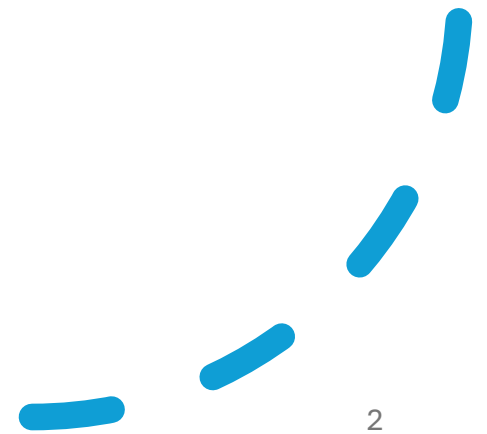

Proclamation:

1. Abba Father who has adopted us; it is about Sonship
 - ❖¹⁵ For you did not receive the spirit of bondage again to fear, but you received the Spirit of adoption by whom we cry out, “Abba, Father.” – Romans 8:15
2. Abba Father tabernacled with the Israelites for 40 years in the desert wilderness and HE will tabernacle with all of His children in our Generation

The Feast of Tabernacles – Leviticus 23:39-43

- ³⁹ ‘Also on the *fifteenth day of the seventh month*, when you have gathered in the fruit of the land, you shall keep the feast of the Lord *for seven days*; on *the first day* there shall be a *sabbath-rest*, and on the *eighth day* a sabbath-rest. ⁴⁰ And you shall take for yourselves on the *first day the fruit of beautiful trees, branches of palm trees, the boughs of leafy trees, and willows of the brook*; and you shall *rejoice* before the Lord your God for seven days. ⁴¹ You shall keep it as a feast to the LORD for seven days in the year. *It shall be* a statute forever in your generations. **You shall celebrate it in the seventh month.** ⁴² You shall dwell in booths for seven days. All who are native Israelites shall dwell in booths, ⁴³ that your generations may know that I made the children of Israel dwell in booths when I brought them out of the land of Egypt: I *am* the LORD your God.’ – Lev 23:39-43

On the *LAST* Day - The Water Libation - the Water Pouring Ceremony

- Feast of Atonement (Yom Kippur) ushers in the Feast of Tabernacles
 - The Pouring of water signifying the *Outpouring of the Holy Spirit*
 - Water is a symbol of the Spirit of God
 - God calls us *into fruitfulness* which can only come by the Holy Spirit
- ³⁷ On the last day, that great *day* of the feast (*Hosana Raba*), Jesus stood and cried out, saying, “If anyone thirsts, let him come to Me and drink. ³⁸ He who believes in Me, as the Scripture has said, out of his heart will *flow rivers of living water.*” ³⁹ But this *He spoke concerning the Spirit*, whom those believing in Him would receive; for the Holy Spirit was not yet given, because Jesus was not yet glorified.— John 7:37-39

- Day Four – 10 Bulls
- Day Five – 9 Bulls
- Day Six – 8 Bulls
- Day Seven – 7 Bulls (Completion Number on Day and Number of Bulls) ($13+12+11+10+9+8 = 70$)
 - Genesis 10 – 70 nations from Noah
- Day Eight – sabbath - One Bull

 - One New Man – “8” New Beginning


A Seven-Day Celebration of God's Goodness

The **Word** became **Flesh** and *Tabernacles* with us

- In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. ² He was in the beginning with God. ³ All things were made through Him, and without Him nothing was made that was made. ⁴ In Him was life, and the life was the light of men. ⁵ And the light shines in the darkness, and the *darkness did not comprehend it*. – John 1:1-5
- ¹⁰ He was in the world, and the world was made through Him, and the world did not know Him. ¹¹ He came to His own, and His own did not receive Him. ¹² But as many as received Him, to them *He gave the right to become children of God*, to those who believe in His name: ¹³ who were born, not of blood, nor of the will of the flesh, nor of the will of man, but of God. John 1:10-13
- ¹⁴ And the Word became flesh and *dwelt among us (tabernacle among us)*, and we beheld His glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father, full of grace and truth. – John 1:14

