 - "Father, by faith I submit myself to (the Spirit of Knowledge), to be trained by him, to be tutored by him, to be instructed by him. I give myself, my life, and my spirit man to be tutored by the (Spirit of Knowledge) in the name of Yeshua, that out of that (knowledge), would come the (knowledge) of God upon my life."
- Be consistent in your prayers in asking and each time giving thanks ...
 - Thank Him in the morning when you wake up. "Father, I thank you that I am under the tutorship of the (Spirit of Knowledge). Father, I thank you that the (Spirit of Knowledge) walks with me. Father, wherever I go he goes, and wherever he goes, I can go! He shows to me the things out of the Kingdom and reveals to me things that come out of the realm of Heaven. He enables me – giving me knowledge."
