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

The Seven Feasts of the LORD

- Let us revisit the first Four Fulfilled Feast of the LORD
- 23 And the LORD spoke to Moses, saying, ² "Speak to the children of Israel, and say to them: 'The *feasts of the LORD*, which you shall proclaim *to be holy convocations*, these *are My feasts*. Lev 23:1-2
- These are the feasts of the LORD The First Feast is the Lord's Passover
 - ⁴ 'These *are* the feasts of the LORD, holy convocations which you shall proclaim at their appointed times. ⁵ On the fourteenth *day* of the first month *at twilight is* the *LORD's Passover*.
 - LORD's Passover
 - ⁶ And on the fifteenth day of the same month *is* the Feast of Unleavened Bread to the LORD; seven days you must eat unleavened bread.
 - Feast of Unleavened Bread



Feast of Unleavened Bread - Seven Days Celebration

- On the first day you shall have a holy convocation (dress rehearsal; you shall do no customary work (Sabbath rest) on it. ⁸ But you shall offer an offering made by fire to the LORD for seven days. The seventh day shall be a holy convocation); you shall do no customary work on it.' "
- First Day of the Feasts of Unleavened Bread Sabbath Rest
- Seven days celebration with Burnt offering each day
- Seventh Day of the Feast of Unleavened Bread Sabbath rest

Feast of Firstfruits

⁹ And the LORD spoke to Moses, saying, ¹⁰ "Speak to the children of Israel, and say to them: 'When *you come into the land* which I give to you, and reap its harvest, then you shall bring a sheaf of the firstfruits of your harvest to the priest. ¹¹ He shall wave the sheaf before the LORD, to be accepted on your behalf; on the day after the Sabbath the priest shall wave it. - Leviticus 23:9-11



Feast of Firstfruits

- 12 And you shall offer on that day, when you wave the sheaf, a male lamb of the first year, without blemish, as a burnt offering to the LORD. 13 Its grain offering shall be two-tenths of an ephah of fine flour mixed with oil, an offering made by fire to the LORD, for a sweet aroma; and its drink offering shall be of wine, one-fourth of a hin. 14 You shall eat neither bread nor parched grain nor fresh grain until the same day that you have brought an offering to your God; it shall be a statute forever throughout your generations in all your dwellings.-Leviticus 23:12-14
- First Fruits is a biblical festival celebrating the first harvest of crops

Deuteronomy 26:1-11

- 26 "And it shall be, when you come into the land which the LORD your God is giving you as an inheritance, and you possess it and dwell in it, that you shall take some of the first of all the produce of the ground, which you shall bring from your land that the LORD your God is giving you, and put it in a basket and go to the place where the LORD your God chooses to make His name abide. And you shall go to the one who is priest in those days, and say to him, I declare today to the LORD your God that I have come to the country which the LORD swore to our fathers to give us."
- 4 "Then the priest shall take the basket out of your hand and set it down before the altar of the LORD your God. ⁵ And you shall answer and say before the LORD your God: 'My father was a Syrian, about to perish, and he went down to Egypt and dwelt there, few in number; and there he became a nation, great, mighty, and populous. ⁶ But the Egyptians mistreated us, afflicted us, and laid hard bondage on us. ⁷ Then we cried out to the LORD God of our fathers, and the LORD heard our voice and looked on our affliction and our labor and our oppression. ⁸ So the LORD brought us out of Egypt with a mighty hand and with an outstretched arm, with great terror and with signs and wonders. ⁹ He has brought us to this place and has given us this land, "a land flowing with milk and honey"; ¹⁰ and now, behold, *I have brought the firstfruits of the land* which you, O LORD, have given me.'
- "Then you shall set it before the LORD your God, and worship before the LORD your God. ¹¹ So you shall rejoice in every good *thing* which the LORD your God has given to you and your house, you and the Levite and the stranger who *is* among you. Deuteronomy 26:1-11

Three Main Feast of the LORD

• 14 "Three times you shall keep a feast to Me in the year: 15 You shall keep the (1) Feast of Unleavened Bread (you shall eat unleavened bread seven days, as I commanded you, at the time appointed in the month of Abib, for in it you came out of Egypt; none shall appear before Me empty); 16 and (2) the Feast of Harvest, the firstfruits of your labors (Pentecost) which you have sown in the field; and the (3) Feast of Ingathering (Tabernacles) at the end of the year, when you have gathered in the fruit of your labors from the field. 17 "Three times in the year all your males shall appear before the Lord God. – Exodus 23:14-17



First Fruits Offerings

- Unleavened Bread (During Passover)

 First fruits of Barley
 - First of the First fruits
 - Christ being our First fruits of those who have fallen asleep
- Pentecost (Shavuot) First fruits of Wheat
- Tabernacles (Sukkot) First fruits of Olive and Grapes (oil and the wine)