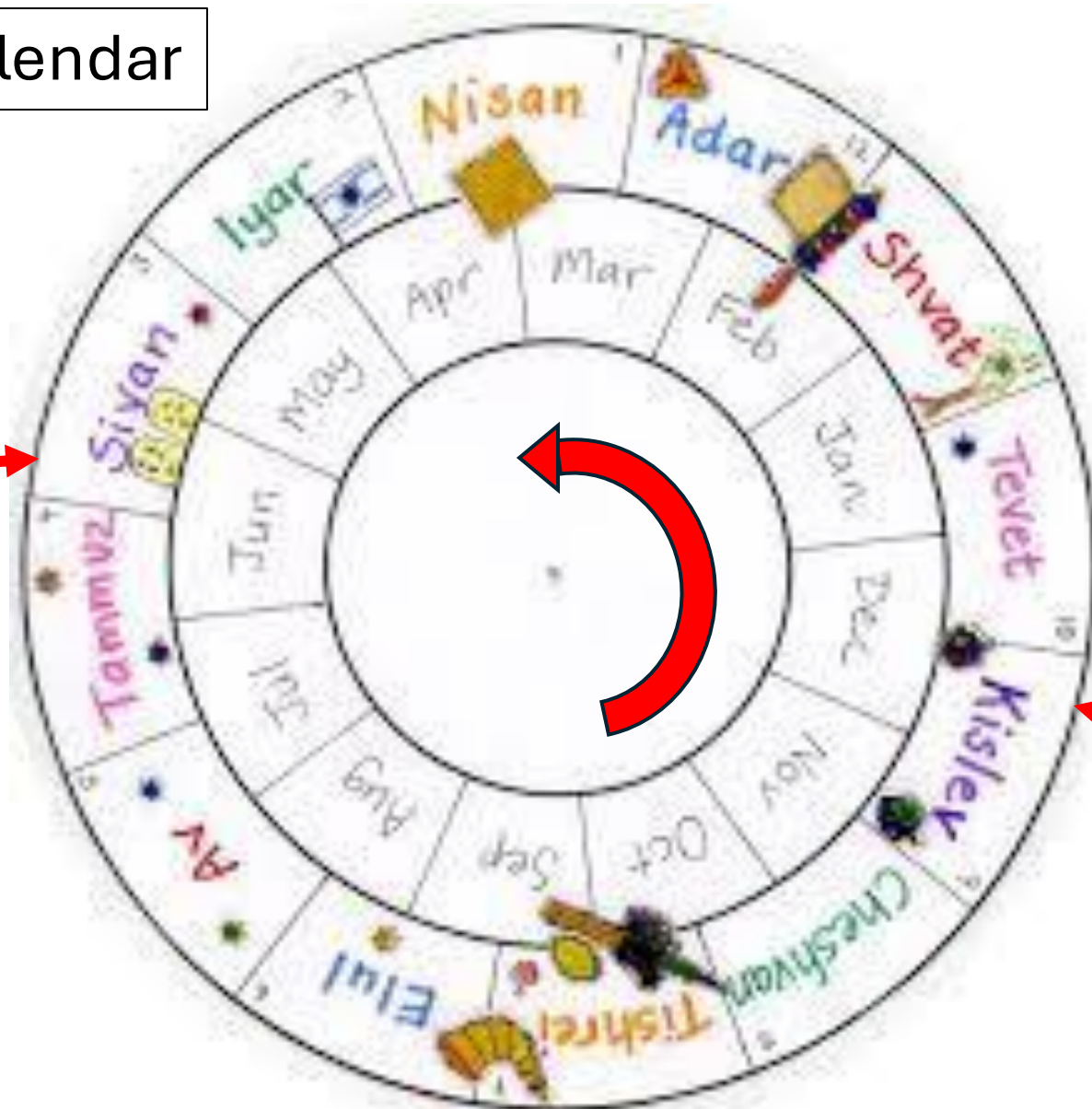
- ⁵ There was in the days of Herod, the king of Judea, a certain priest named Zacharias, of the division of Abijah. His wife was of the daughters of Aaron, and her name was Elizabeth. – Luke 1:5
- Three very important information:
 1. Zacharias was a *priest*
 2. The *Lot* fell on him to perform Temple service in the Hebrew month of Sivan (May/June) in BC 3-4
 3. Elizabeth, Zacharias' wife was from the daughters of Aaron, the priestly family