Opening of the Third Seal in Revelation 6

- 5 When He opened the third seal, I heard the third living creature say, "Come and see." So I looked, and behold, a black horse, and he who sat on it had a pair of scales in his hand. 6 And I heard a voice in the midst of the four living creatures saying, "A quart of wheat for a denarius, and three quarts of barley for a denarius; and do not harm the oil and the wine."
- Scale represents Judgment
- First fruits of Wheat take place in Shavuot (Pentecost)
 One quart
- First fruits of Barley take place in Passover Unleavened Bread – Three quart
- First fruits of Olive (oil) & Grapes (wine) (Tabernacles)
 - Command not to harm the oil and the wine
 - Revelation 6:6



Shavuot - Pentecost

- Feast of Weeks
- Marks the conclusion of the counting of the Omer
- On Passover freed from slavery in Egypt
- On Shavuot Torah was given, and Israelites became a nation committed to serving God
 - Israel became wife of God
- In New Testament the Holy Spirit came Acts 2
 - The Holy Spirit guide us to holiness Titus 3:5
 - The Church is the Bride of Yeshua Ephesians 5:22-27
 - The Body and Christ Ephesians 5:28-29
 - It seems the Church and the Body are two and not the same Ephesians 5:30-32
 - "This is a great mystery, but I speak concerning Christ and the church" Ephesians 5:32



- All these Four Feasts fulfilled
 - Passover Yeshua came as the Passover Lamb
 - Unleavened Bread Yeshua has no sin and die for all of us
 - Firstfruits Yeshua was the firstfruit
 Offering unto Abba Father
 - Pentecost The Holy Spirit came and gives us Power to live a victorious life – Holy life

The Half an Hour silence


When He opened the *seventh seal*, there was silence in heaven for about *half an hour*.

And I saw the seven angels who stand before God, and to them were given seven trumpets. – Revelation 8:1-2



Historical perspective - Half an hour

- The 30 minutes of silent prayers that always accompanied a major event in the ancient temple practice
 - refer to page 108 of my Book "Unpacking the Book of Revelation from the Hebraic Mindset by Jehu Chan"
- This event could be when the High Priest enters the Holy of Holies, on Yom Kippur
 - The twelve tribes will wait outside their tents in solemn silence while their sins are atoned by the High Priest
- And also Yeshua, our High Priest enters the Temple
- Half an hour in God's time is much longer in earth time
- Could this be 42 months or Three and-half years of 1260 days?




The Seven Seals Ketubah – A digression

- The Seven seals Ketubah (Marriage Covenant)
 - And I saw in the right hand of Him who sat on the throne a scroll written inside and on the back, sealed with seven seals. ² Then I saw a strong angel proclaiming with a loud voice, "Who is worthy to open the scroll and to loose its seals?" ³ And no one in heaven or on the earth or under the earth was able to open the scroll, or to look at it. Revelation 5:1-3
- This scroll is the Marriage covenant or the *Ketubah in Hebrew*
 - Sealed with 7 seals
 - Only Yeshua as the Bridegroom has the right to open the 7 seals Revelation 5:4-7
- After the seven seals are opened, the Ketubah is opened...
 - the Marriage is consummated follow by the Marriage Supper of the Lamb
 - Revelation 19:9

When the Seven Seal is opened?

- The Bride with Yeshua in heaven
- Half an hour silence -Yeshua, our High Priest atones for our sins – Final Salvation is fulfilled
- The fulfilment of the Feast of Atonement
- Between Rev 8 verse 1 & 2 is an example of the story telling pattern peculiar to the Jewish people



The Half an Hour silence

When He opened the seventh seal, there was silence in heaven for about *half an hour*.

Half an hour in heaven could be 42 months (Three-an-half years) for the Wrath of the Dragon (Great Tribulation) and the sounding of the seven trumpets and the rapture of the Bride and Saints

- ² And I saw the seven angels who stand before God, and to them were given seven trumpets.
- Revelation 8:1-2





Beginning of the Sounding of the Trumpets

² And I saw the seven angels who stand before God, and to them were *given seven trumpets*. ³ Then *another angel*, having a golden censer, came and stood at the altar. He was given much incense, that he should *offer it with the prayers of all the saints* upon the golden altar which was before the throne. ⁴ And the smoke of the incense, with the *prayers of the saints*, ascended before God from the angel's hand. ⁵ Then the angel took the censer, filled it with fire from the altar, and threw *it* to the earth. And there were *noises*, *thunderings*, *lightnings*, *and an earthquake*. – Revelation 8:2-5

The Cry of the Martyrs — Fifth Seal

⁹ When He opened *the fifth seal*, I saw under the *altar the souls* of those who had been slain for the word of God and for the testimony which they held. ¹⁰ And they cried with a loud voice, saying, "How long, O Lord, holy and true, until You judge and avenge our blood on those who dwell on the earth?" ¹¹ Then a white robe was given to each of them; and it was said to them that they should rest a little while longer, *until both the number of their fellow servants and their brethren, who would be killed as they were, was completed.* – Revelation 6:9-11

- In the earlier slide, at Rev 8:2-5 at the opening of the Seventh Seal,
 - Seven angels were given seven trumpets
 - Another angel was given a golden censer full of the prayers of the martyred saints
 - There were noises, thunderings, lightnings and an earthquake signifying judgment on earth
 - This is God answering the martyrs and when the number of martyrs is completed, judgment would come

Back to Ancient Temple worship

- The pattern of Ancient Temple worship
 - First (First Trumpet) sounding of the shofar to declare the Temple door is opened
 - The Morning Service two blasts of shofar (Second and Third Trumpets)
 - The Morning Service ends with the fourth blast of the shofar (the Fourth Trumpet)
 - The Evening service begins and ends with the sounding of the fifth and sixth shofar blasts (Fifth and Sixth Trumpets)
 - The Last blast (Seventh Trumpet) the Temple door closes
- No one is allowed to end the Temple until the next morning
 - ⁴I must work the works of Him who sent Me while it is day; *the* night is coming when *no one can work.* John 9:4
- After the Seventh Trumpet the Rapture takes place
 - Deep Darkness comes to earth. The Holy Spirit has returned to heaven with the Bride entourage
- The Wrath of God the Seven Bowls is poured out
 - 8 The temple was filled with smoke from the glory of God and from His power, and no one was able to enter the temple till the seven plagues of the seven angels were completed. Revelation 15:8

The Seven Trumpet is sounded

- Rev 11:15 RAPTURE TAKEN PLACE

- ¹⁹ Then the temple of God was opened in heaven, and the ark of His covenant was seen in His temple. And there were lightnings, noises, thunderings, an earthquake, and great hail. Revelation 11:19
 - This is a scene on earth as the wrath of God is poured out as evidenced by the lightnings, noises etc...
 - The Temple of God is in first heaven (the skies, atmosphere) and not the third heaven
- The same word is used for verse 1 (same Chapter) "temple of God"
- Could this be the same temple?

Last Trumpet

- ⁵¹ Behold, I tell you a mystery: We shall not all sleep, but we shall all be changed— ⁵² in a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the *last trumpet*. For the trumpet will sound, and the dead will be raised incorruptible, and we shall be changed. ⁵³ For this corruptible must put on incorruption, and this mortal *must* put on immortality. 1 Corinthians 15:51-53
- ¹⁶ For the Lord Himself will descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of an archangel, and with the trumpet of God. And the dead in Christ will rise first. ¹⁷ Then we who are alive and remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air. And thus we shall always be with the Lord. 1 Thessalonians 4:16-17

Yeshua with His Bride

- At the "Last trumpet" the Bride is "caught up" in the skies – 1 Thessalonians 4:15-17
- Yeshua returns to earth for judgment – Revelation 19:11-21
- Yeshua enters the Temple and presents His blood to atone for our sins – Hebrews 9:11-13
- At the opening of the Seventh Seal, Yeshua returns to heaven and pronounce His Bride pure – Revelation 8:1

The Sequence of Events

- The sounding of the Seven Trumpets is during the $3^{1/2}$ year Great tribulation also known as the wrath of the Dragon
- The Seventh trumpet is the fulfilment of the Feast of Trumpets
 - Yeshua meets the dead in Christ and those who are alive in the air -1
 Thessalonians 4:16-17
 - Is also the Last trumpet 1 Corinthians 15:51-55
- The Opening of the Seventh Seal Rev 8:1
 - The Bride is in heaven
 - Yeshua atones for the sins of the raptured saints and His Bride
 - The fulfilment of the Feast of Atonement

The Feast of Atonement

- ¹¹ But Christ came *as* High Priest of the good things to come, with the greater and more perfect tabernacle not made with hands, *that is, not of this creation*. ¹² Not with the blood of goats and calves, but with His own blood *He entered the Most Holy Place once for all*, having *obtained eternal redemption*. ¹³ For if the blood of bulls and goats and the ashes of a heifer, sprinkling the unclean, sanctifies for the purifying of the flesh, Hebrew 9:11-13
- so Christ was offered once to bear the sins of many. To those who eagerly wait for Him He will appear a second time, apart from sin, for **salvation**. Hebrew 9:28




Is this is a replica of the original Menorah?


Clue to Yeshua's Burial Place

- ¹⁷ And He, bearing His cross, went out to a place called *the Place* of a Skull, which is called in Hebrew, Golgotha, ¹⁸ where they crucified Him, and two others with Him, one on either side, and Jesus in the center. John 19:17-18
- Now in the place where He was crucified there was a garden, and in the garden a new tomb in which no one had yet been laid. ⁴² So there they laid Jesus, because of the Jews' Preparation *Day*, for the tomb was nearby. John 19:41-42









Why is there a Need for temple in the Last Days?