The Dating of Yeshua's Birth

- When Zacharias completed his duty, it was in the *Hebraic month Sivan* (May/June) B.C. 3-4
- “And after those days” Elizabeth conceived – May/June (Sivan)
- Sixth month of Elizabeth’s pregnancy, angel Gabriel appeared to Mary – Luke 1:26
- Six months from Elizabeth’s pregnancy took us to *Kislev (Dec)* where Mary conceived Yeshua by the Holy Spirit

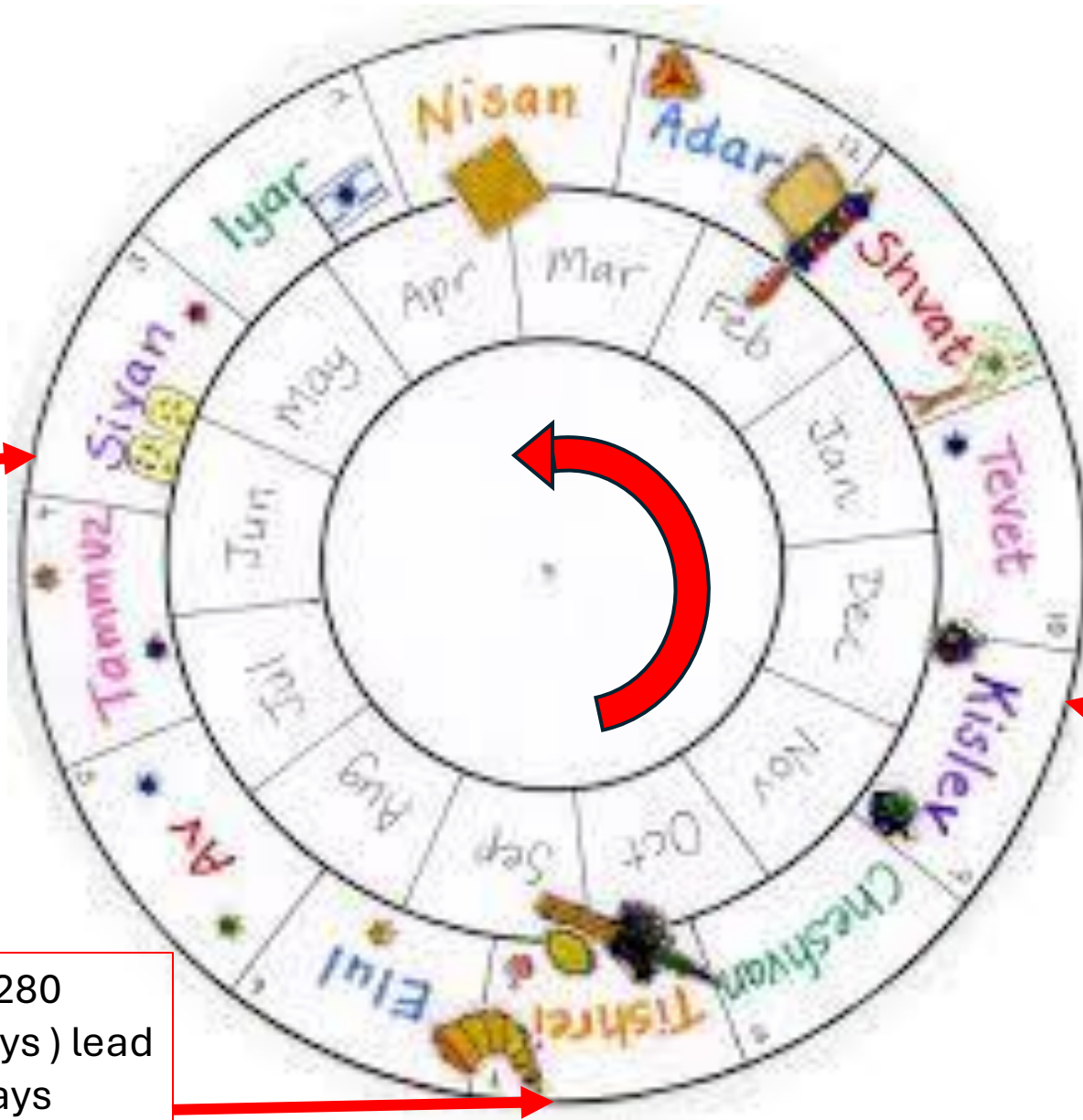

³⁵ And the angel answered and said to her, “*The Holy Spirit will come upon you, and the power of the Highest will overshadow you; therefore, also, that Holy One who is to be born will be called the Son of God.*” ³⁶ Now indeed, Elizabeth your relative has also conceived a son in her old age; and this is now the *sixth month* for her who was called barren. – Luke 1:35-36