- Ezekiel was asked to measure the Temple of God
 - ²⁰ He measured it on the four sides; it had a wall all around, five hundred *cubits* long and five hundred wide, to separate the holy areas from the common.

 Ezekiel 42:20
- The Ezekiel Temple is the End Time Temple because of God's unfailing love for His firstborn Israel
 - The Temple need to be present because God will show Himself, Father, Son and Holy Spirit for the sake of His firstborn, Israel Ezekiel 43:1-7
 - The remnant will come to the saving Grace of Abba Father
 - All Israel will be saved "And so all Israel will be saved, as it is written: "The Deliverer will come out of Zion, And He will turn away ungodliness from Jacob;" – Romans 11:26

Yeshua Born during the Feast of Tabernacles and not on 25 December

- ¹⁴ And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us (tabernacles), and we beheld His glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father, full of grace and truth. John 1:14
- Yeshua was born during the Feast of Tabernacles

The Feast of Tabernacles

The most celebrated Feasts

Seven days celebration, begins on the 15th Day of Tishri – Numbers 29:12-39

First day (Sabbath) - Burnt offering 13 unblemished bulls

Second day – Burnt offering 12 unblemished bulls

Third day - Burnt offering 11 unblemished bulls

Fourth day - Burnt offering 10 unblemished bulls

Fifth day - Burnt offering 9 unblemished bulls

Sixth day - Burnt offering 8 unblemished bulls

Seventh day - Burnt offering 7 unblemished bulls

Eight day (Sabbath) - Burnt offering ONE unblemished bulls

Adds up to 70 - nations
On the Eight Day
SimChat Torah; One
Bull representing ONE
NEW MAN



The Millennium Era 1000 years

22 And he showed me a pure river of water of life, clear as crystal, proceeding from the throne of God and of the Lamb. ² In the middle of its street, and on either side of the river, was the tree of life, which bore twelve fruits, each tree yielding its fruit every month. The leaves of the tree were for the healing of the nations. ³ And there shall be no more curse, but the throne of God and of the Lamb shall be in it, and His servants shall serve Him. ⁴ They shall see His face, and His name shall be on their foreheads. ⁵ There shall be no night there: They need no lamp nor light of the sun, for the Lord God gives them light. And they shall reign forever and ever. – Revelation 22:1-5

Nations outside the Kingdom

¹⁶ And it shall come to pass *that* everyone who is left of all the nations which came against Jerusalem shall go up from year to year to worship the King, the LORD of hosts, and to keep the Feast of Tabernacles. ¹⁷ And it shall be *that* whichever of the families of the earth do not come up to Jerusalem to worship the King, the LORD of hosts, on them there will be no rain. ¹⁸ If the family of Egypt will not come up and enter in, they *shall have* no *rain*; they shall receive the plague with which the LORD strikes the nations who do not come up to keep the Feast of Tabernacles. ¹⁹ This shall be the punishment of Egypt and the punishment of all the nations that do not come up to keep the Feast of Tabernacles. – Zechariah 14:16-19

The Time is Near – Revelation 22:6-11

- ⁶Then he said to me, "These words *are* faithful and true." And the Lord God of the holy prophets sent His angel to show His servants the things which must shortly take place.
- 7 "Behold, I am coming quickly! Blessed is he who keeps the words of the prophecy of this book."
- 8 Now I, John, saw and heard these things. And when I heard and saw, I fell down to worship before the feet of the angel who showed me these things.
- ⁹Then he said to me, "See *that you do* not *do that*. For I am your fellow servant, and of your brethren the prophets, and of those who keep the words of this book. Worship God." ¹⁰ And he said to me, "Do not seal the words of the prophecy of this book, for the time is at hand. ¹¹ He who is unjust, let him be unjust still; he who is filthy, let him be filthy still; he who is righteous, let him be righteous still; he who is holy, let him be holy still."

Yeshua's warning to the Churches

- 12 "And behold, I am coming quickly, and My reward is with Me, to give to every one according to his work. 13 I am the Alpha and the Omega, the Beginning and the End, the First and the Last."
- ¹⁴ Blessed *are* those who do His commandments, that they may have the right to the tree of life, and may enter through the gates into the city. ¹⁵ But outside *are* dogs and sorcerers and sexually immoral and murderers and idolaters, and whoever loves and practices a lie.
- 16 "I, Jesus, have sent My angel to testify to you these things in the churches. I am the Root and the Offspring of David, the Bright and Morning Star."
- 17 And the Spirit and the bride say, "Come!" And let him who hears say, "Come!" And let him who thirsts come. Whoever desires, let him take the water of life freely.