- Elizabeth’s sixth month pregnancy is in the month of Kislev, the month Yeshua (Hanukkah) was conceived by the Holy Spirit in Mary’s womb
- Hanukkah has 8 days of celebration
- If Yeshua was conceived in the month of Kislev then His birth, 40 weeks later (Full Term) would be in the month of Tishri (@Feast of Tabernacles)

Full term baby - 40 weeks = 280
days or 9 months plus 10 days) lead

Birth of Yeshua @Feast of Tabernacles

- I believe Yeshua's was born during the Feast of Tabernacles
- He came to "tabernacle" with us at the Feast of the Great Rejoicing
- His birth recorded in Luke 2 was first witnessed by the shepherds
- Shepherd bring their sheep to the field only when weather permitting
 - ⁸ Now there were in the same country *shepherds living out in the fields, (likely built sukkah for themselves during Sukkot)* keeping watch over their flock by night. ⁹ And behold, an angel of the Lord stood before them, and the glory of the Lord shone around them, and they were greatly afraid. ¹⁰ Then the angel said to them, "Do not be afraid, for behold, I bring you good tidings of *great joy* which will be to *all people*. ¹¹ For there *is born to you this day* in the city of David a *Savior*, who is *Christ the Lord*. ¹² And this *will be* the sign to you: You will find a Babe wrapped in swaddling cloths, lying in a manger (*Sukkah*)." – Luke 2:8-12

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- The three wise men from the East, offered gifts to celebrate the birth of Yeshua
 - This is not at Yeshua's birth
 - Yeshua was then about two years old – Mathew 2:11,16

Another Evidence - Booths or Sukkah

- During the Feast of Tabernacles there will be many temporary shelter animals – Hebrew word of stable is Sukkah (Genesis 33:17)
 - And she brought forth her firstborn Son, and wrapped Him in swaddling cloths, and laid Him in a manger, because there was no room for them in the inn. – Luke 2:7
 - Manger as in Hebrew is “shelter of livestock in this case a Sukkah
 - Yeshua was birthed into a “temporary shelter” His human body

Feast of Tabernacles


- Five days (Grace) after the Feast of Atonement (Yom Kippur)
- After the completion of the Fall harvest
- It is a time of celebration, remembering God's deliverance from Egypt and His provision and protection during the 40 years wandering in the wilderness
- Is also a time the Israelites brought their tithes and offerings to the Temple
- Josephus called this Feast the holiest and greatest feast of the Jews
- After 7 days of feasting, the eighth day was to be a holy convocation (Simchat Torah) – was October 7, 2024, the day in which Hamas attacked the Jewish population in the border with Gaza
- Could this also usher in a 'new beginning' of events to come?

How did present day churches end up celebrating Yeshua's Birth on 25 December?

- December 25 origins from pagan festivals, worship of the sun god
- It was in 4th Century AD changed to a Christian festival honoring the birth of Christ
- Adopted by the Western Roman Empire on 25 December and the Eastern Roman Empire on January 6
- Reflecting disagreement even among the early fathers of Faith
- Christmas tree is linked with late medieval practices



Feast of Tabernacles – The Final Fulfilment

- **14** “Let not your heart be troubled; you believe in God, believe also in Me. ²In My Father’s house are many mansions; if *it were* not so, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you. ³And if I go and prepare a place for you, *I will come again and receive you to Myself; that where I am, there you may be also.*” - John 14:1-3
- This is a language of a Jewish Bridegroom to his betrothal bride

Who Are These “Raptured” Saints?

- ³ But I do not want you to be ignorant, brethren, concerning those who have fallen asleep, lest you sorrow as others who have no hope. ¹⁴ For if we believe that Jesus died and rose again, even so God will bring with Him those who *sleep in Christ (Jesus)*.
- ¹⁵ For this we say to you by the word of the Lord, that we who are alive *and* remain until the coming of the Lord will by no means precede those who are asleep. ¹⁶ For the Lord Himself will descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of an archangel, and with the trumpet of God. 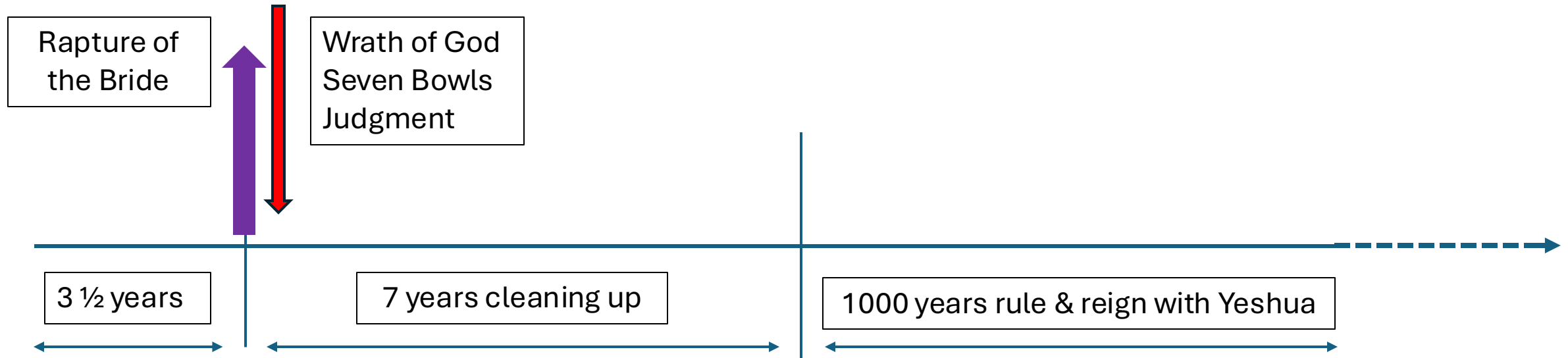
- ¹⁶ And it shall come to pass *that* everyone *who is left of all the nations which came against Jerusalem* shall go up from year to year to worship the King, the LORD of hosts, and to keep the Feast of Tabernacles. ¹⁷ And it shall be *that* whichever of the *families* of the earth do not come up to Jerusalem to worship the King, the LORD of hosts, on them there will be no rain. ¹⁸ If the family of Egypt will not come up and enter in, they *shall have no rain*; they shall receive the plague with which the LORD strikes the nations who do not come up to keep the Feast of Tabernacles. ¹⁹ This shall be the punishment of Egypt and the punishment of all the nations that do not come up to keep the Feast of Tabernacles. – Zechariah 14:16-19

Compare with Rev 21:10 - Great (*holy*) City and Holy (*New*) Jerusalem

Timeline




- Last Three and half years of the Great Tribulation or the Wrath of the Dragon (Time, Times and Half a Time) – Rev 12:14,17
- It will take seven years to clean up the nuclear fall out from the War of Armageddon – Rev 16:16
- During the seven year of clean-up (Ezekiel 39:9) and the Bride and the Martyrs will tabernacle with Yeshua in heaven

Act of Repentance before the LORD Supper – We Proclaim

4. We repent of the dedication of the foundation of our nation to spiritual forces to obstruct what Almighty God had ordained for us, and we command these spirits to vacate their seats; we wash every such seat with the Blood of the Lamb and call on the angelic hosts to clear these seats and similar hindrances in our land, so that Singapore will fulfill its destiny as ordained by Almighty God.

Act of Repentance before the LORD Supper – We Proclaim

- That we together with the aid of the angelic hosts will destroy:
 - the surface of the covering cast over all people, and
 - the veil that is spread over all nations; so that our people will be able to come out of Moab.

The LORD's Supper

We shall now partake of the LORD's Supper and ask the Holy Spirit to destroy the wine of Babylon that we had drunk and wash our minds, clean with the blood of Yeshua; wash away all humanistic thinking; wash away all witchcraft and sorcery from Moab and Babylon and its demonic allies.
